Visa Information

Participants should check if they require a visa to enter the United States on the U.S. Department of State's [U.S. Visas](#) website.

Foreign travelers, who are citizens from certain eligible countries, may also be able to visit the U.S. for business (e.g. attend a scientific conference) or tourism for 90 days or less without a visa if they meet the [Visa Waiver Program](#) requirements. All Visa Waiver Program travelers must present a machine-readable passport at the U.S. port of entry to enter the U.S. without a visa; otherwise a U.S. visa is required. All eligible travelers who wish to travel under the Visa Waiver Program must apply for authorization on-line through [ESTA](#) (Electronic System for Travel Authorization).

Currently processing times of visas can be quite long. So if you require a visa to enter the U.S., we **strongly recommend** that you start the visa application process as soon as possible.

IMPORTANT: You should contact the US consulate/Embassy in your country of origin for more information on obtaining the appropriate US visa, specific requirements, and about the process.
