floating comments




- Japanese streaming service owned by DWANGO Co. Ltd.
- Audiences can type their comments that floats on screen in realtime



What is "Niconico"?

"8888888" is Niconico slang; an imitation sound of "clapping hands"



- This feature makes live streaming more interesting & interactive
- The audiences start chatting each other
 - o sometimes an "expert"-ish appears and leaves a supplementary comments



Belle II Roll-in



with the Mayor of Tsukuba

5 video cameras

- "Roll-in": Moved Belle II detector 13 meters from construction area to interaction region
- Live streamed whole procedure of the roll-in
- Invite guests from various field and discussed about "Science and Society"




SuperKEKB First Collision



Visitor History (accumulated numbers)





Definition of "visitor"

Literally the "number of people visited"


- +1: when entered URL
- +1: when refreshed/reloaded
- NO minimum session time
- NO distinction of same person

[Example] If the same person ...

- "watched 30hrs without closing the page" ⇒ 1 visitor
- "watched brokenly (say 10min, 1hr, and 5min) in a day" ⇒ 3 visitors



Impression of Audiences



- Niconico also has features to ask questions to the audience
- Questions can be changed as we like
- Choices are shown on top of the screen




Questions we asked

- Q1 : How was today's show ?
 - very good / good / okay / not so good / not good
- Q2: How old are you?
 - 10's and younger / 20's / 30's / 40's / 50's /
 60's / 70's / 80's / 90's and older
- Q3: Where are you watching from?
 - KEK / office / home / outside Japan / outer space / hidden place




Q1. How was today's show?





Q2. How old are you?




- Although "90's and over" contains jokes, the age distribution seems reliable
- We can say that Niconico live streaming is a better tool to reach group of 20's to 50's



Q3. Where are you watching from?





The main audiences were **Japanese**

Outer space Outside Japan

- They watched from Home
- "Others" are just jokes: "outer space", "hidden place"
