

## Hadronic decays of $D^{0(+)}$ and $D_s^+$ at BESIII

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BESIII collected 2.93 and 3.2 fb<sup>-1</sup> of data at  $\sqrt{s} = 3.773$  and 4.178 GeV, respectively. Many hadronic decays of  $D^{0(+)}$  and  $D_s^+$  have been studied. In this talk, the measurements of the branching fractions of  $D^{0(+)}$   $\rightarrow$   $PP$  (P=Peudecalor) decays, the observations of the baryonic decay  $D_s^+ \rightarrow p\bar{n}$  and the pure W-annihilation decay  $D_s^+ \rightarrow \omega\pi^+$  as well as the amplitude analyses of the multi-body decays  $D^0 \rightarrow K^-\pi^+\pi^0\pi^0$ ,  $K^-\pi^+\pi^+\pi^-$ ,  $D^+ \rightarrow K_s\pi^+\pi^+\pi^-$  and  $D_s^+ \rightarrow \eta\pi^+\pi^0$  will be presented.

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
