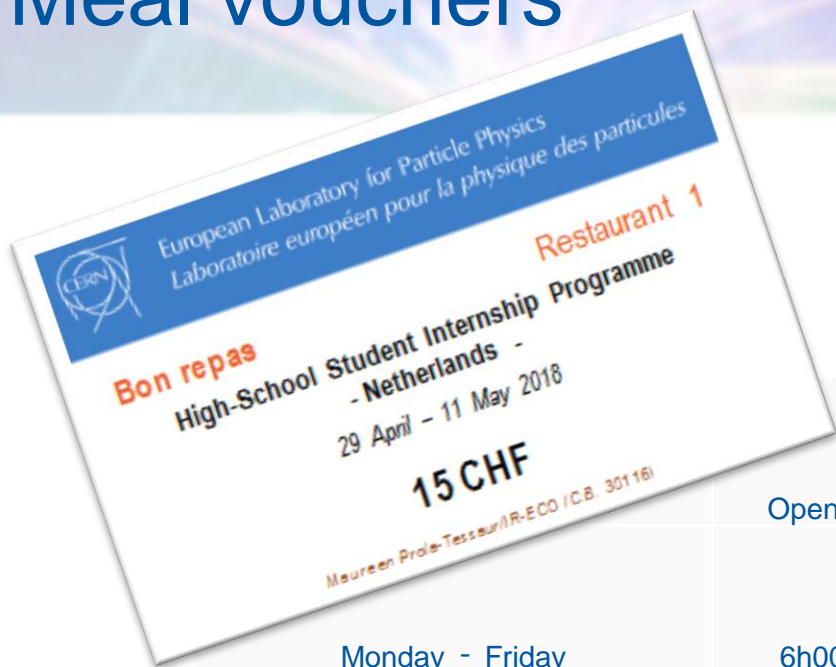

Computer Security



This computer security course addresses the "tools" and "fronts" of the use of computer resources at CERN. It covers how to protect your computer, how to browse the web and use email securely, file data, and what is and isn't allowed in the CERN Computing Rules. Many of the items also apply to computer use at home or anywhere else in the world.

After the slides on computer security, you'll be challenged by a short multiple-choice test and then asked to sign digitally the CERN computing rules. The course material is online and passed by all online participants, within 5 days after initial account creation.

Failure to pass this course leads to the blocking of your CERN account(s)!
