Registration for the 11th International Workshop on Top Quark Physics, TOP 2018, is ongoing. The workshop will be held in the resort town of Bad Neuenahr in Germany from the 16th to the 21st of September. Bad Neuenahr is located in the lovely Ahr valley, surrounded by vineyards, 60 kilometers south of Cologne.

in due time. A **reduced registration fee** of 180 Euros is offered only until **July 10** (“early bird” reduction). Please take the opportunity to make use of this reduced fee and **register now!** Later registrants will have to pay 230 Euros.

The workshop venue is the Steigenberger hotel located at the banks of the Ahr river in the centre of the town. A public spa is available next door for recreation. Bad Neuenahr can be reached by train from the airports of Cologne/Bonn, Dusseldorf and Frankfurt. The **hotel rooms** at the Steigenberger are reserved for participants of the workshop until **July 20**. Please make sure to reserve the room before this deadline. All participants are expected to attend the workshop for the entire period of the event.

To provide young physicists with the opportunity to contribute to the scientific programme, a **Poster Session** and a **Young Scientist Forum** with short presentations will be organized. The best presentations and posters will be awarded a prize.

The experimental talks of the Young Scientist Forum (three for ATLAS and three for CMS speakers) will be awarded by the speakers’ committees of the collaborations. Proposals for posters on experimental topics can be submitted to the top group conveners of ATLAS and CMS.

The young **theorists’ presentations** for the Young Scientist Forum will be awarded by the International Advisory Committee. Note that not more than three talks may be selected due to the length of the session, but additional ones may be converted to the poster session. We ask young theorists to submit abstracts for a talk or a poster via the workshop web page to the International Advisory Committee **until July 20**.

We are looking forward to meet you in Bad Neuenahr this coming September.
