 - Several interested science centres (particularly Poland – Copernicus Science Centre in Warsaw; Israel – National Museum of Science in Haifa)

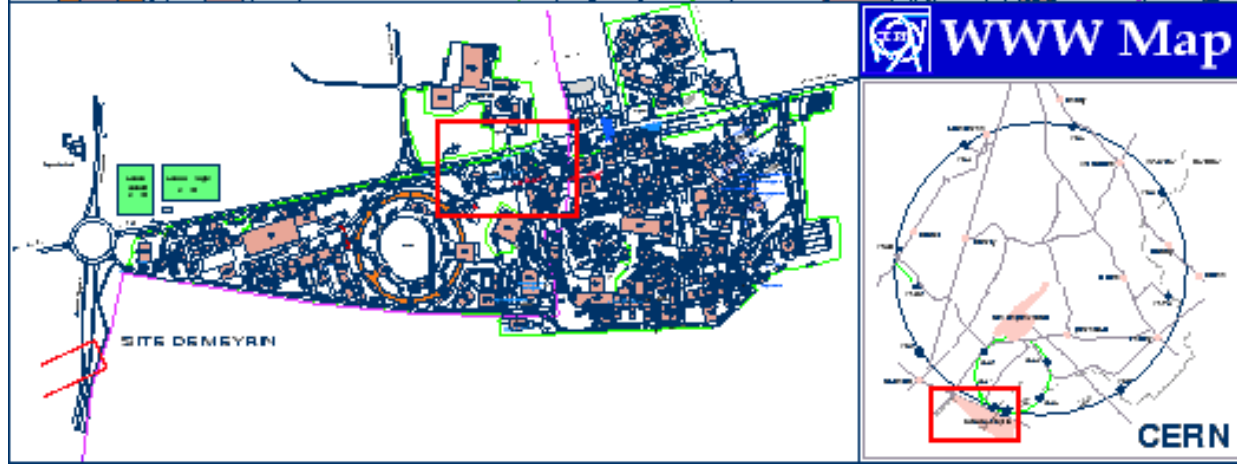
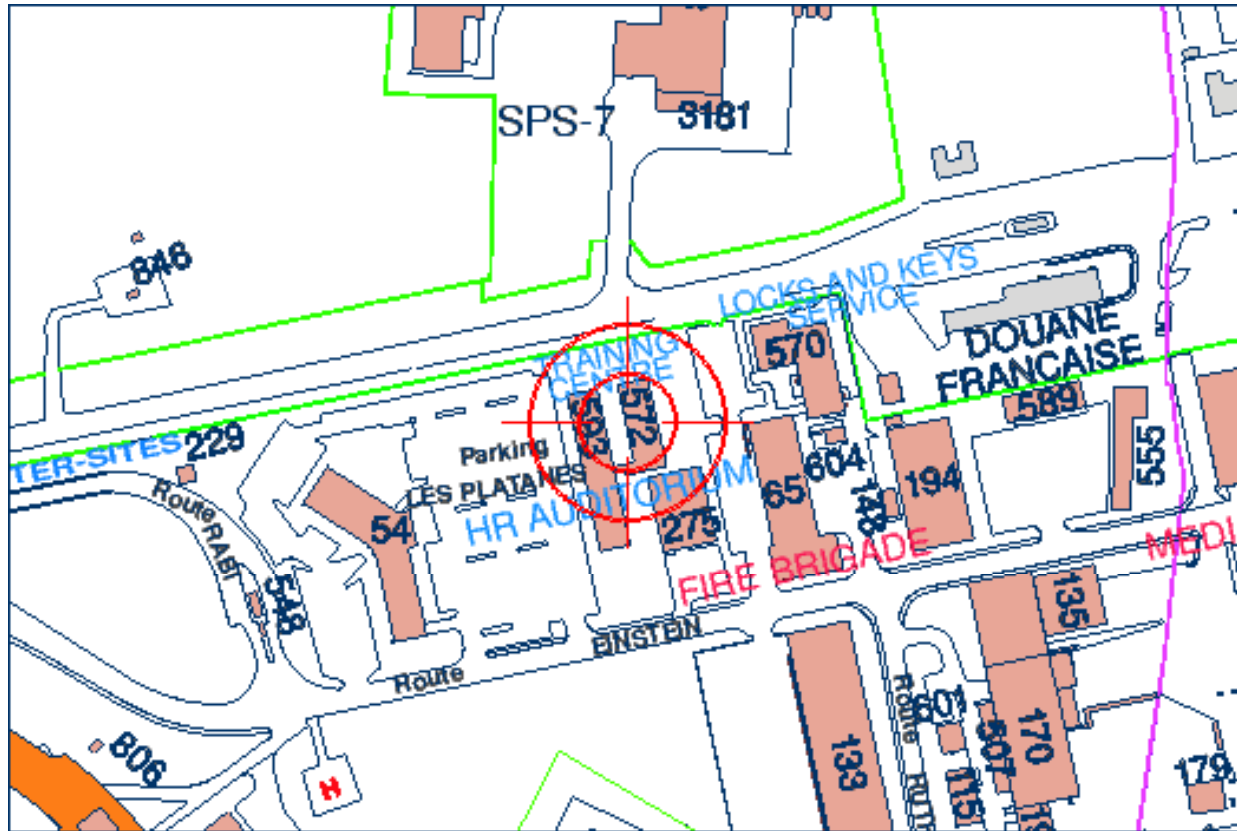
Aims of this EPPOG meeting
