### **Longitudinal Polarisation**



- activity already ongoing, people working on the subject from Ljubljana, Milano, Paris (LLR), Torino, Pavia
- one of those places is the natural location for the meeting
- candidate location: Paris
- period: end of September or beginning of October
- have preliminary Vidyo meetings (mid-July + second week of Sep?)

### **Physics Objects Reco**



- no core group already setup on the subject, so it's less clear where to have it (and when)
- does WG3 have an idea of who would be working on it?
- should we have a general call for candidacies of location and period?
- candidate locations: Krakow
- period: avoid overlaps w/ other VBSCan events, ATLAS/CMS weeks
- have preliminary Vidyo meetings

# the training event



- dedicated to the tools specific for VBS, also developed in our Action
- expected audience of about 20 people
- performed together with the second in-person meeting of the Grant Period
  - this was the decision of the last MC meeting, but we can revisit it of course (may be more expensive though)
- possible arguments
  - use of MC generators
  - ML
  - EFT (generation, fitting)
  - unfolding
- candidate locations: Ljubljana, Dresden, München

- How to handle the turn-over
- The MC needs to devise and approve the turn-over procedure.
  - One proposal is to do it with an open call for nominations, to be then evaluated by a Search Committee nominated by the MC.
  - The search committee may be composed of a maximum of 5 people, seniors, voted by the MC after (self-)candidacy, properly considering gender balance, ITC countries involvement, theory/experiment balance when choosing its composition
  - decide the dates for the open call, for the decision and for the turnover

# 10. general meeting for GP3



- this will coincide with the Mid Term Scientific Meeting (MTSM), a major event of the Action where to make the point of the advancement of our scientific program.
  - will close the process of internal review, rather than start it, and serve as a starting point for the following two years
- when and where to hold it has to be discussed
  - when: it would be best to decide today, this eases planning and candidacies
  - where: decide a date when to close candidacies
- expect large attendance, also remotely, maybe also with COST people (our Science Officer, the External Rapporteur?)
- our current ITC countries: Cyprus, Czech Republic, Croatia, Poland, Portugal, Serbia, Slovenia, Turkey
