Purpose

- Ensure that R&D activities, most notably of openlab and Techlab, are aligned with
 - the needs of users
 - the strategy of IT Department and other R&D activities
 - each other



Expectations

- Help improve communication and information flow
- Help IT better understand priorities within and across the experiments, and set priorities accordingly
 - Improve understanding of resource impacts of proposed projects



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Mandate

- Consider requests and proposals for resources for R&D projects in the context of openIab and TechIab, and make recommendations to IT Management on priorities
 - Ensure that R&D activities are properly documented, and the results are made available publicly (as much as possible in view of potential NDAs)
 - Serve as focal point for information about openlab and Techlab activities
 - Scope:
 - Activities with impact on IT personnel and/or material resources beyond core personnel already clearly assigned (e.g. the openlab core team)
 - Activities with impact on R&D systems made available to users beyond regular hardware upgrades
 - Other topics can be presented or discussed on request, for example to probe experiment priorities

Proposed Guidelines (1)

- Transparent, open working mode
 - Open sessions
 - Proposals, status reports, results
 - Slides and/or supporting documentation compulsory
 - All accepted proposals to be followed up via status reports (minimum 1/year?) and presentations of results
 - Relevant experts can/will be invited to attend



Proposed Guidelines (2)

- Avoid duplication: If proposals are followed up elsewhere (for a good reason), don't do it in this group – but ensure the group is fully informed about proposals, status reports, results
 - Pointers to documentation in a central place
- Meeting details:
 - Suggest to start with monthly meetings, and review rhythm after a few meetings
 - Venue: Not too small a room, but the IT amphi might be over the top (?) – 513-1-024?
 - Vidyo or Webcast if required
 - Fixed time slot is Friday 09:00h generally good?



Proposed Guidelines (3)

- Documentation: Indico category
- Regular reports to IT Management (ITMM)
 - The group advises, recommends, tries to convince - it does not have decisive and/or executive power
- Fine-tune and adapt to changing landscape to ensure the group is useful
 - Changes of mandate, composition, scope etc. subject to IT Management approval
