

Dear participants of the ATLAS Standard-Model WS in London,

We have now finalized our timetable.

Our campus is located at Mile End Road. The postal code E14NS will get you to the exact location. Nearest stations on the London Underground are "Mile End" on Hammersmith and City, District and Central lines, and "Stepney Green" on the Hammersmith and City and District lines.

The conference venue is the Skeel Lecture Theatre in the Peoples Palace (number 16 on the campus map).

The registration desk, coffee and lunch breaks will be located in the Foyer of the Peoples Palace.

We will connect the conference to a video room (see information on the indico page) but we will not carry around microphones.

Eduroam is available at the conference venue. For those without Eduroam account, we will provide passwords for our guest network.

The offices of our group, the PPRC, are in the 4th floor of the G.O Jones building, number 25 of the campus map.

This floor is not officially part of the conference venue but we can provide e.g. quiet rooms for private conferences or a fridge for storage.

Seminar rooms available for you are: 410a / 410b on the 4th floor and 516 on the 5th floor.

The registration desk will be open from Wednesday morning, 8:30 am in the Foyer of the People's Palace. The conference will start at 9:30 am.

For early arrivals, we will provide an early-registration desk on Tue, Sept 4th, from 4pm to 6pm in the Foyer of the G.O. Jones building.

For those, who for some technical reason have been unable to pay the conference fee or the theatre tickets, we will provide the possibility to pay by credit card at the registration desk. We are not prepared to handle cash.

On-campus accommodations will be on the residential area marked on the campus map. The reception for the on-campus accommodation is in Christopher France House (number 54 on the campus map), which is open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Keys are issued starting from 2pm. Please bring a photo ID. The hotel reception will also hand you the breakfast vouchers and explain where to find the breakfast place.
