# Google Summer of Code (GSoC)

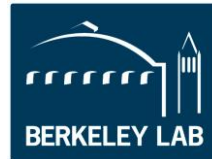
- Created in 2005 to:

  - Bring new talent and ideas into open source
- 2018 totals
  - 212 organisations
  - 1264 students
- CERN
  - Participating since 2011
  - 2017 - Evolution into an umbrella organisation:  
*CERN-HEP Software Foundation*
  - 2018: **29 students** accepted (26 last year)

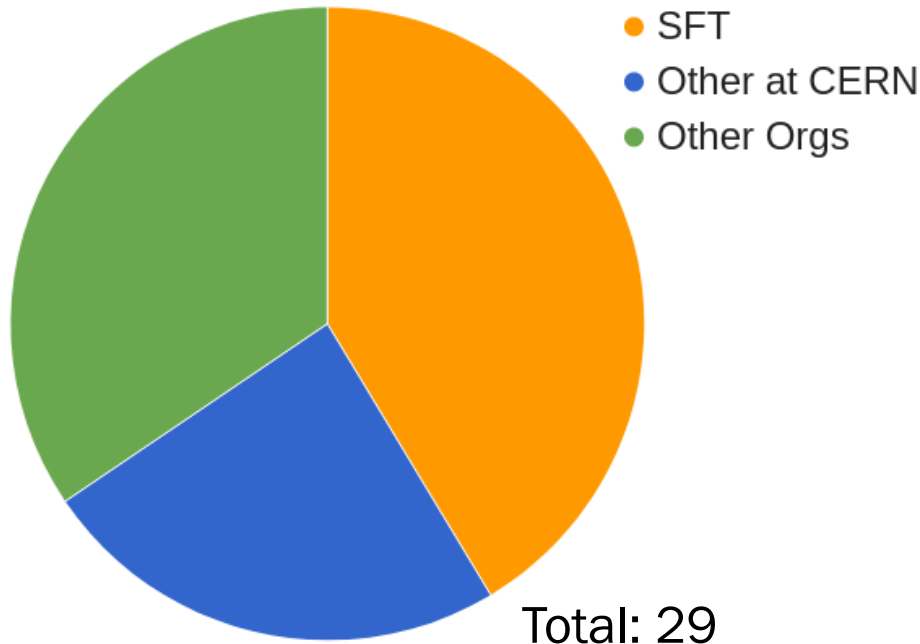

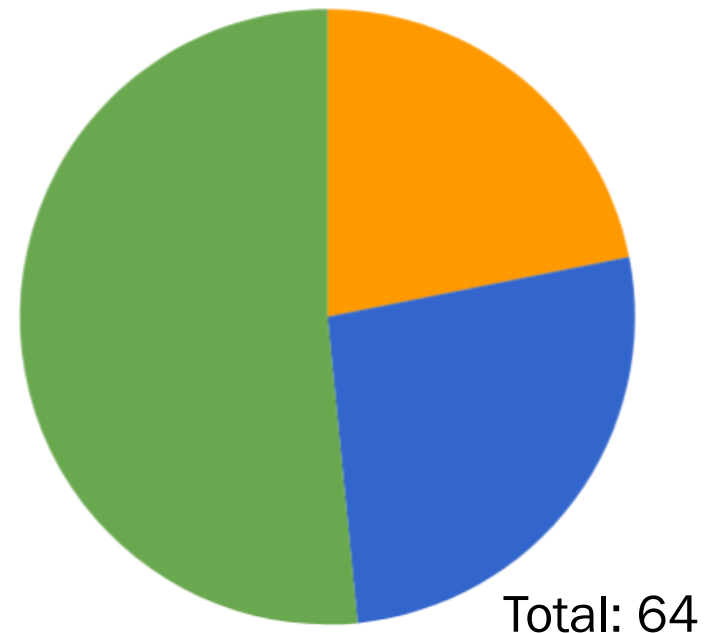
