ARTHUR I. MILLER is professor of history and philosophy of science at University College London. He is fascinated by the nature of creative thinking and, in particular, in creativity in art (on the one hand) and science (on the other). What are the similarities, what are the differences? He is the author of *Einstein, Picasso*, which was nominated for the Pulitzer Prize and *Empire of the Stars*, which was shortlisted for the 2006 Aventis Prize for Science Books. *Deciphering the Cosmic Number: The Strange Friendship of Wolfgang Pauli and Carl Jung* was published in April 2009.
