- Indico can create visitor badges
- Vidyo soon receives a "whiteboard" feature
- Increase in emails in junk folder to decrease false rejections
- First release of new tape management system CTA (replacing CASTOR) expected this year
- CernVM-FS: 300 % increase in 2017
- Upcoming S3 service (important for CernVM-FS)
- Bidirectional SNOW JIRA interface
- gitlab receives LFS support to help migration large files from svn
- Network hardware upgrade across campus
 - current infrastructure 75 % to 80 % utilized
 - better outside coverage around restaurant 1 and 2 and building 13

Service Life Cycle



Linux

- CentOS 7.5 in production, SL 6.10 upcoming
- Batch moves 30 % from SL6 to CC7 by Jan 2019, 80 % by Jun 2019
- The alias lxplus.cern.ch points to CC7 in June 2019
- SL6 is phased out by June 2020

Others

- AFS phase-out still on hold until the new EOS fuse client goes in production; the fuse client is currently in pre-production testing
- SVN is phased out by December 2019, already before that date existing repositories will change to read-only mode
- LFS is phased out by end of 2018, replaced by HT-Condor
- Ceph-FS replaces the commercial NFS filer
- Windows 7 has reached its end of life

Microsoft Software

- CERN has its academic status revoked by March 2019
- At current use results in ${>}10{\times}$ increase in license costs
- Biggest issue: email and authentication given the large number of CERN users (mailboxes)
- Service and product replacement based on use cases
 - Use cases gathered this year (!)
 - First prototypes in 2019
- Note: In general, MS Software will continue to be available at CERN

Application Software Changes

- Inkscape replaces Corel Draw
- BlueGriffon replaces Adobe Dreamweaver
- ProjectLibre replaces Microsoft Project (where possible)
