Meeting goals

- Validation / quality assurance in particular in MT mode and large event samples
 - Critical for both physics and non-physics
 - Examine the test coverage : do we cover all functionalities / phase space?
 - Collaboration-wide effort
- Familiarize with new (and current) tools
 - Drupal, Git
 - Coverity, performance monitoring, Cdash, physics validation DB, etc.
- Look for the future
 - Join the discussion at plenary / parallel sessions on discussions about shorter- and longer-term developments
 - Again, collaboration-wide effort
- Update user requirements
 - New requirements, forgotten requirements
 - Emerging user domains, e.g. material science, radiation security, ...

 - The Steering Board is now checking every open bug report at every SB meeting.
 - Collaboration meeting is an excellent opportunity for tackling to longstanding issues.
- Please update bug report you are assigned to.
 - If you think the report should be assigned to someone else, please re-assign it. Otherwise change the status to "assigned".
 - If you have already fixed the issue, or if you have identified the report as invalid, please update the report status accordingly. Don't remain the report unattended.
- Many "good" HyperNews postings are unattended.
 - First of all, subscribe threads that are related to your WGs.
- Join the collaboration-wide efforts. Collaboration meeting is a good opportunity for joining in.
 - Testing, computing and physics performance monitoring
 - Examples, documentation, web
