"Educational Residential Internship Programmes for High-School Students: it's all about Respect"

In order to ensure the smooth running of the residential programme, all participants are reminded that applicable on-site rules must be respected at all times. These include, but not limited to:

- The CERN Access Card has to be worn visibly at all times on the premises of the Organization.
- All persons have to be in possession of a valid identity document.
- Instructions given by a Member of the Personnel or a Security Agent have to be followed.
- Integrity of the premises have to be respected at all times.
- Silence of the place of lodging have to be respected at all times, and particularly between 22:00 and 08:00.
- CERN is a no-smoking laboratory. Smoking inside buildings is not permitted.
- Any behaviour that is prohibited or disturbing is strictly forbidden. This includes any behaviour
 deemed a risk for persons, goods, or the environment, by a Member of the Personnel or a Security
 Agent, as well as any behaviour putting the normal functioning of the Organization, its neighbours,
 public peace and safety at risk or violates the rights of others.
- It is forbidden to bring alcohol or any other illegal drug onto the premises of the Organization.
 Consumption of alcohol should be reasonable and strict rules apply.
- The participants are under the responsibility of the accompanying persons for the duration of the programme and have to follow their instructions.
- Proper care should be taken of personal valuables. CERN is not responsible in the event of their theft,
 loss or damage.

CERN reserves the right to take adequate measures against persons who do not comply with these on-site rules.
