






CERN as an international organisation

Note: personnel from contractors working on site not included (~ 1'400)



Official Currency: CHF

Units

1 kCHF = 1000 CHF = 10^3 = one thousand

1 MCHF = 1 000 000 CHF = 10^6 = one million


1250 MCHF = $1.25 * 10^9 = 1.25$ billion (1.25 milliard) CHF
