

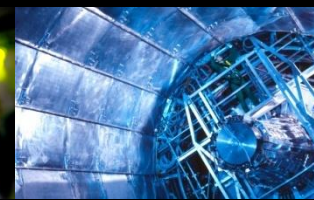
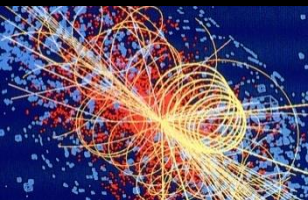

- Regular registration (\$200) will be possible until March 18th.



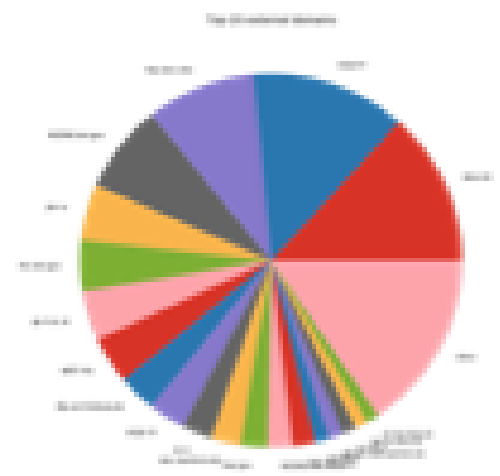
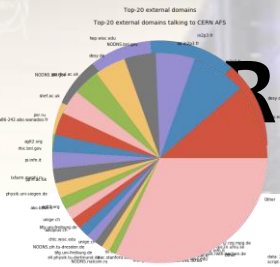

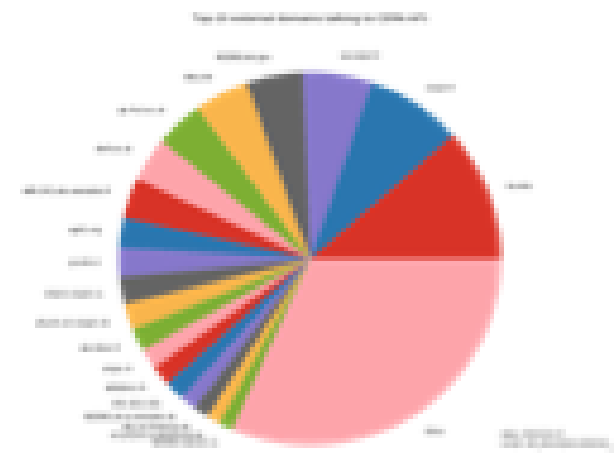

CERN 2nd external AFS disconnection test

- “FYI”: non-WLCG but *might* affect sites
- test: cut access to CERN AFS service from non-CERN networks
 - affects eternal use of all CERN AFS areas (homedirectories, workspace, project space)
 - Goals: flush (still-)unknown AFS dependencies
- Start: Wed April 3rd 2019 09:00 CET
- Duration: 1 week
- Details: Announce on ITSSB
- reaction to single-day test in 2017 (TL;DR:“meh.”)
