



CMS VISIT : SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

All visitors must be registered at CERN before access to any CERN site is possible. Visitor badges, displaying the visitors name, can be collected at the CERN reception (Meyrin) or at the CMS site (Cessy). Visitors must wear their visitor badge at all times during the visit.

Flat or block-heeled, closed shoes are required to be worn during the site visit. Official CMS visitor helmets will be provided and are the only ones to be used during the tour.

It is not possible to take bags or backpacks larger than 10 litres to the underground areas. CERN does not take any responsibility for items left unattended during the visit.

Persons equipped with any magnetic field sensitive medical device or implant (pacemaker, defibrillator, electronic medicine dispenser, hearing aid, metal implant ...) should contact us before the visit. **Magnet is OFF now - July 2019!** When the magnet is ON these persons will not be allowed in the underground premises.

Pregnant women should contact us in advance of their visit. They might not be allowed underground.

People suffering from claustrophobia or epilepsy are not allowed in the underground areas.

Children below 8 y/o are not authorised to join the visit.

Children younger than 10 years old & persons not fit to climb stairways, should contact us in advance for safety reasons.

No smoking, eating and drinking on the surface and underground tour, except when on dedicated areas on surface only.

Please, make sure you stay with your guide during the whole visit. Should an alarm occur please follow the instructions given by your guide who will take you to the surface using the lift.

For the safety of those working at or visiting the CMS site, CMS reserves the right to cancel visits at short notice.
