



To the attention of the bidders

 Rules applicable to the tendering process

 Reflect the principles laid down in the Procurement Rules







Country of origin

- Member states (generally including Associate Member states)
- Percentage terms
- Relevant for the adjudication



Eligibility & formal requirements of the bids

- Compliant bid by a bidder qualified on the basis of the MS criteria
- Bidder accepts all obligations of tender/future contract
- Formalities: language, signature, prices,...
- Validity of 6 months, can be prolonged



> Alternative Proposals

- Bidder may submit alternative proposal
- In addition to compliant bid
- Adjudication on basis of compliant bid
- Successful bidder's alternative proposal may be preferred by CERN



Subcontracting

- Detail of subcontracted obligations, value and country of origin
- CERN's entitlement to reject
- Rules: exclusion, cap.



> Award of the contract

- CERN's sole discretion
- No right of recourse by bidder
- Possible splitting





NEW CONCEPT

Abnormally low bids

CERN may reject bids considered « abnormally low » (new section 7.3 Procurement Rules)

- Rules applicable to the transaction between CERN and the contractor



General Conditions of CERN Contracts Utility

- Pre-approved, autonomous language (English and French)
- Address standard situations
- Reflect long procurement experience
- Cover supplies and services




Contractual arrangement with contractor

Specific clauses

purchase order or standard contract General terms the GCCC

"Tailormade" contract









Delivery & Acceptance

- Delivery as instructed by CERN
- Responsibility of the contractor
- Procedures in the event of late/damaged/incorrect delivery
- Standard acceptance procedure
- Procedures in the event of non-conformity of the supplies/services
- Specific acceptance modalities in the tender documents



Confidential information

- Standard situation: only CERN discloses confidential information
- Possible modification: mutual disclosure
- Where necessary, mark as confidential





- Standard situation: 2 years
- Starts with acceptance
- Longer duration must be specified
- Procedures in the event of non-conformity



> Intellectual Property

- Standard situation: only CERN discloses IP to the contractor
- Licensing conditions
- Possible modification: mutual disclosure of IP
- IP generated in the performance of contract belongs to CERN – possible license to contractor



Governing law & arbitration

- Interpretation of the GCCC in accordance with true meaning and effect
- Omission, ambiguity: Swiss substantive law
- *« Ad Hoc »* arbitration procedure



General Conditions of CERN Contracts 2018: Improved version

- Improved definitions
- IP: contractor may be granted with license of use of IP generated in the execution of the contract



General Conditions of CERN Contracts 2018: Improved version

Subcontracting

- Clarifications to the definition
- New obligations of the contractor towards the subcontractor
- Better protection of CERN in the event of default of contractor towards its subcontractor
