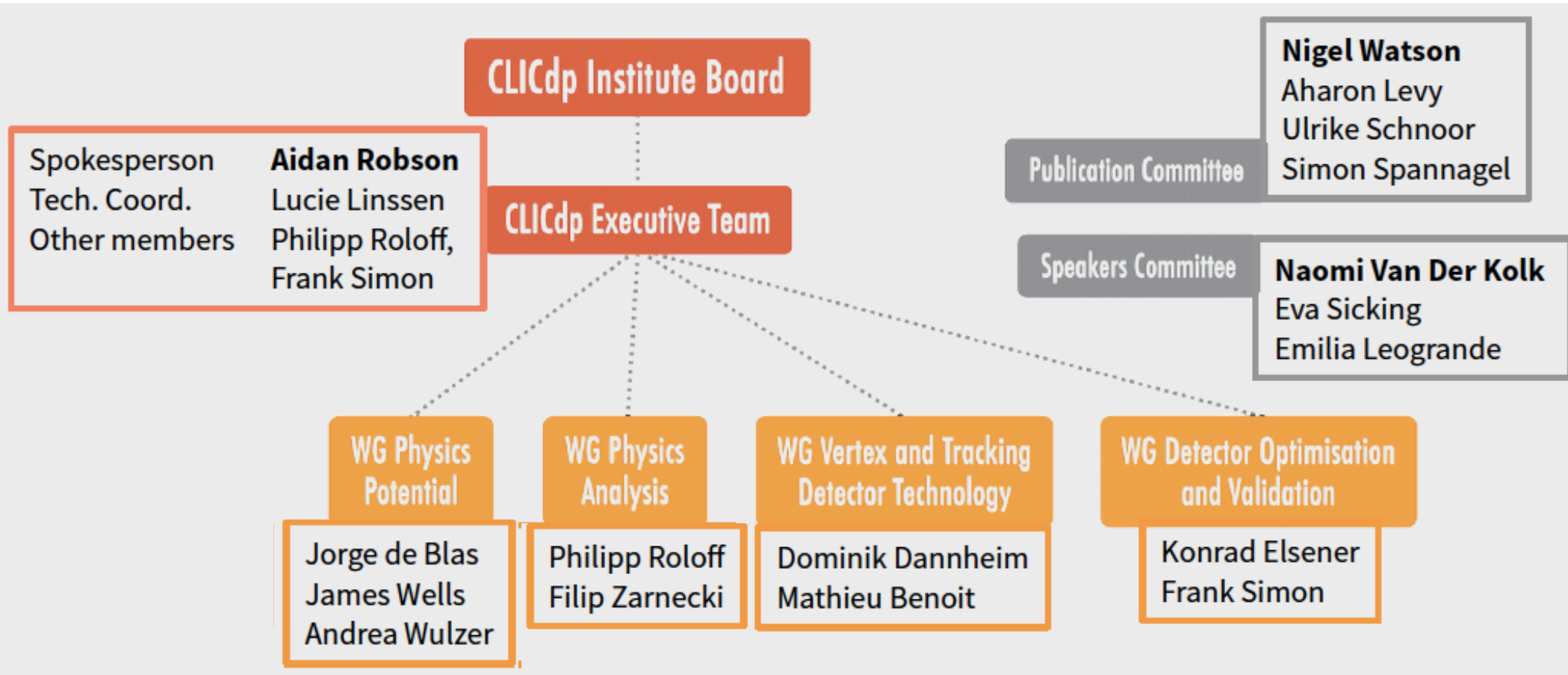

  - Result should be known by end of May

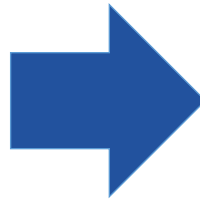


# Institute Board: IFJ PAN (Krakow)

# IB business



- ➔ Discussed European Strategy status and process [see Aidan's talk in this session]
- ➔ Discussed CLICdp working group plans for this year
- ➔ The IB agreed: **Time to make CLIC's message very clear!**
  - Unprecedented, excellent, diverse physics reach
  - Feasible timescale
  - Cost of CLIC 380GeV + 1.5TeV < cost of FCC-ee
  - CLIC staging brings cost staging, and accompanying implications on affordability
  - Linear tunnel provides natural infrastructure for future beyond CLIC
