Other issues

 - Mobile phones
 - International roaming on mobile phones can be <u>extremely</u> expensive depending on your phone contract
 - E.g. with my French phone
 - » USD 2.50 per minute to make voice calls
 - » USD 17.50 per MB for data
 - » Receiving calls is also charged
 - You need to pay yourselves for items that are not included in the fee
 - Should not charge anything to your rooms, pay in cash or with credit card
