9 exhibitors, 2 sponsors (NuPECC for prizes)












Timing of the 58 presentations





based on 'EXCHANGE AGREEMENT'

- up to 20% of the total ENSAR2 for transnational access (TA)
- cover local expenses only
- to work BI-directionally (EU researcher going abroad, NON-EU researchers coming to EU).
- So, if European users go to these facilities, they can ask for support!

EURISOL – Distributed Facility (DF) new timeline

> ESFRI roadmap 2021:

next call launched by ESFRI in June 2019.

deadline to submit the proposals - Jan. 2020

official announcement of selected projects in October 2021.

Preparation time-line for the EURISOL-DF Steering Committee:

- Executive Summary finalised by the end of November 2018
- Preparation of EURISOL-DF brochure and Printed version of the Executive Summary November 2018 – February 2019
- Meetings with funding agencies in order to ensure a support from at least 3 EU countries (France, Italy, CERN, Belgium, and also Finland, Poland,...)

from January 2019 onwards
