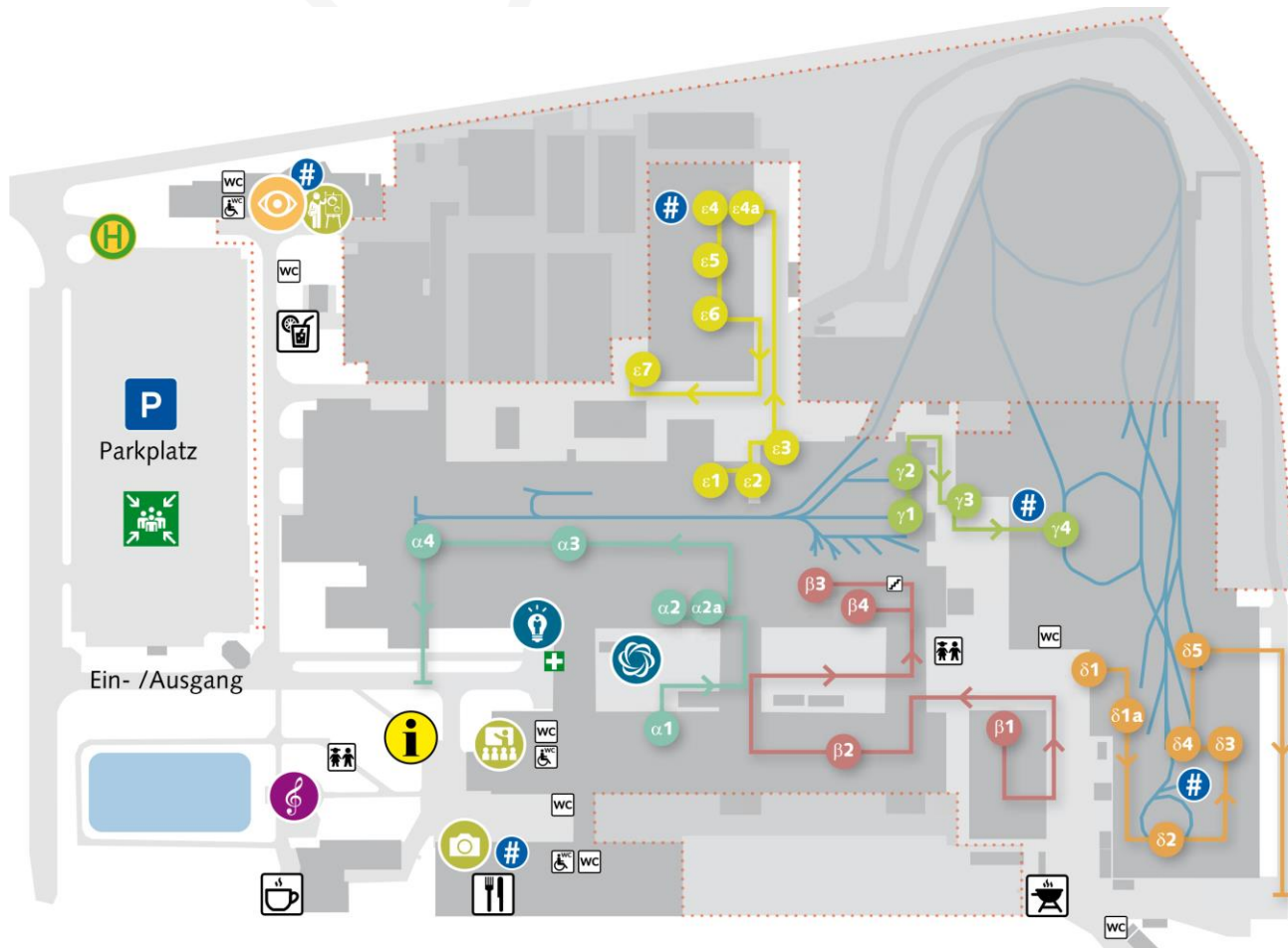

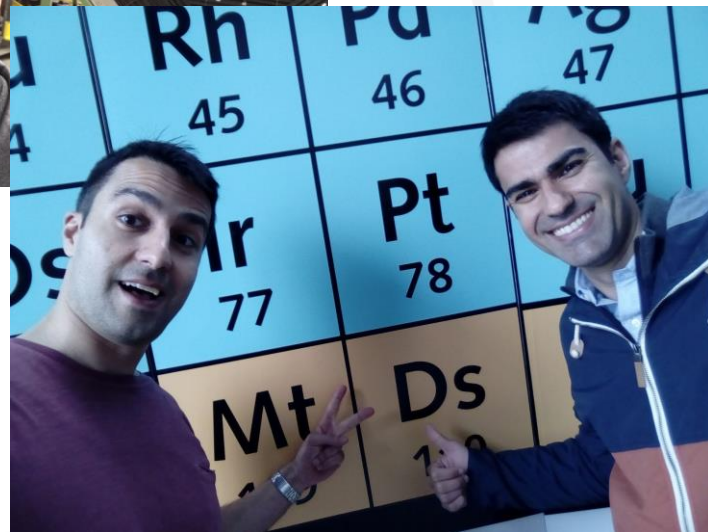
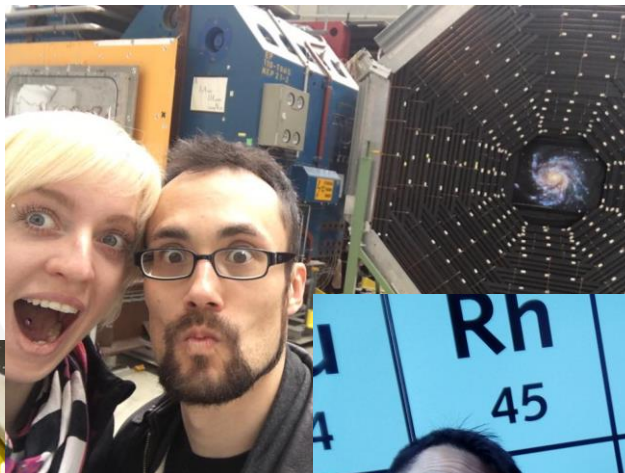

 - Moving people away from the campus “hot spots”



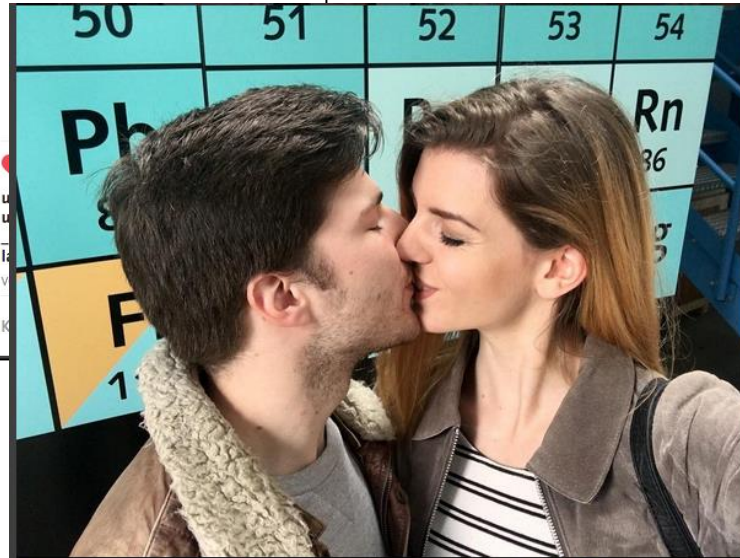

Some Conclusions

- We are the **Exhibitions, Exhibits and Activities Working Group**
 - **Exhibition:** A public display of Exhibit components and Activities
 - Something specific to a location or an event
 - Usually expensive and challenging to create
 - Typically expensive to send around to different places
 - **Exhibit:** A component or set of components used in Exhibitions or Activities
 - Can be specific to an audience and/or physics topic
 - Used to aid in understanding a concept
 - Describable with a recipe
 - **Activity:** Exercise for students or public often using some hands-on components
 - Also specific to an audience / topic
 - Also designed to understand a concept
 - Describable with a recipe

Working Group Existential Discussion

Our Input

- Information on inspiring stories about exhibitions, exhibits & activities (past, present or future)

Our Primary Output

- Activities for classrooms to be put in IPPOG database

Processing Power

- The Working Group (in identifying activities & material)
- CERN HST Working Groups (in helping to find additional activities and curation)

Working Group Existential Discussion

Future Meeting Structure
