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Site-specific issues:

1) 11/8: BU_ATLAS_Tier2_MCORE - job failures with stage-in errors ("STAGEIN FAILED: Get error: Staging input file failed"). Site had attempted to replace the LSM with the rucio copytool (via AGIS), but had to revert the change until the problem is understood. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=138180 was closed on 11/9. eLog 67599.

2) 11/13: BNL-OSG2 MCTAPE - file transfer errors ("SOURCE SRM_GET_TURL error on the turl request : [SE][StatusOfGetRequest][SRM_INVALID_PATH]"). Issue was actually on the destination end (RO-02-NIPNE_DATADISK), and being tracked in ggus ticket https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=138030. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=138289 was closed early a.m. on 11/14. eLog 67579.

3) 11/14: User reported a problem with some jobs from an Event Index task running at

SLACXRD, due to a failure accessing input files. Issue seemed to be a transient one, as the input files were accessible later the same day when the user re-tried the jobs.

Follow-ups from earlier reports:

(i) 11/5: OU_OCHEP_SWT2 - heavy failover from the site to the Frontier backup proxies. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=138102 in progress.
