# Python 2.6

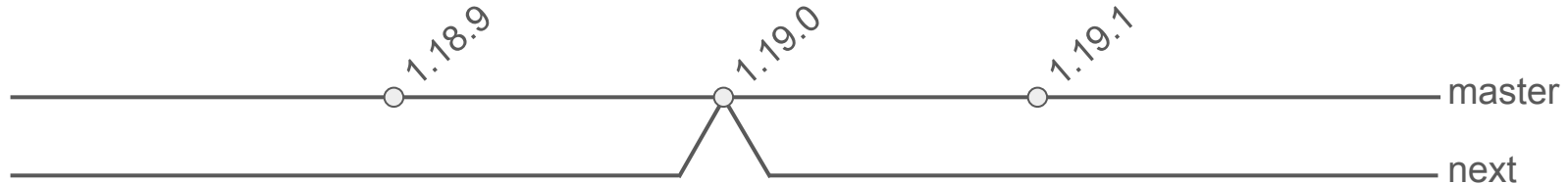
