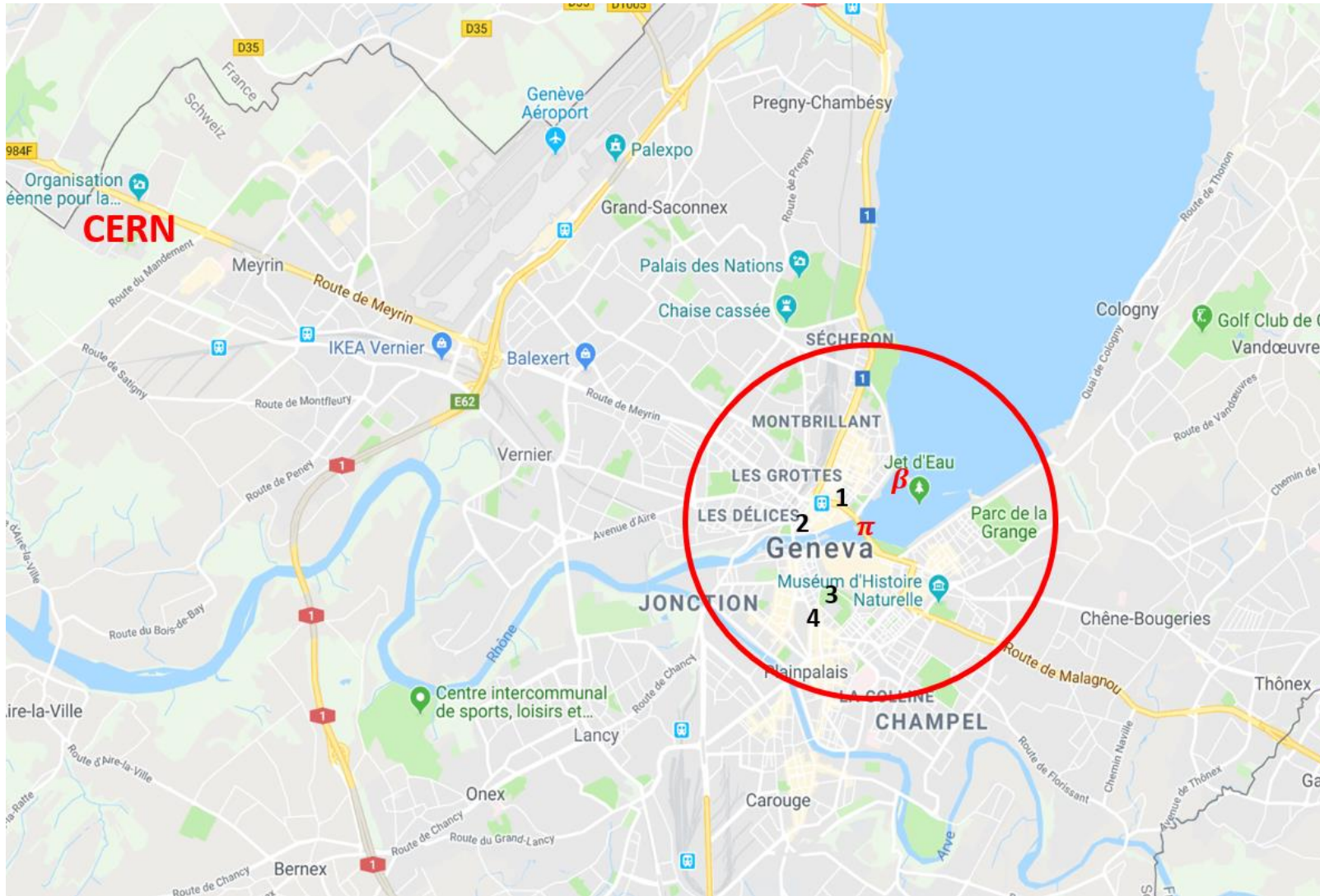


A couple of tips about Geneva

and how to get there



To get downtown:

Tram **18** from the stop in front of CERN reception at Building 33 (any direction)

To come back to CERN from downtown:

Tram **18** direction CERN

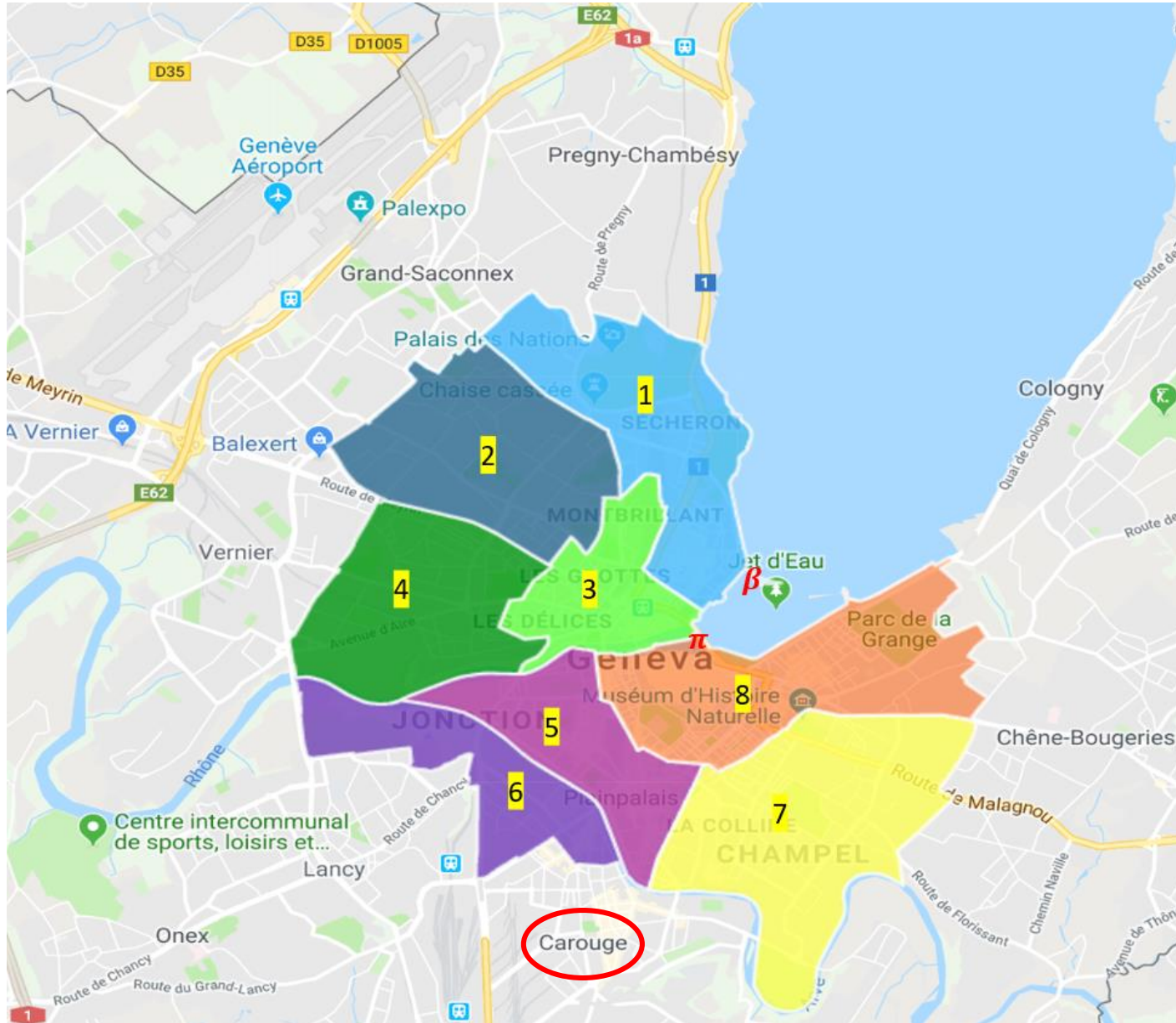
Convenient stops of the tram 18, downtown:

- 1-Gare Cornavin (train station)
- 2-Bel-Air
- 3-Place de Neuve
- 4-Plainpalais

Tram tickets to be bought at the machines that are present at the stops, right before each ride
- select the ticket *Tout Genève* which is valid 1h since it's issued
(cost is CHF 3.- , machines accepts CHF coins, euro coins, credit and debit cards)



Most lively neighborhoods in Geneva:

- 1 - Perle du Lac, Bains des Pâquis & Pâquis
- 3 - Grottes
- 5 - Jonction & Plainpalais
- 8 - Old town & Eaux Vives

Other neighborhoods:

- 2 - Servette, Petit-Saconnex
- 4 - Saint-Jean, Charmilles
- 6 - Acacias Bâtie
- 7 - Champel

Recommended:

Visit *Bains des Pâquis*(β) and the lake promenade from Pont du Mont Blanc(π) to Perle du Lac, or to Eaux Vives.

Next to Geneva, at the end of the Tram 18 line, you can reach the wonderful old town of Carouge. Also recommended.
