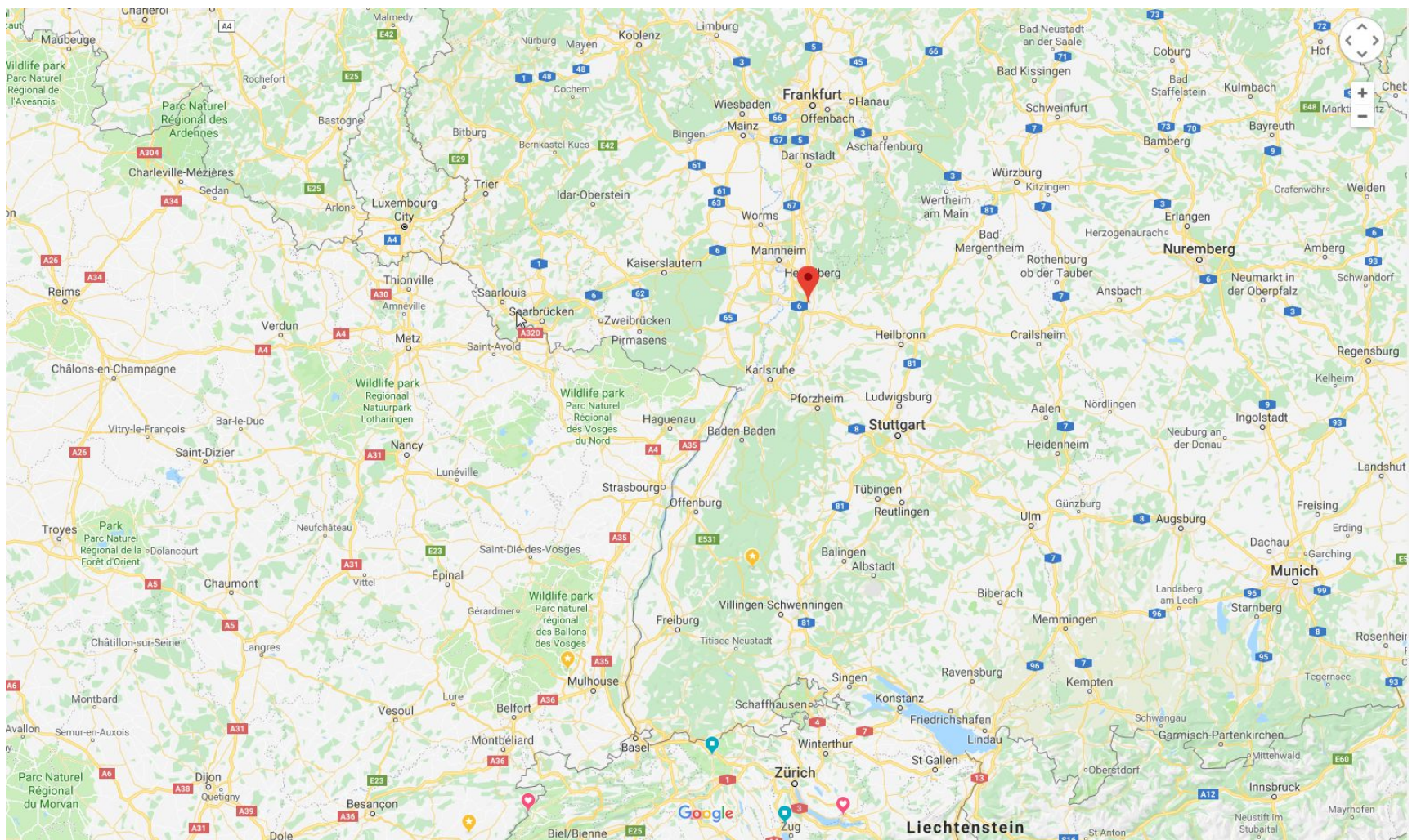

- Shape the future ROOT Web GUI

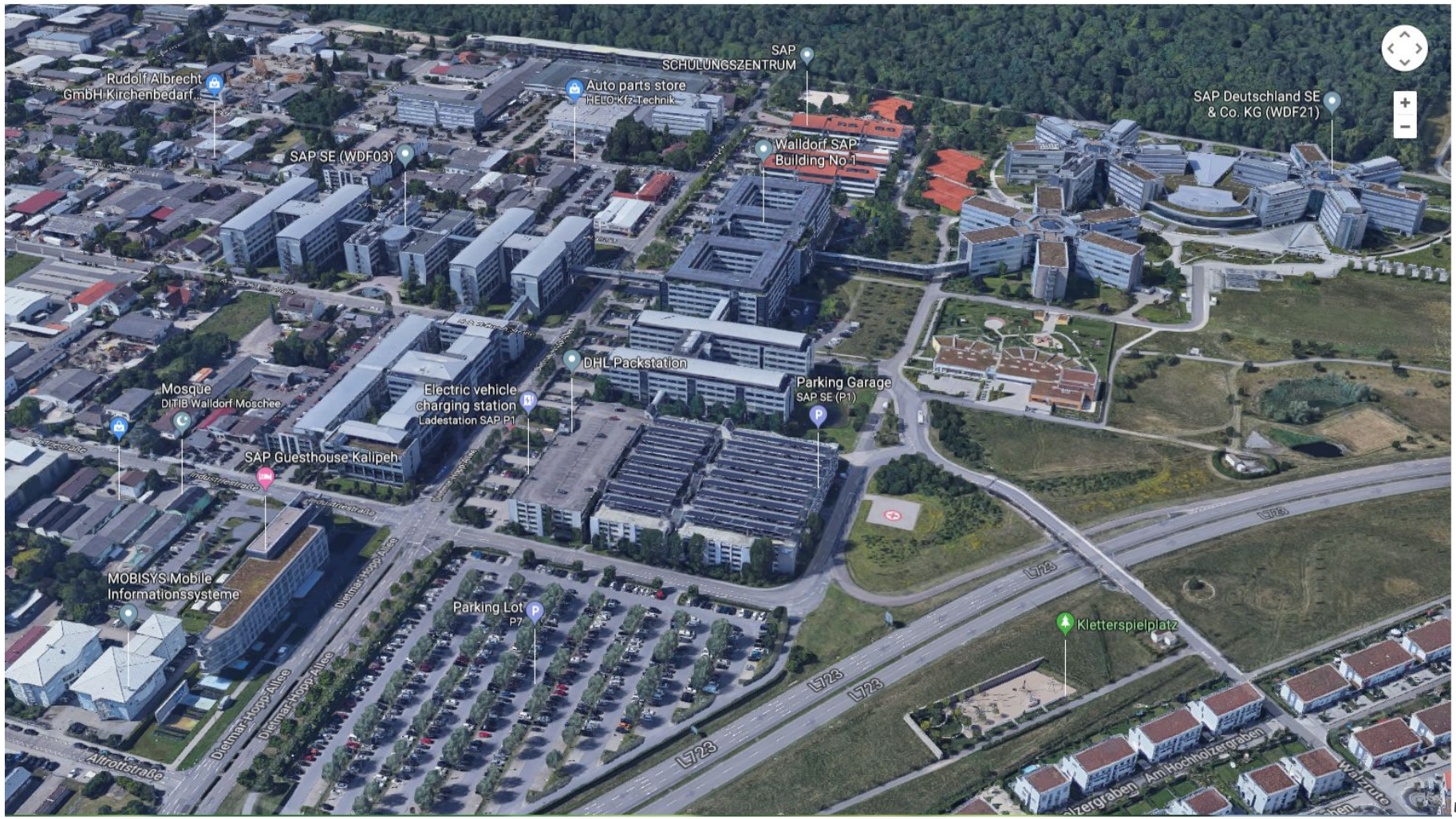
