

2019 Trans-European School on High Energy Physics (July 12-21), Baltic Countries

In terms of organization, the 2019 TESHEP event could potentially combine several actions: the TESHEP itself, dedicated half-day conference in the National University of your choice, and the meeting of the French-Ukrainian Associated Laboratory. This year, it will be the 13th edition of the TESHEP following the first school in 2007 in Mukachevo. Any special events can be organized in addition. The website of the school series:

The major requirement to accommodation is that all students and professors stay in the same isolated resort, which ensures lodging, centrally served meals to participants, and have a meeting room with projectors for 50 people. A good quality internet connection is mandatory at least in the conference room and around it.

1. The TESHEP itself starts on July 13 in the morning, and ends on July 20 in the evening. This assumes the arrival on July 12 in the evening, and departure on July 21 in the morning.

We count on 40 attendants (students) to be lodged in the double rooms (20 rooms), and 20 attendants (professors) to be lodged in the single rooms (20 rooms). If we can keep some flexibility (plus or minus 2 double rooms and plus or minor 2 single rooms) until middle of June, this will be highly appreciated.

The conference room is needed for the whole duration of the school, starting on July 13 in the morning, and until July 20 in the evening.

The meals are needed from late dinner on July 12 until an early breakfast on July 21.

Coffee breaks (two per day) are needed July 13 - July 20.

2. Social events:

- one light welcome drink - before or after the dinner on July 12 or July 13 (for example wine/juice/water + 1-2 different fruit types).
- one school/conference dinner, possibly "upgraded" dinner at the resort site
- one afternoon excursion in the afternoon.

3. Transportation:

- Arrival and departure days from the airport and the railway station. Few trajectories to/from the station will be needed.
- Excursion for 40-50 participants.
- Transportation to/from the University on the conference day.
