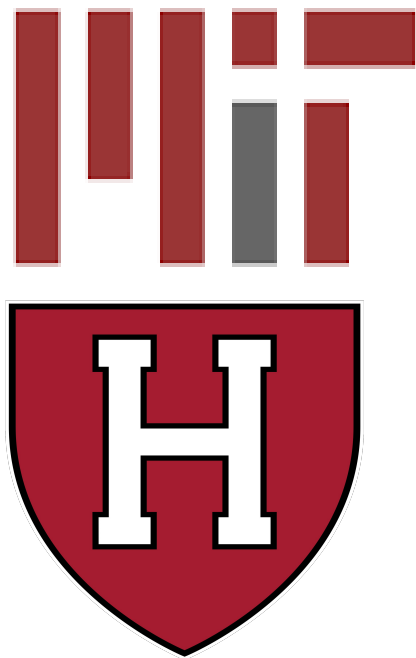

- Dinner will be at the MIT Samberg Center

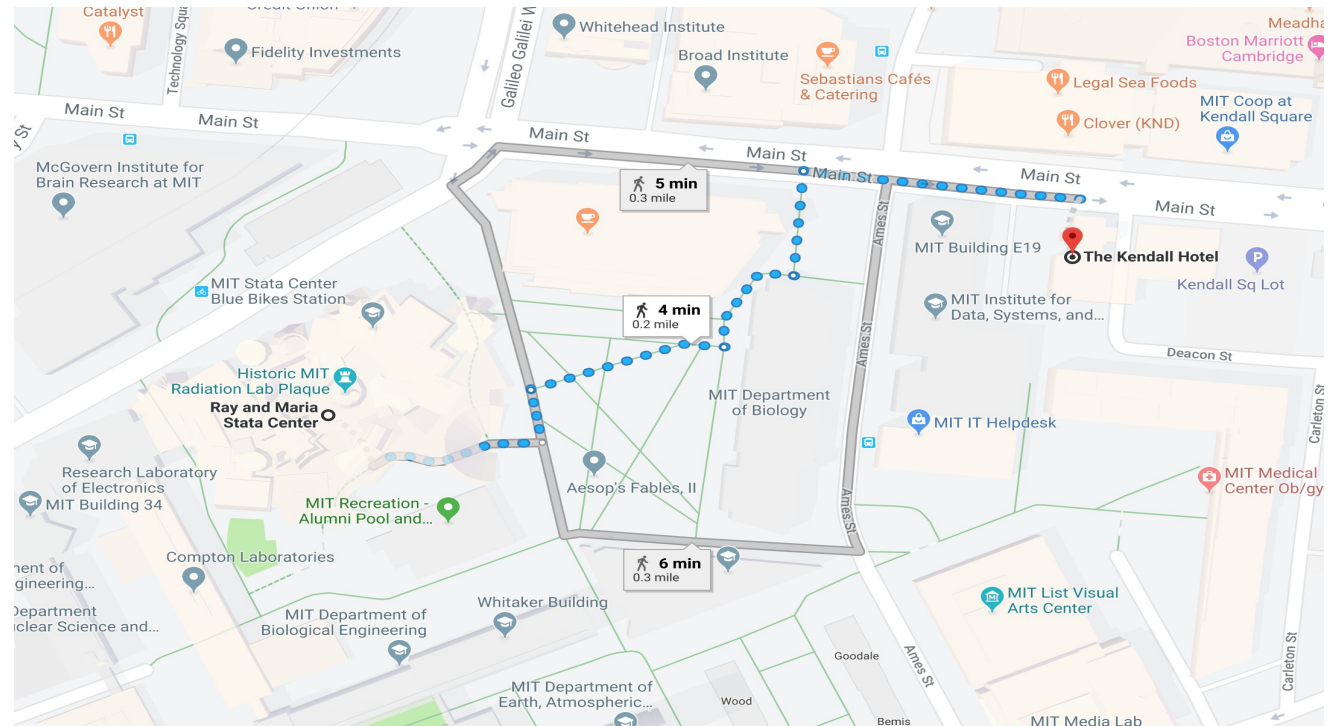

  - 5 Min walk

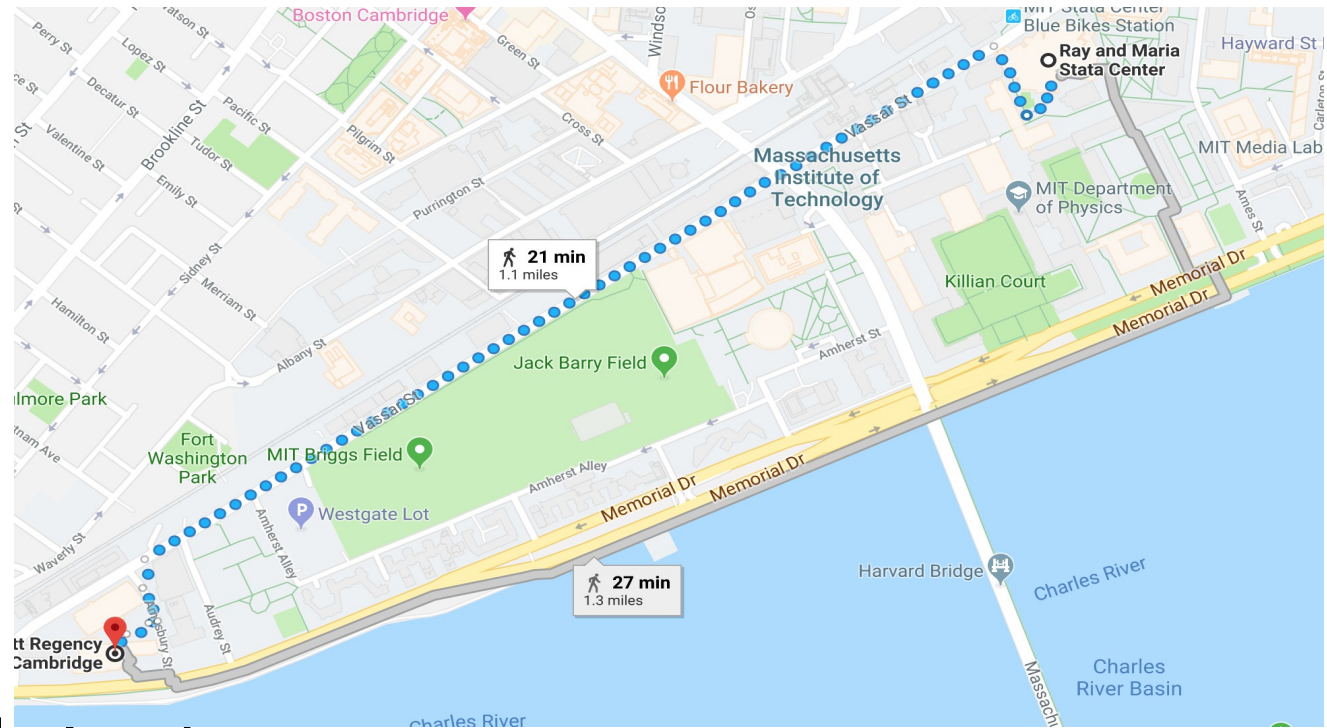

- Currently do not foresee support for invited guests

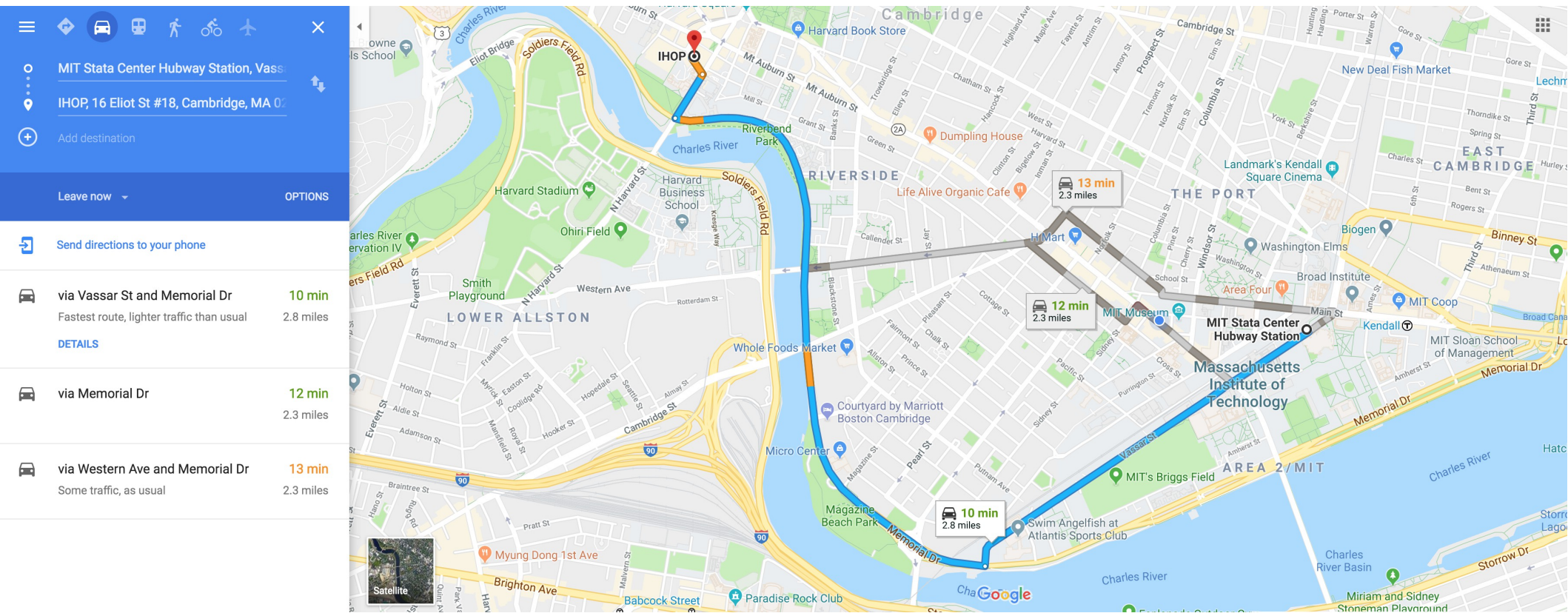
