

### **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions**

European Commission



#### ITN

#### Innovative Training Networks

#### What does it offer?

High-quality research training delivered through international and interdisciplinary networks, industrial

doctorates or joint doctorates

#### Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and nonacademic sectors

#### Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral level (less than four years of full-time research experience and no doctoral degree)



#### IF

#### Individual Fellowships

#### What does it offer?

Opportunities to work on personal research projects by moving between countries and possibly sectors to acquire new skills

#### Who applies?

Individual researchers together with the host organisation

#### Who is funded?

Postdoctoral researchers



#### RISE

#### Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

#### What does it offer?

The exchange of staff members involved in research and innovation to develop sustainable collaborative projects and the transfer of knowledge

#### Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

#### Who is funded?

Researchers, technical, administrative and managerial staff of any nationality and at all career levels



#### COFUND

### Co-Funding of Regional, National and International Programmes

#### What does it offer?

Regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development

#### Who applies?

Organisations funding or managing doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes

#### Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral and postdoctoral level





### What does Marie Skłodowska-Curie offer?

- Postdoc and PhD positions abroad
- Mobility through exchanging staff and knowledge
- Promoting researchers' career development
- Fair and attractive working conditions
- Cooperation between academia and non-academic sector
- Key skills and training for researchers

### **MSCA Mobility Rule!**

Fellow must not have lived and worked more than 12 months within the last 3 years (prior to the deadline) in the potential host country!



### **MSCA Classification of Research Experience**

MSCA classification	Status	Research experience after graduation
Early Stage Researchers (ESR)	PhD student	< 4 years
Experienced Researchers (ER)	Postdoc	≥ 4 years





### **MSCA Innovative Training Networks (ITN)**

ITN offer financial support for structured doctoral training for 4 years

**Type of action**: training networks with European/international partners

Who is qualified:

**European Training Networks (ETN)**: consortia consisting of at least 3 organisations (universities, research institutes, enterprises etc.) from different EU Member States (MS) and/or Associated Countries (AC)

**European Industrial Doctorates (EID)**: consortia consisting of at least 2 organisations from different sectors and from different EU MS and/or AC

**European Joint Doctorates (EJD):** consortia consisting of at least 3 organisations from different EU MS and/or AC

**Activities**: research projects, (intersectoral) secondments, training courses (scientific and transferrable skills), summer schools, etc.

**Duration of funding**: 4 years

**Topic of the project**: open to all fields of research

What will be funded:

Researchers: salary, supplementary allowance for research and travel costs

**Applying organisations**: contributions for training and networking activities, conferences, coordination,

management and indirect costs

Application: online at specific deadlines





### MSCA Research and Innvation Staff Exchange (RISE)

Type of action: international and inter-sector collaboration through research and innovation staff exchanges

Who is qualified:

**International stream**: at least 1 institution outside Europe and 2 institutions from different MS and/or AC. **Inter-sector stream**: at least 1 participant from each of the 2 sectors and from at least 2 different MS and/or AC

**Activities**: either intersectoral or international exchange of Early-stage and Experienced Researchers including administrative, managerial and technical staff, or a combination of both

**Duration**: maximum 540 person-months for maximum 4 years; duration of secondment phase per person: 1-12 months

Topic of the project: open for all fields of research

What will be funded:

**Exchanged staff**: Top-up allowance (unit cost of EUR 2,100 person/month)

**Applying organisations**: supplementary allowance for research, training and networking activities, conferences, coordination and management costs, lump sum for indirect costs

**Application**: online at specific deadlines

### MSCA Individual Fellowships (IF)

European Fellowship (EF)
Global Fellowship (GF)

- Target Group: experienced researchers
- Independent individual research project
- Proposal in liaison with a Host Institution
- Host Institution offers scientific & soft skill training
- Optional secondments, e.g. to the non-academic sector





### **European Fellowships (EF)**

 Funding of an individual research project in Europe (Member State or Associated Country

Eligibility

Postdocs or researchers with ≥4 years of research experience

Nationality

Researchers of any nationality

Mobility rule

Stays in the host country no longer than 12 months in the last 3 years

Duration

1-2 years





### Global Fellowships (GF)

 Funding of an individual research project in a Third Country (together with a European host)

Eligibility

Postdocs or researchers with ≥4 years of research experience

Nationality

nationals and long term residents of MS/AC

Mobility rule

Stays in the host country no longer than 12 months in the last 3 years

Duration

1-2 years outgoing phase

+ 1 year return phase in Europe

# PRIME – Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience

Description	Support the international mobility of postdoctoral researchers; 18 months: 12 months abroad at foreign host institution + 6 in Germany (reintegration)
Funding	18-month temporary job position at the selected German university (according to "TV-L 13": 3,500-4,500 €/month pre-tax), additional lump sum travel allowance for the time at the foreign host institution (12 month, 1,000 - 2,000 €/month)
Eligible	All nationalities, all ages ("scientific age" matters), PhD required before start of funding
Requirements	Host: German university; Foreign host: university, a non-university research institute, or an industrial research entity mobility rule!
Application process	First, application by the Postdoc directly through the DAAD Portal, all application documents can be uploaded online; Second, German host universities of selected Postdocs have to informally apply through the DAAD Portal in order to get the funding transferred to the University and ensure the employment of the Postdoc
Evaluation	Through two external reviewers with corresponding expertise; achievements of the applicant to date (scientific and other qualifications); quality of the proposed project and the consistency with long-term career planning;
Success rates	10-20 %; 2018/19: 12,9% (194 applications, 25 selected)
Call	Announcement: 1st May 2019; <b>Deadline: 30th August 2019</b> ; Earliest Start: 1st May 2020

### **Specifications of EU/MSCA funding**

- European added value!
- Calls for proposals with strict (!) deadlines
- EU projects support your mid-term/long-term strategy:
  - a) "time-to-grant" (max. 8 months from call deadline to project start)
  - b) MSCA highly competitive: success often only after re-submission(s)
- Open science (OA obligatory, OD as option)
- Gender aspects
- Ethics
- Documents: Work Programme, Guide for Applicants, Proposal templates, Ethics Guide...
- "Side effects" of EU/MSCA projects
  - gaining intercultural know-how
  - boosting your (international) career
  - building international networks (which often last way longer than the project itself)
  - recruiting excellent PhDs or Postdocs
  - fostering the international visibility of your research group/your institution
  - working with international experts on global challenges
  - •
