Current advances in research, development and application of artificial intelligence (AI) systems have yielded a far-reaching discourse on AI ethics. In consequence, a number of codes of ethics have been released in recent years. The talk uses those guidelines to give a broad overview of the many issues of AI ethics. It also focusses on general considerations about AI ethics, its effectiveness and the ways it can be put into practice.
