Q: Is there a map of the Kellogg Biological Station?

A: Please check out this **PDF** map.

Q: Where should I go to check in when I arrive?

A: Please go to the front desk of McCrary Dining Hall between 8AM and 4:30PM. The reception area is marked as a yellow star on the PDF map.

Q: What should I do if I arrive after 4:30PM?

A: After the front desk closes, there will be an envelope with each lodger's name situated between the double doors just inside this same building (McCrary Dining Hall).

Q: Roughly where are the accommodations located?

A: We will all be in the apartments located next to McCrary Hall on the map.

Q: What are the meal hours on site?

A: Breakfast is 7:30–8:30AM, lunch is 12:30–1:30PM and dinner is 6–7PM. Due to the limited staff on site, these hours are fixed and cannot be changed.

Q: I currently plan to arrive on Tuesday (24th) in time for dinner. However, I don't know whether there will be any unexpected delays. Are there other food options on site? A: Unfortunately, this is a very small campus, and there are no other food options on site. If you can make it by 7:30PM and email us in advance (by 6PM), we will pack a "dinner box" that will be left for you at the dining hall. If you arrive much later, it's probably best for you to get something else on the way.

Q: I have a car. Where can I park?

A: Everywhere on the map marked as parking is free to park for workshop participants. Please do NOT park in the area marked KBS FACULTY AND STAFF ONLY. You will get a parking ticket and fine, and there's nothing we can do about it.

Q: Where is the actual workshop location?

A: Academic Building on the map.

Q: What's the WiFi situation on site?

A: The entire KBS campus has WiFi. You can connect to EduRoam or use MSU guest network (you do not need a password but you do have to log in via a portal).

Q: I paid for the whole workshop but can only attend part of the workshop. Can I get a partial refund?

A: The majority of the workshop cost is subsidized (not from the registration fee), and advanced payments have already been made that are non-refundable.
