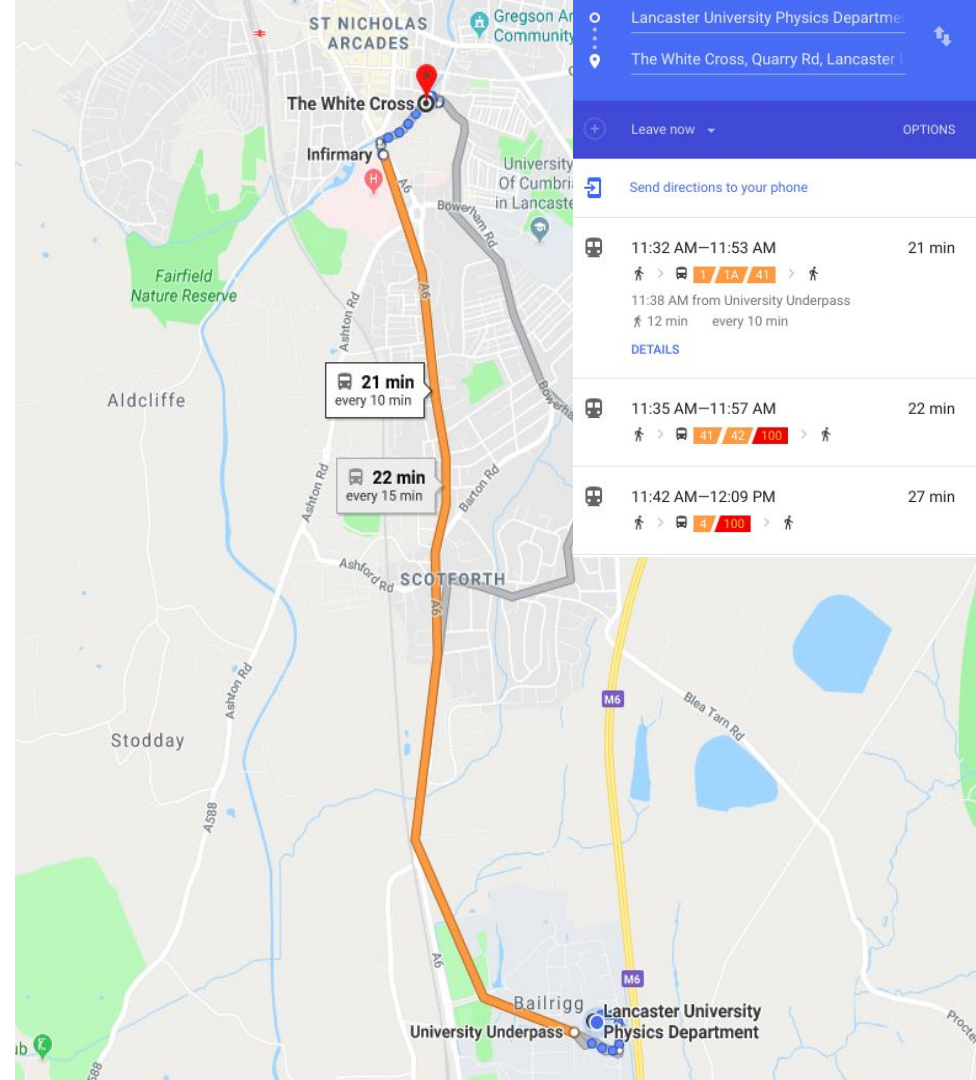


Evening Plan

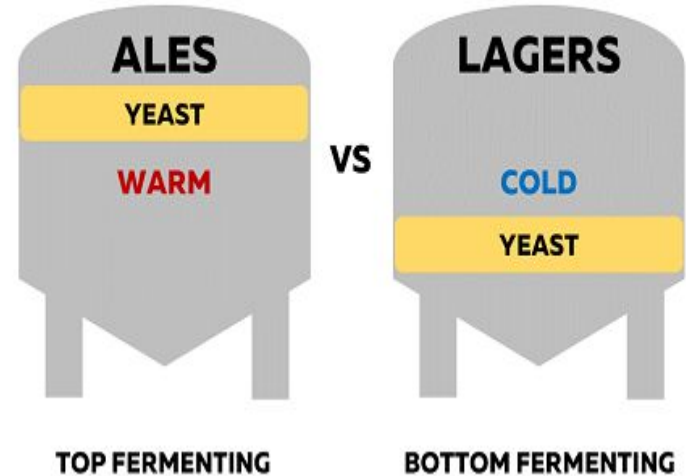
- Meet at the White Cross Inn

Ale vs Beer (or Lager)

- The UK is known for its “warm” beer, which is actually ale
- The main difference between ale and lager is the the temperature at it is brewed, and the yeast used in the process
- “Real” ale refers to “living” ales, those which still have yeast
 - They must also continue fermenting in the container (a cask) they will be served from
 - Serving must be done without extraneous use of CO2, which effects flavor

Brewery's (and beers) to try

- Lancaster Brewery
 - Founded 2002
 - 4 Classic beers, monthly guests
 - **Lancaster Red** - Ruby colour, malty, biscuity flavor
- Black Edge
 - Founded 2011
 - 7 Core beers, tonnes of guests
 - **Black Edge IPA** - Award winning IPA, citrusy and hoppy
- Tirril
 - Founded 1999
 - 5 Core beers, various guests
 - **Eden Valley** is a pale summer ale, very light and refreshing
- Hawkshead
 - Founded 2000
 - 11 Core beers
 - **Brodie's Prime Porter** - Dark chocolate and treacle aroma, surprisingly hoppy finish.
