Touch the **screen** of the tablet to activate it.

To optimize the quality of the projection, adjust the light at the switches located near the exit doors.

SPEECH MODE: **No display.** You can use **only microphones**.

PRESENTATION MODE: You can use **microphones** and **video projector**.

VIDEO CONFERENCE MODE: You can use **microphones**, **video projector** and **video conference**.

Choose the microphone you want to use

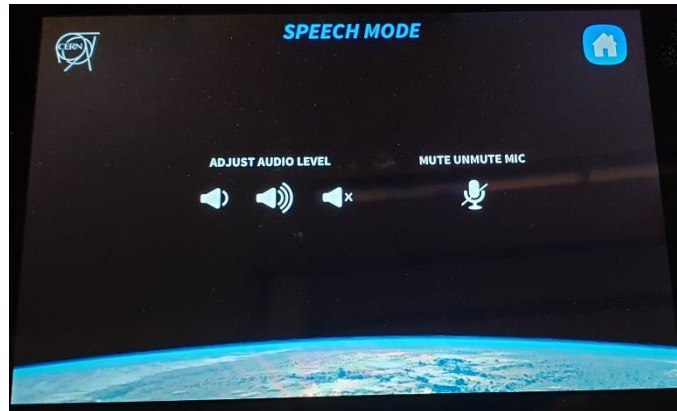


Take the wireless clip on microphone, the hand microphone or switch on the surface-mount mic by pushing its button. You can use different microphones simultaneously.



At the end of your event, do not forget to turn off the mics. Then unravel the cables and place your clip on mic/your hand mic at their dedicated charging station. The mics must be placed on the proper side and the charging station light should not

SPEECH MODE

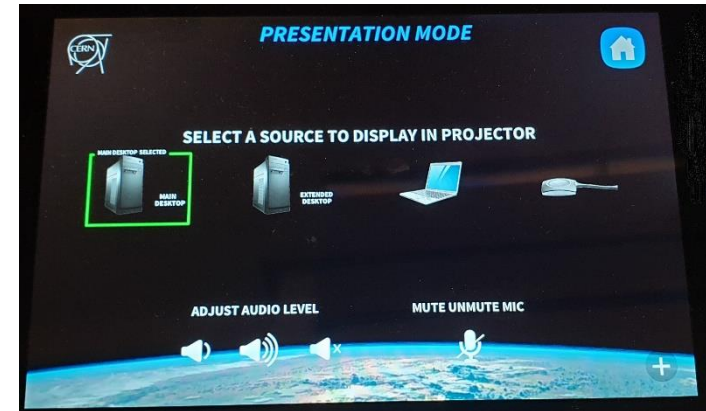


There is **no display** with this mode.

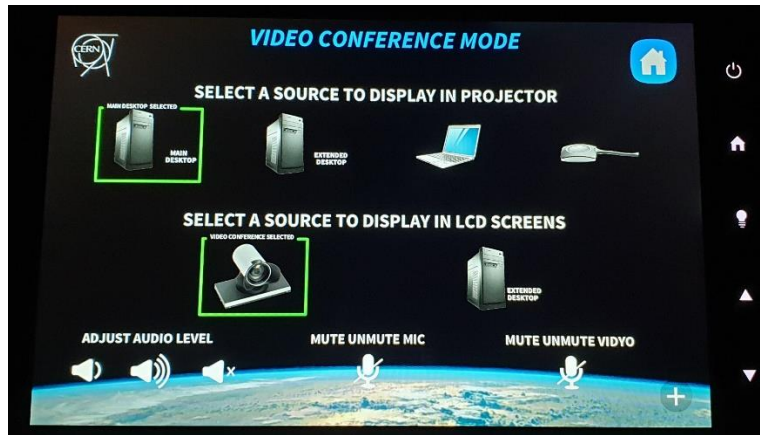
