- (v) 8/14: BNL Despite aggressive central deletions the storage occupancy is increasing. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket info&ticket id=142713.
- (vi) 8/29: NET2 job failures with the error "Unable to set the uid of the server process." https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=142901 in progress, eLog 70081.
- (vii) 9/9: BNL-ATLAS high number of squid hits on the Fermilab backup proxy. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=143055 in progress.

- (ix) 9/19: OU_OSCER_ATLAS source file transfer failures ("No such file or directory"). Some files appear to be missing from the storage, and may need to be declared lost. https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=143307 in progress. eLog 70225. Update 10/1: lost files were declared to rucio, so ggus 143307 was closed. eLog 70356.
- (x) 9/23: NET2 squid failovers from atlas-cm3.bu.edu to CERN backup proxy. https://ggus.eu/index.php?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=143341,
- (xi) 9/24: UTA_SWT2 file deletion errors ("Transport endpoint is not connected"). Same issue as reported in ggus 143331 (problem with a filesystem mount). Issue resolved, https://ggus.eu/?mode=ticket_info&ticket_id=143360 will be closed after verifying no additional errors. eLog 70275. Trying to understand this intermittent issue with the mount.

Update 9/27: A second issue on one of the gridftp servers was fixed (a service had failed to restart properly). Looks like all issues now resolved - ggus 143360 was closed on 9/29. eLog 70334.
