Results Summary

- ◆ 12 sites (11 T1 + 1 T0)
- ◆ Nine responded
- ◆ eight claim to have VOMS mappings (one did not clearly answer)
- ◆ six have mappings to shares, one an "equivalent" scheme, two gave unclear answers
- ◆ Three claim to publish to IS, other six said no
- ◆ Of the three, one does not publish and one is incorrectly published

Worries

- ◆ IN2P3 : compatibility desire seems backwards?
- ◆ CNAF thought they were publishing but are not
- ◆ Communication with ASGC

Questions

- ◆ Accounting : when will it have subdivisions for VOMS roles?
- ◆ Experiments : can you confirm whether you are getting what you asked at these sites?
