




## Practical Days at CERN on 5 and 6 March 2020 Organizational matters for the JUAS students

- After final check with the Head of Safety at CERN on 4 March morning, we maintain the program as foreseen
- For the **two** days
  - you have been informed of your **allocation** to the different labs
  - you will receive access cards, CERN map and buildings/rooms numbers
  - you should bring your **laptops**
  - students on the **Meyrin site** will receive lunch tickets for **restaurant 2**
  - students in the **RF groups** will pickup lunch tickets for **restaurant 3** at the checkout of the restaurant
  - the bus will bring you from ESI to CERN in the morning, enter the Meyrin site (estimated time 8:45) and Prévessin site (estimated time 9:15) and dispatch you in the vicinity of the labs
  - at the end of the day, you will have to return **by your own means** (or with the help of the lab supervisors) to the bus parked near the entrance of the Prévessin site (at 17:00) and Meyrin site (at 17:30)

## Practical Days at CERN on 5 and 6 March 2020 Presentations by the students on Monday 16 March 2020

- Students, in groups of 4 maximum, prepare oral reports on one of the subjects they have worked on during the practical days
- **Organizing the groups** for the oral reports is left to the students: a registration sheet for the oral report groups will be circulated
- The **oral presentations** (max 15 minutes) will be made on Monday 16 March morning and evaluated by a panel
- Each student of a group receives the mark given to the group (coefficient 3) based on the following **criteria**, of equal importance
  - Contents of the presentation: scientific & technical context of practical work, specific measurements performed, instruments used, precision, results & discussion
  - Form of the presentations: clarity of oral, fluency of English, quality of the slides, readability of drawings and graphs, timing
