Please find a summary of the CREMLINplus WP5 meeting that took place on September 27th:

1. The WP5 partners do required actions for the Grant preparation. All partners have signed DoH in time. Start of the CREMLINplus project is held on 1st February, 2020.

2. Content (budget, tasks, deliverables and milestones) of the WP5 was briefly reminded.

3. WP5 tasks were introduced by corresponding speakers. Speakers presented general plans and specific steps for the beginning.
