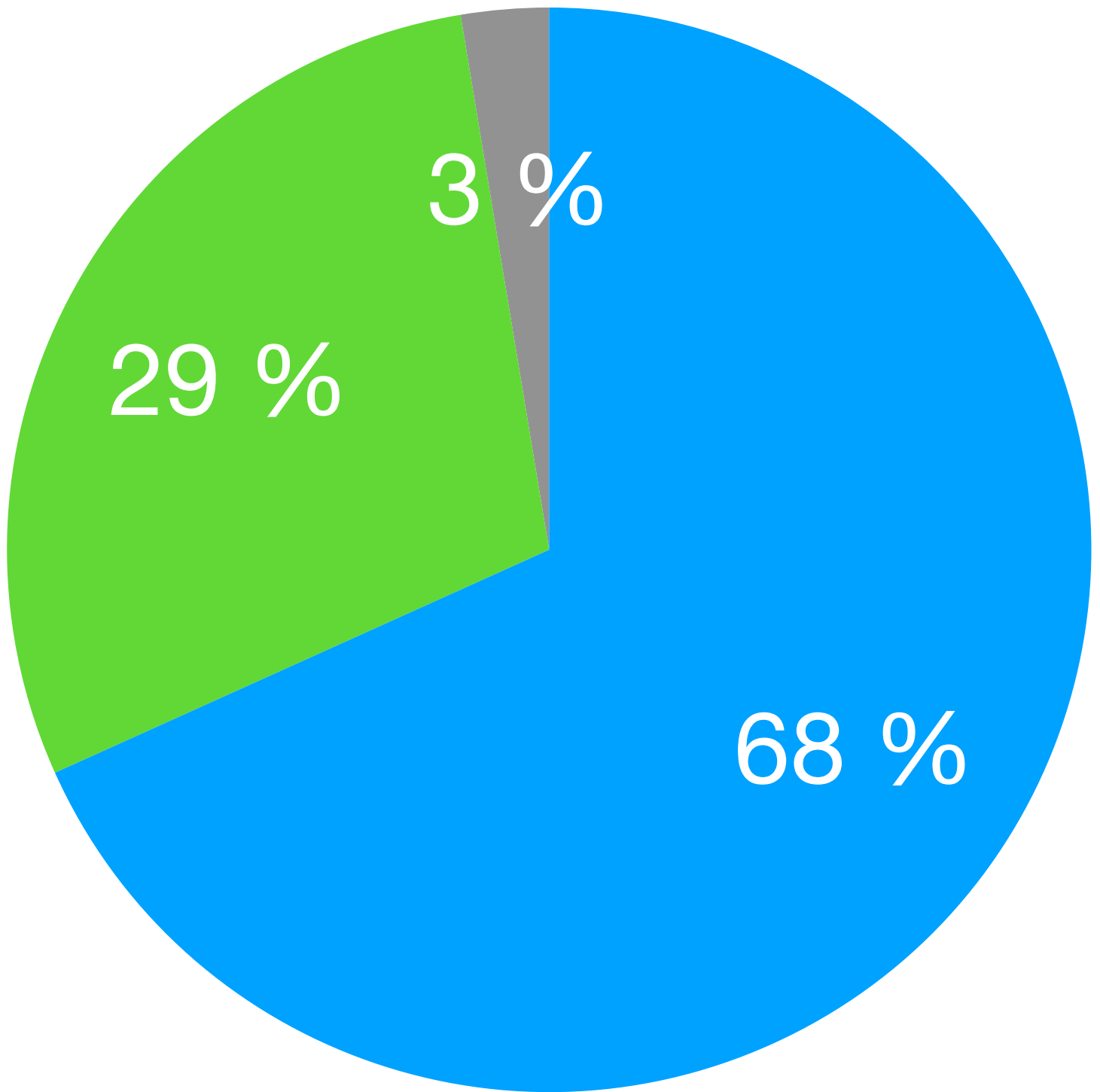
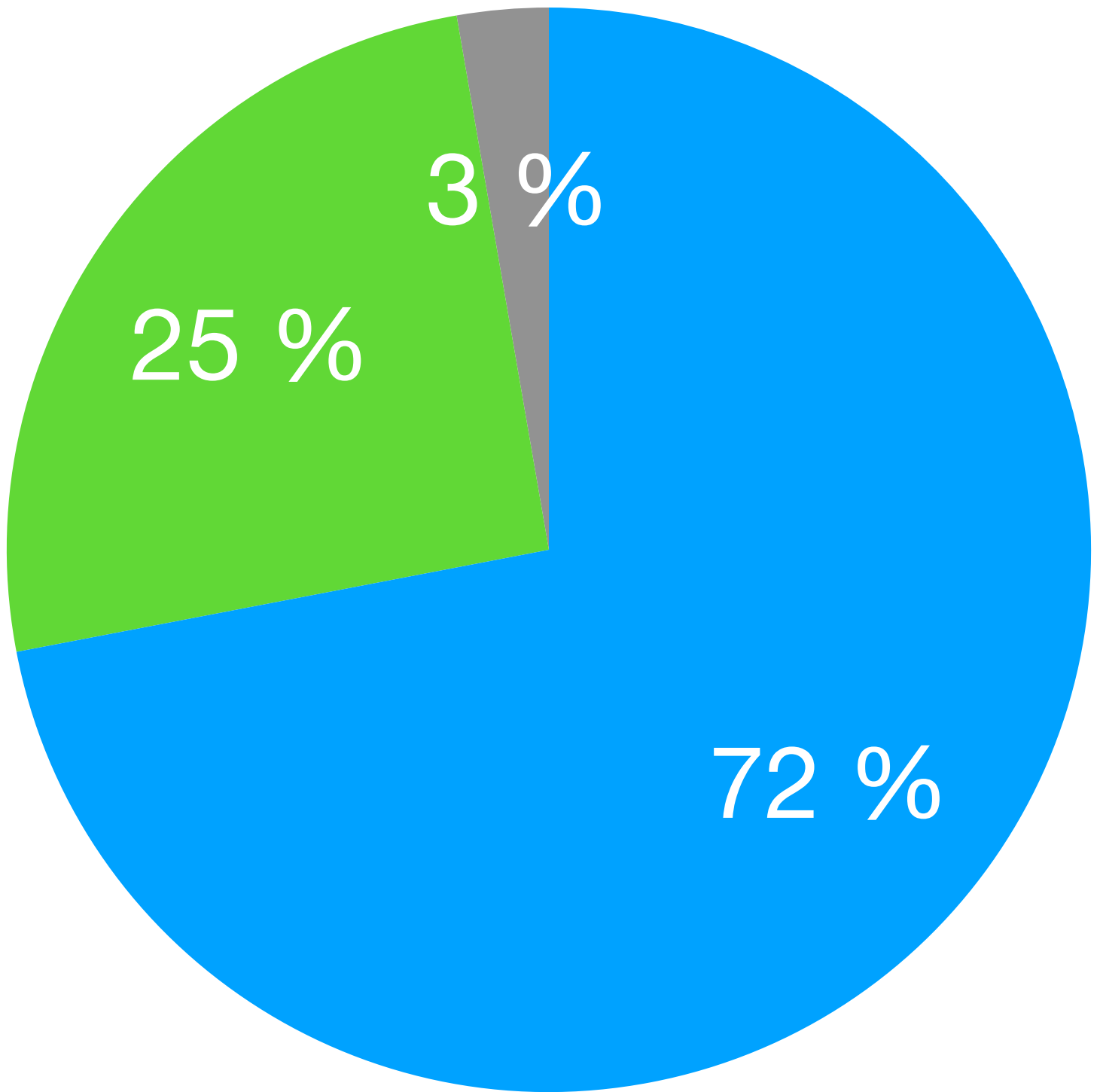


Distribution of participants & organisers by gender (1)

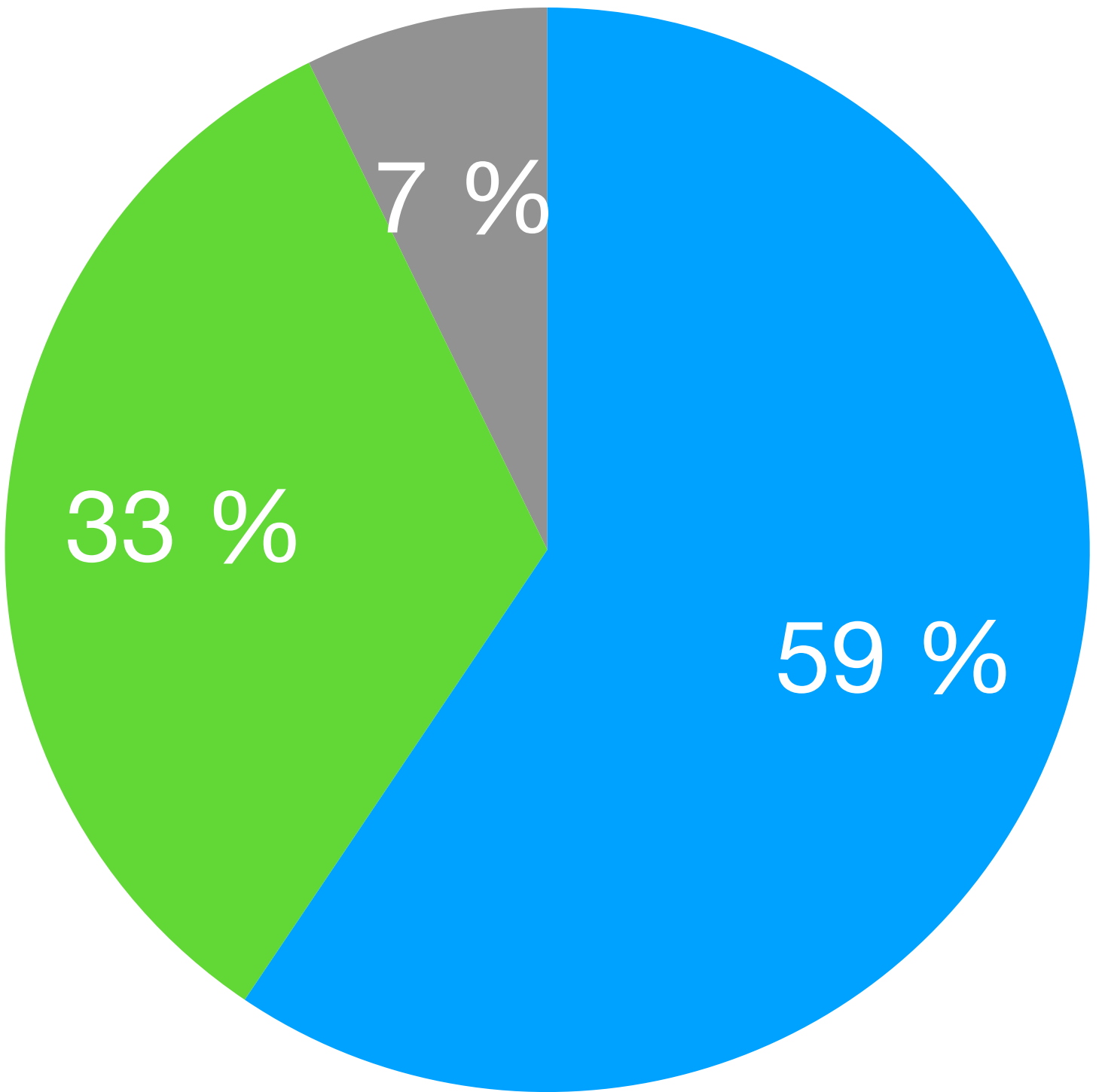

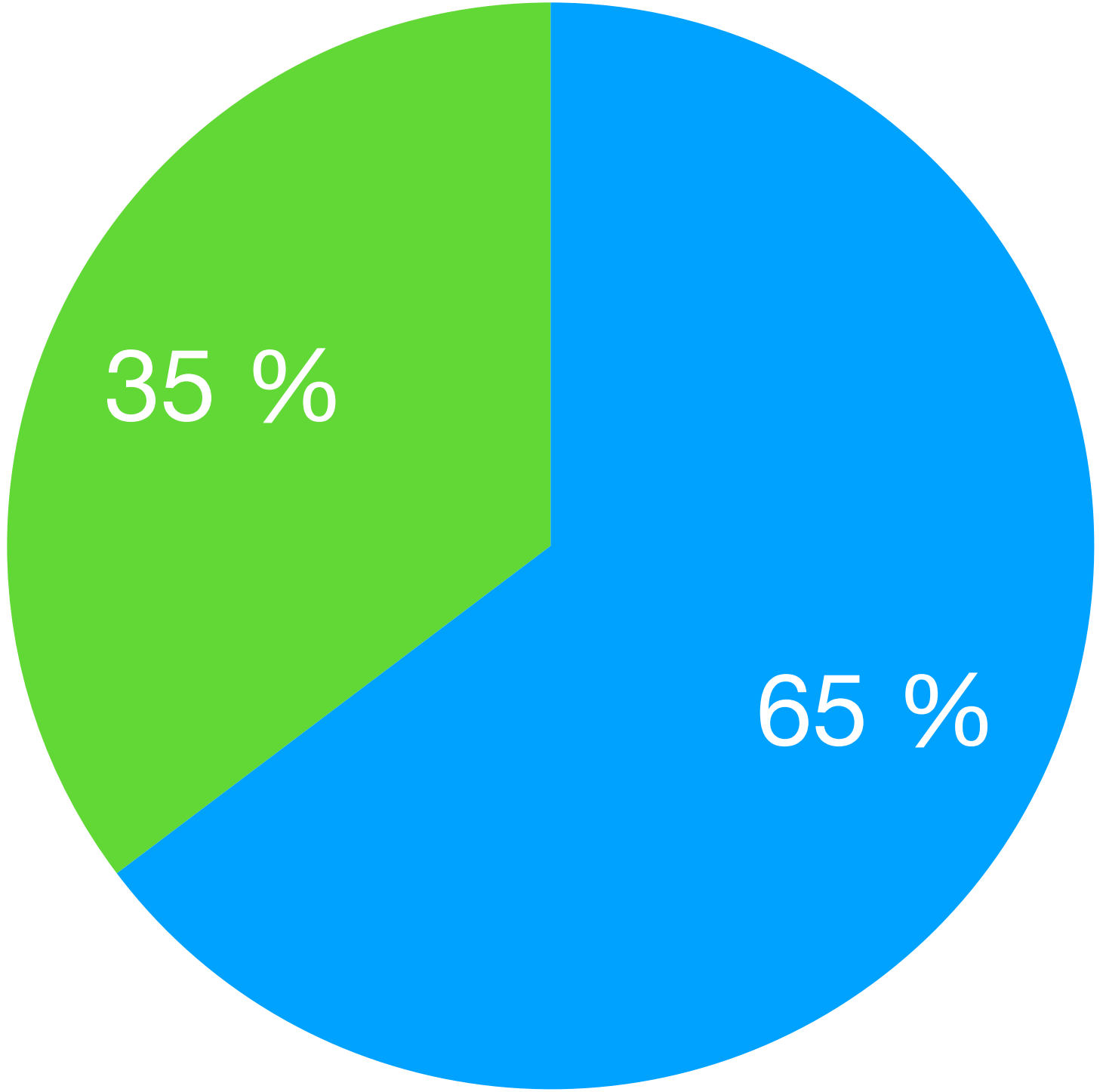

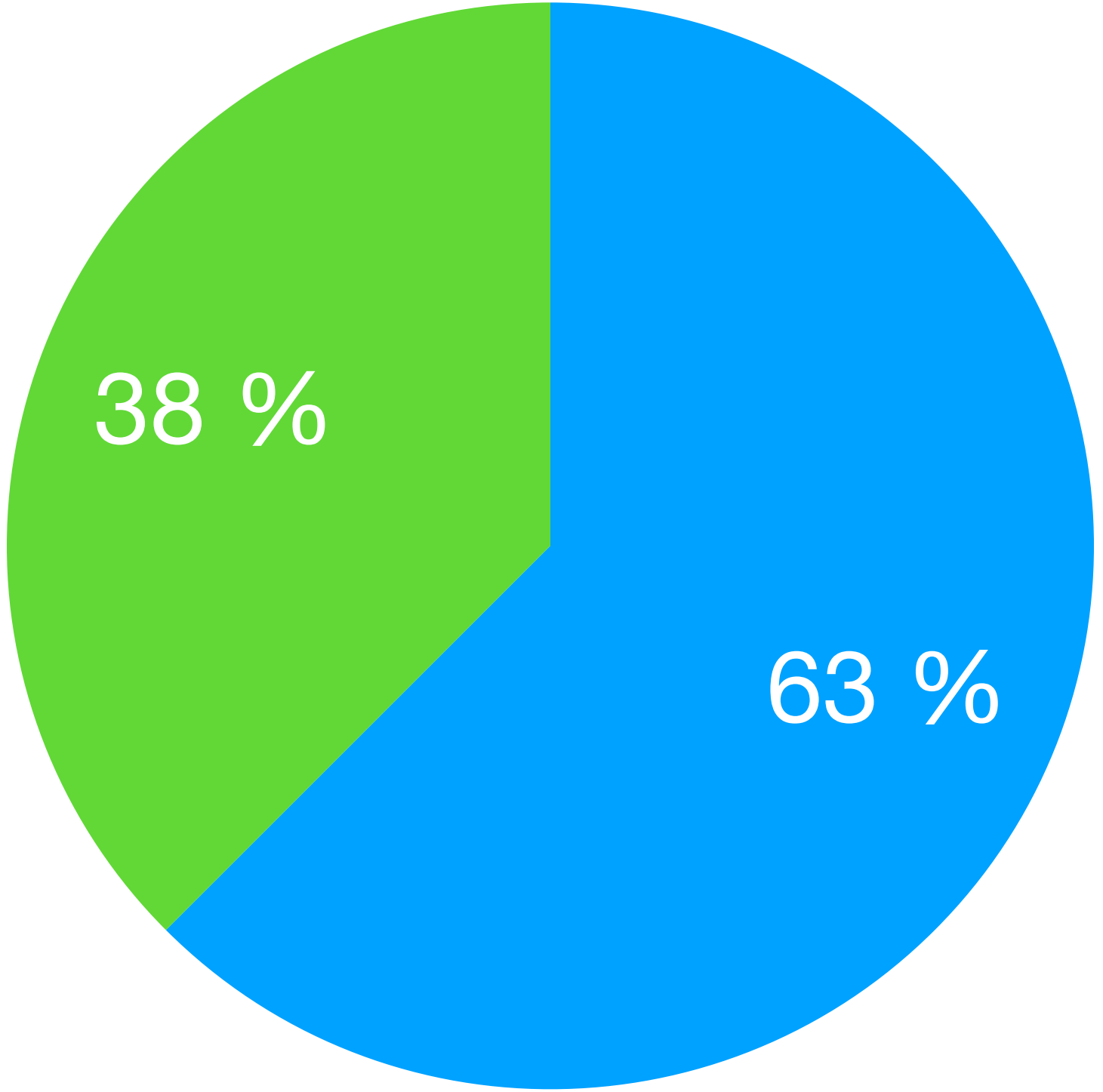

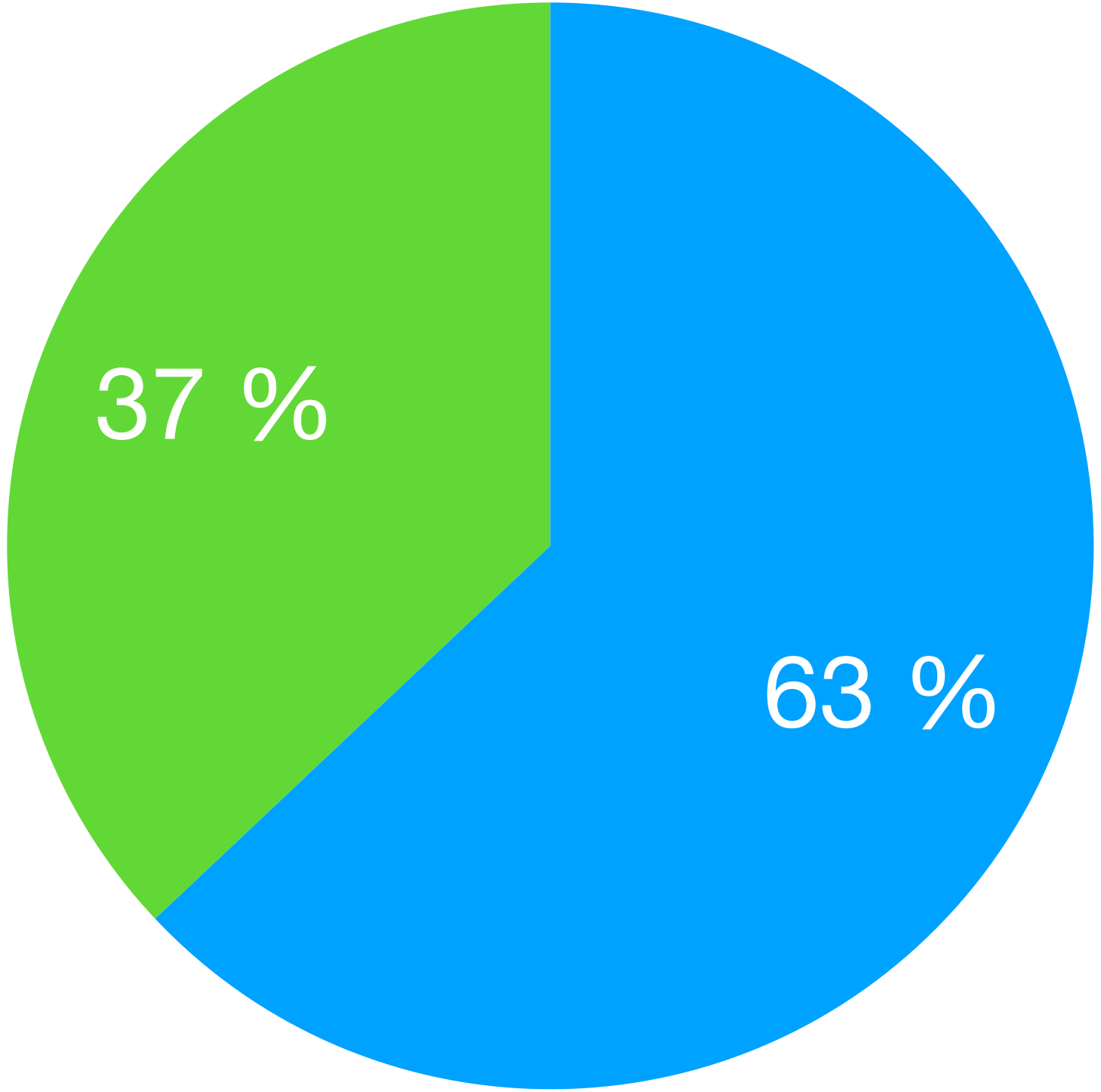

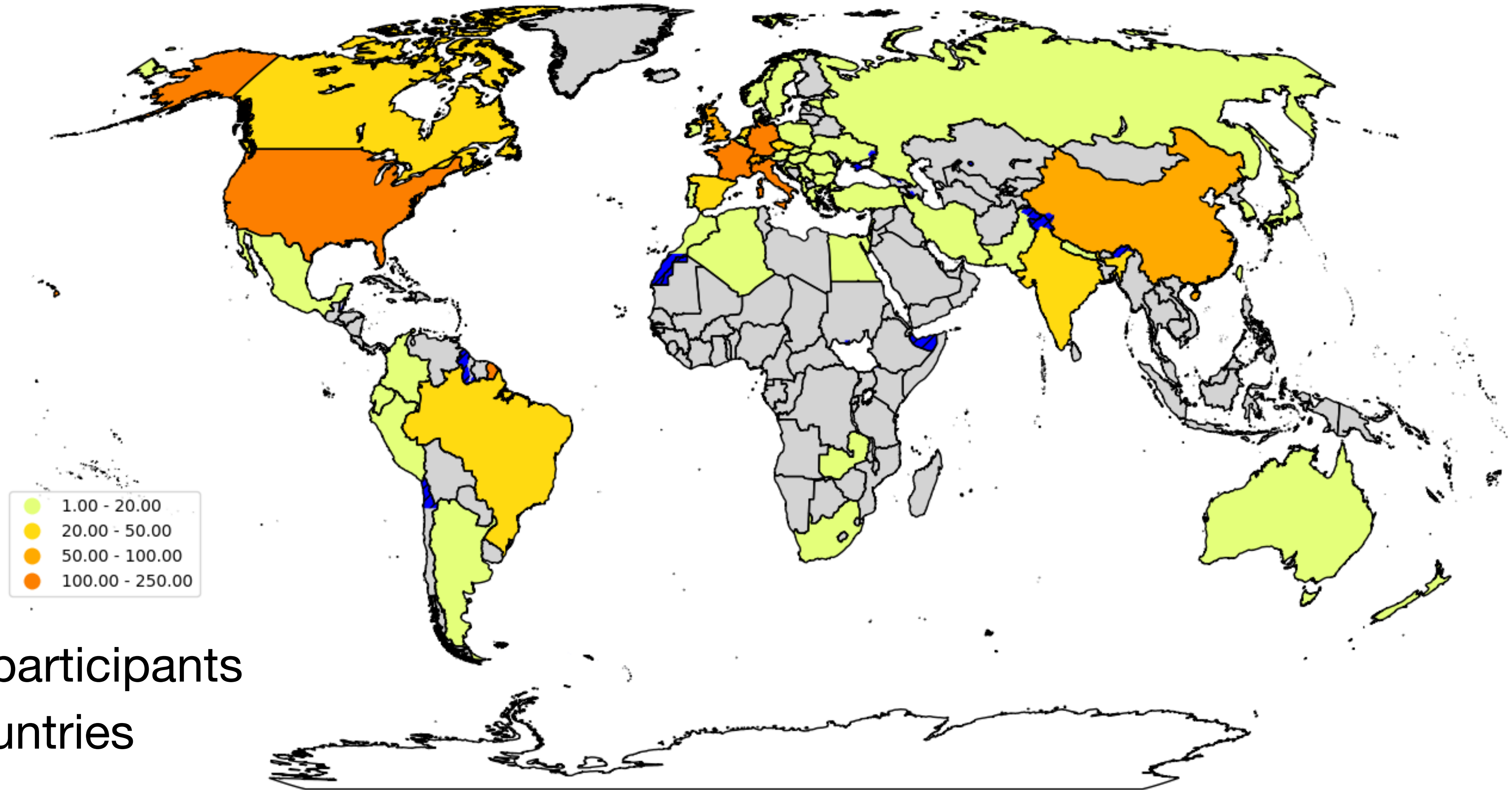

based according on institute declared in Indico registration form

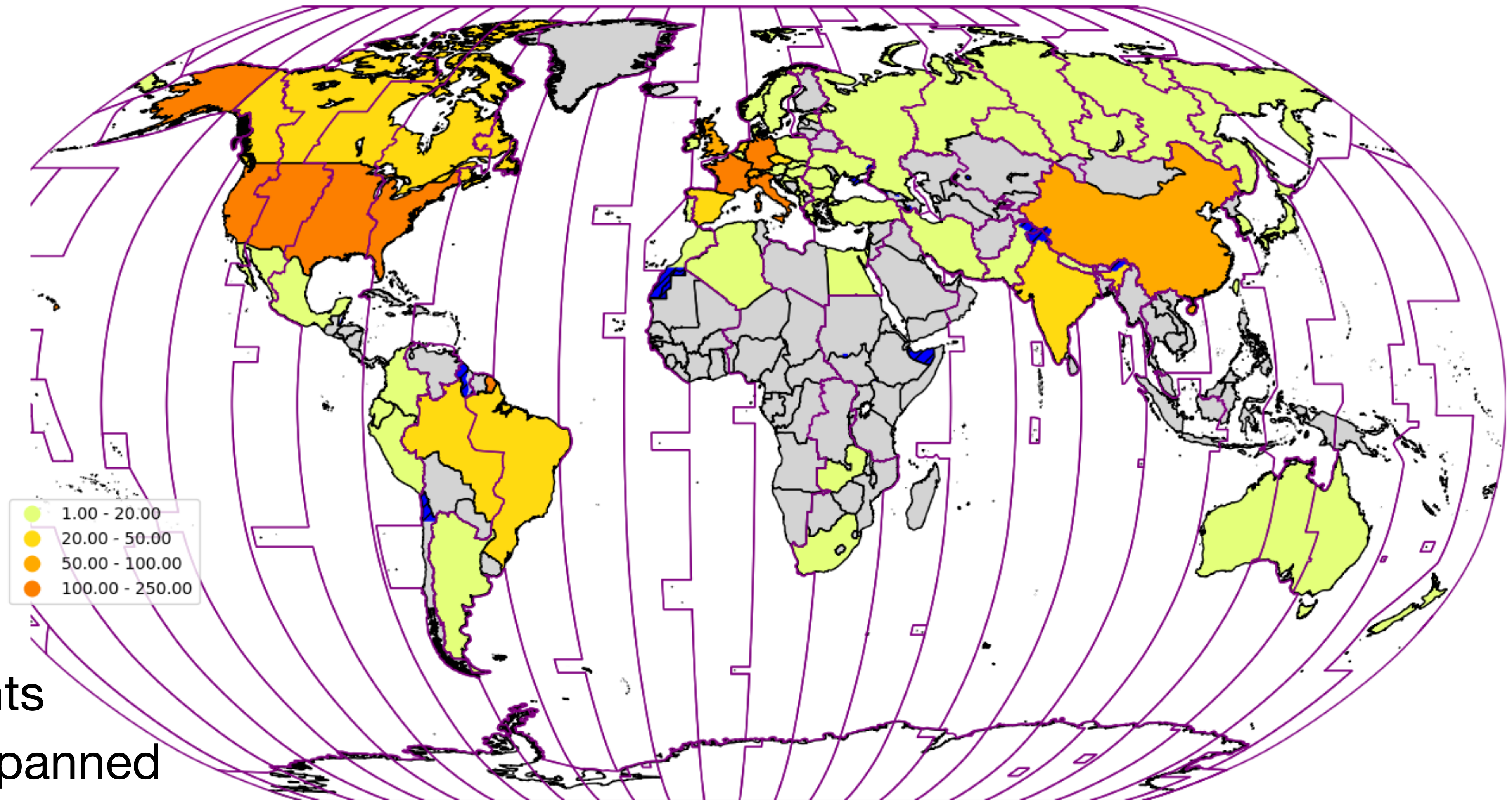

based according on institute declared in Indico registration form

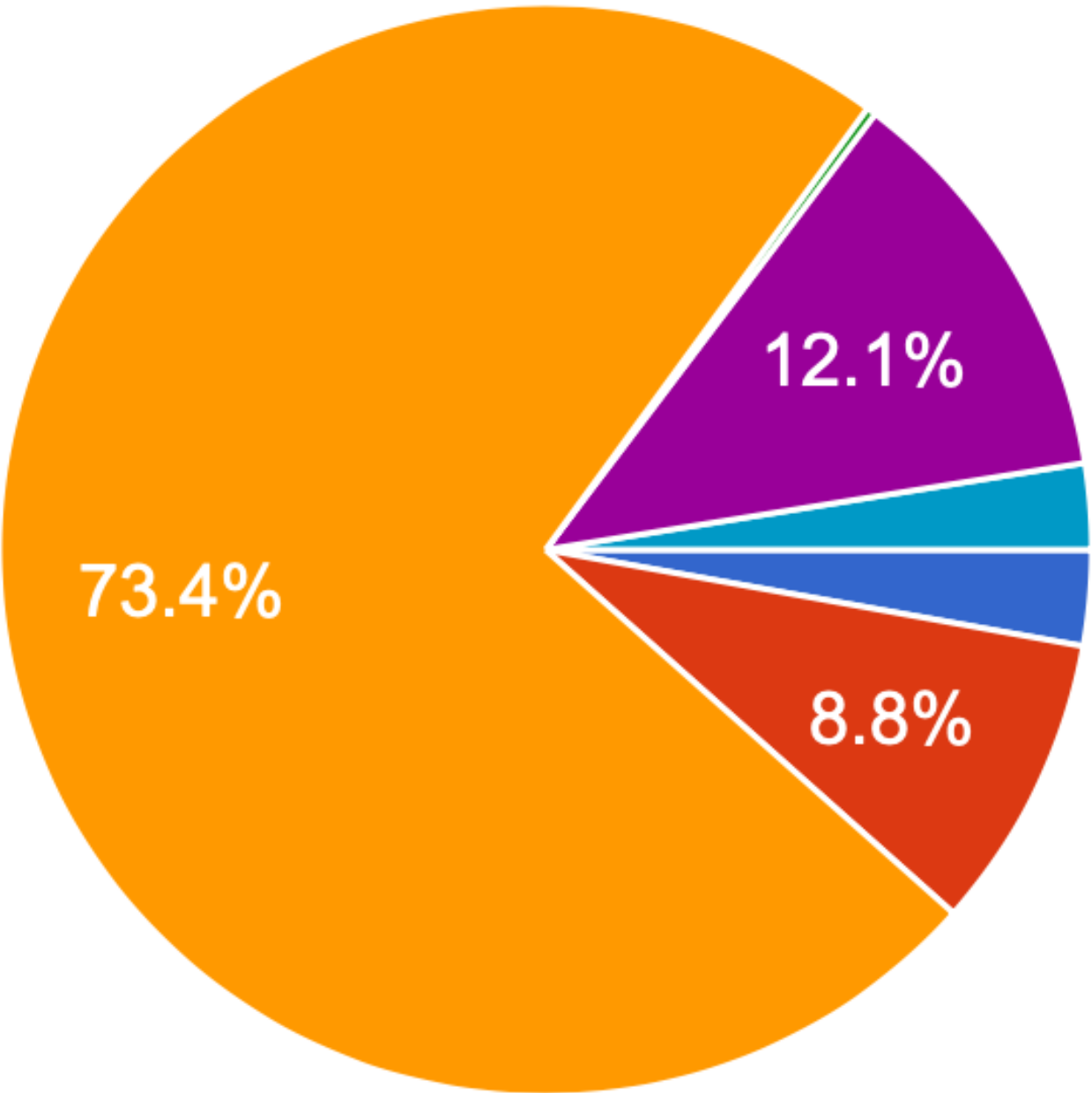

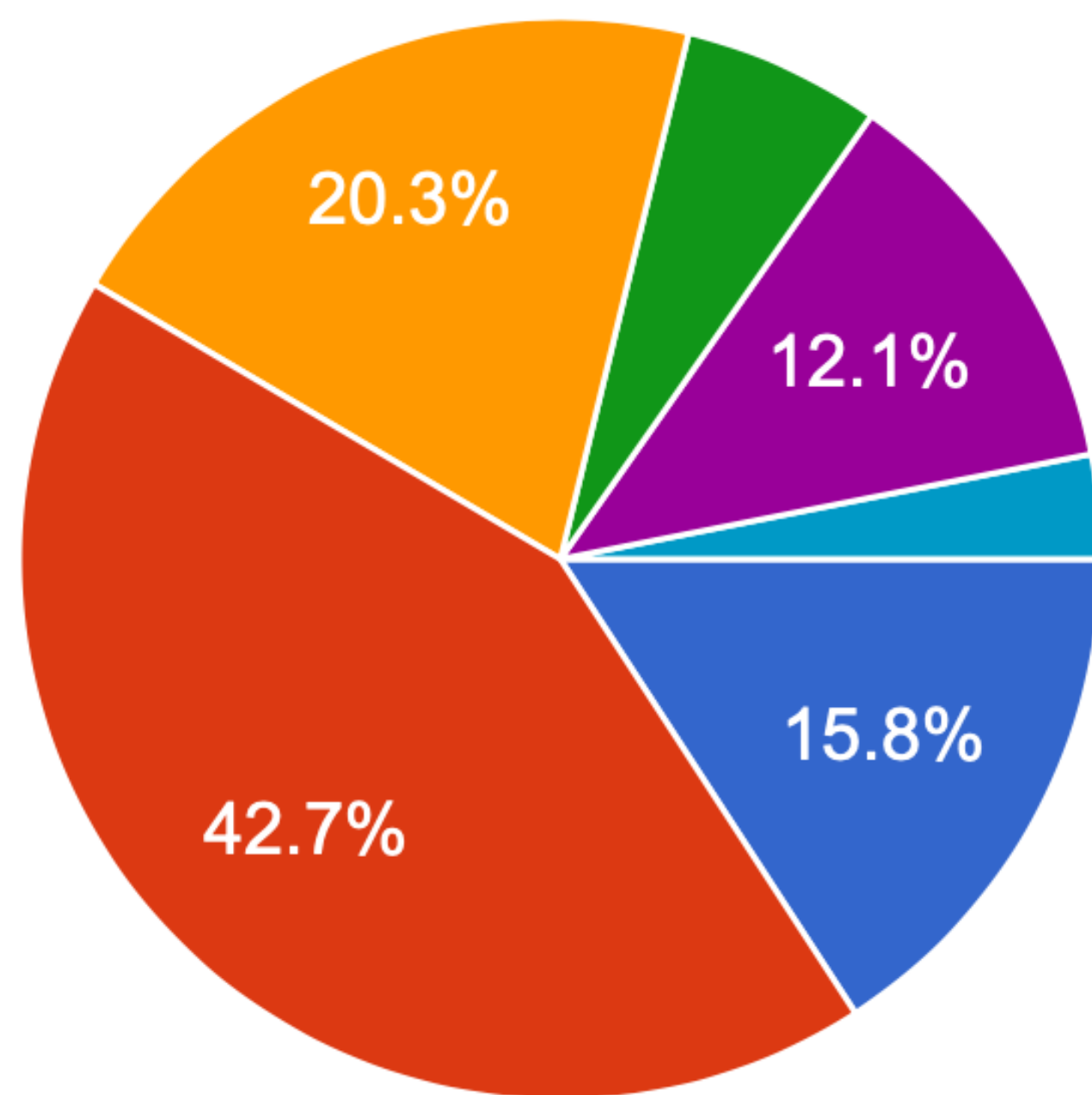

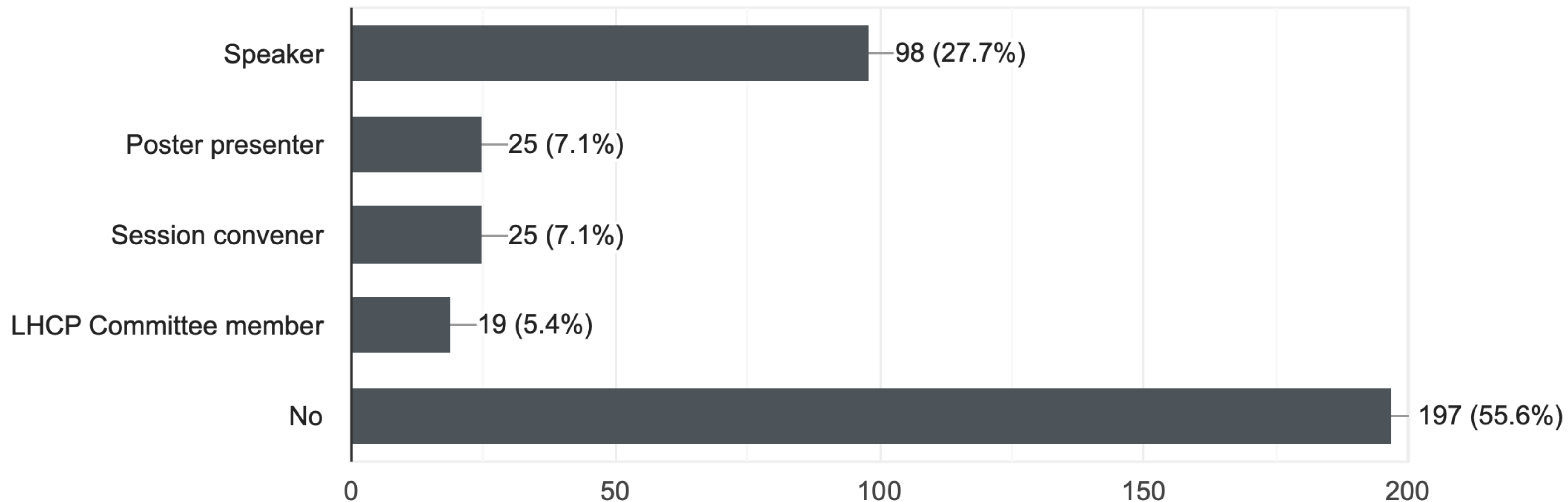

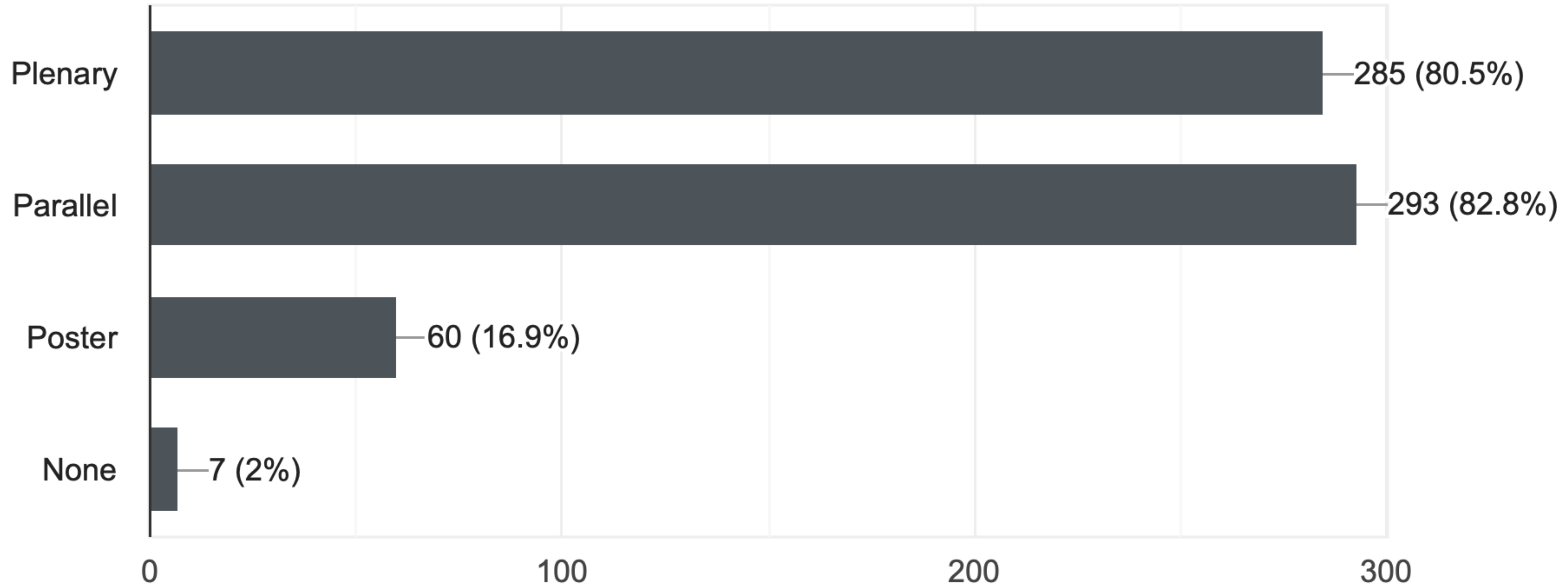

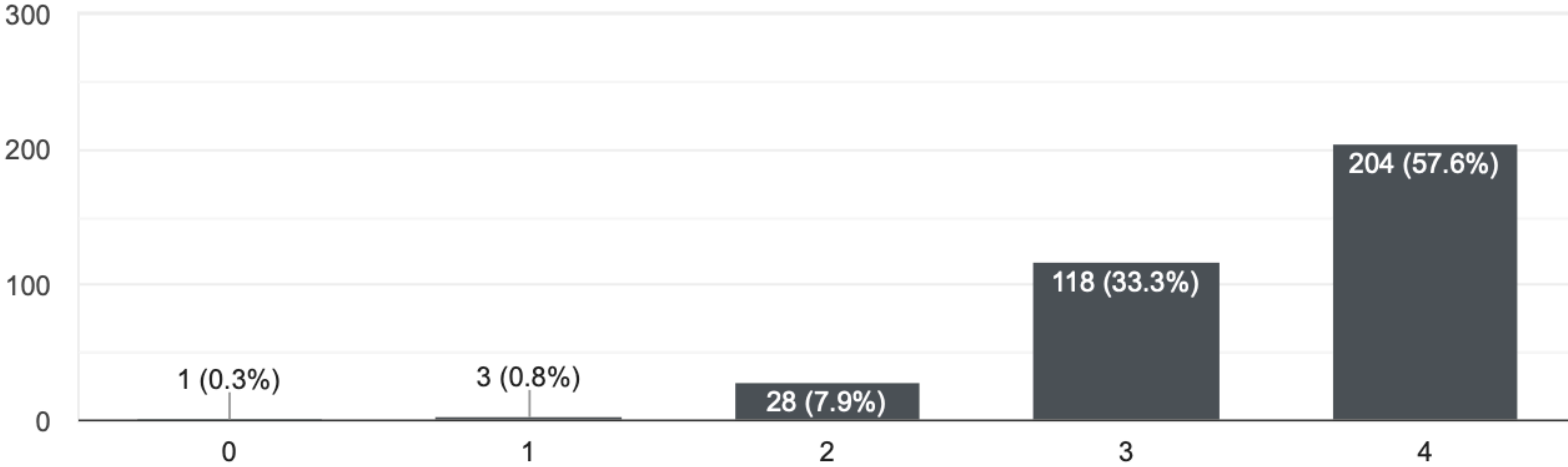
Which sessions did you attend?

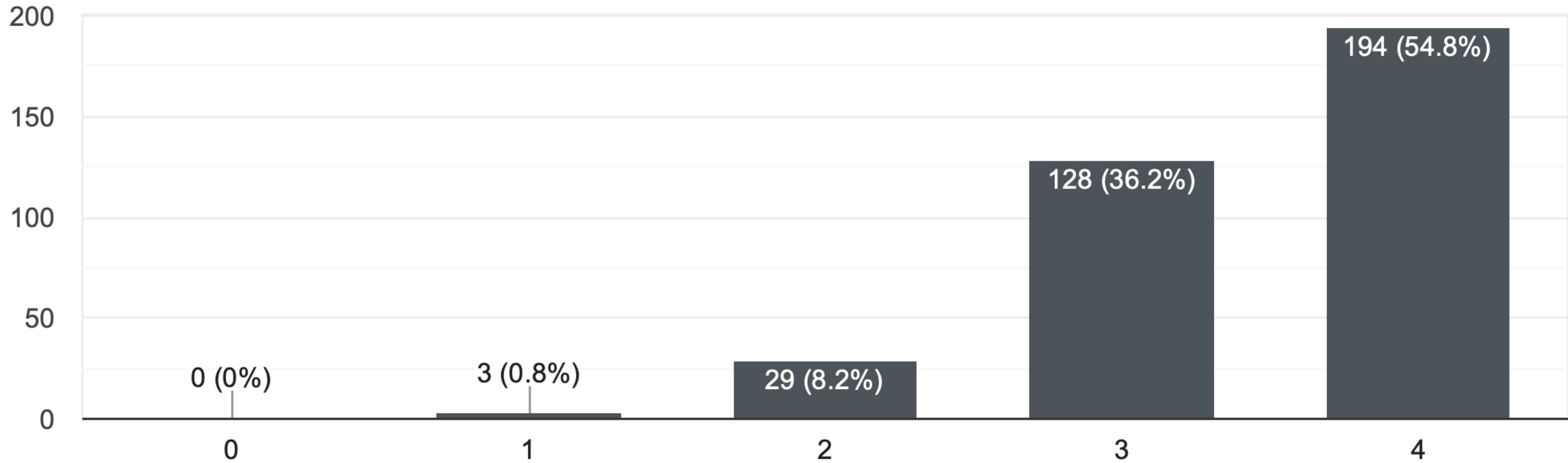

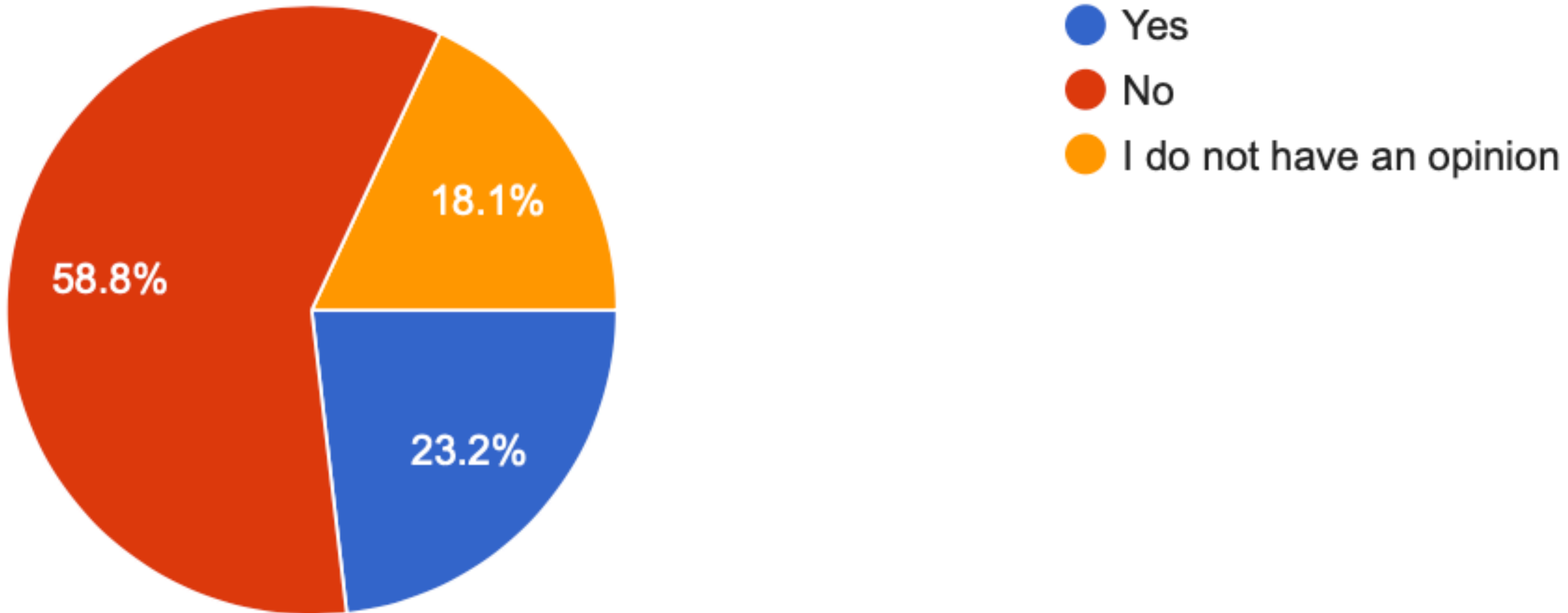
How satisfied are you with having the parallel sessions in the central part of the daily schedule and the plenary sessions at the beginning or at the end of the schedule?

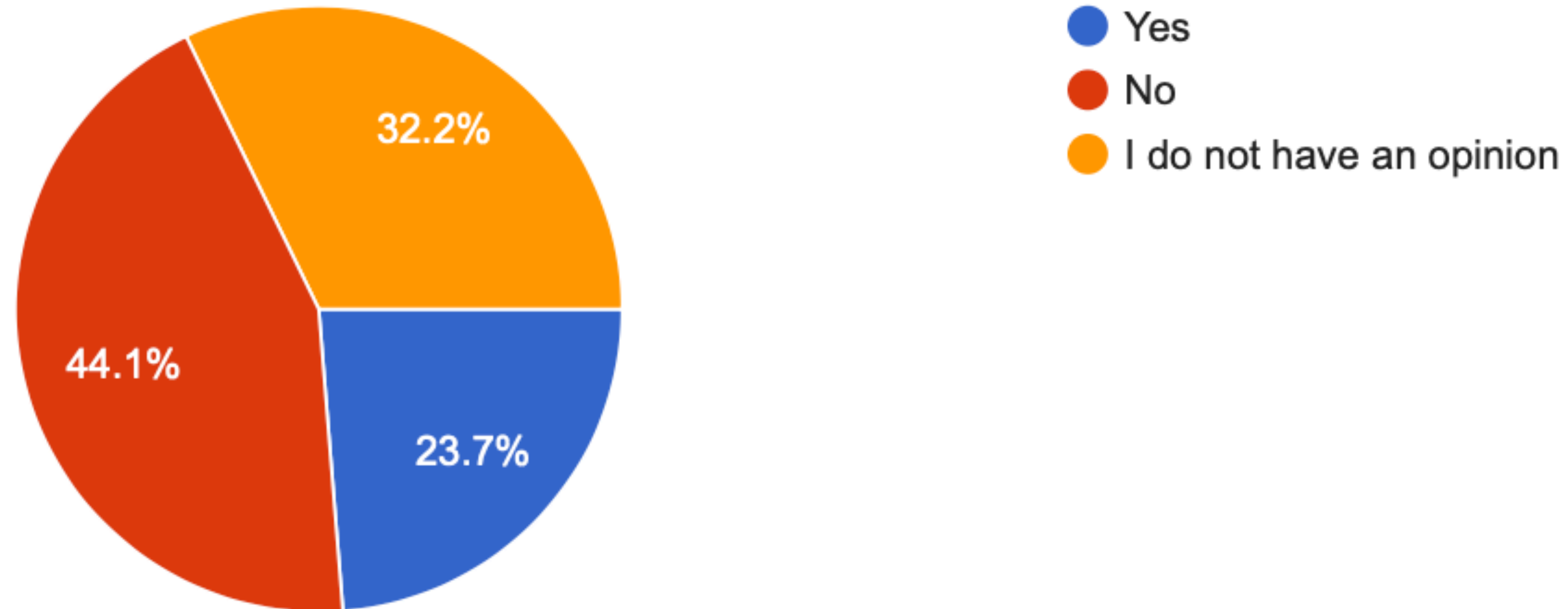

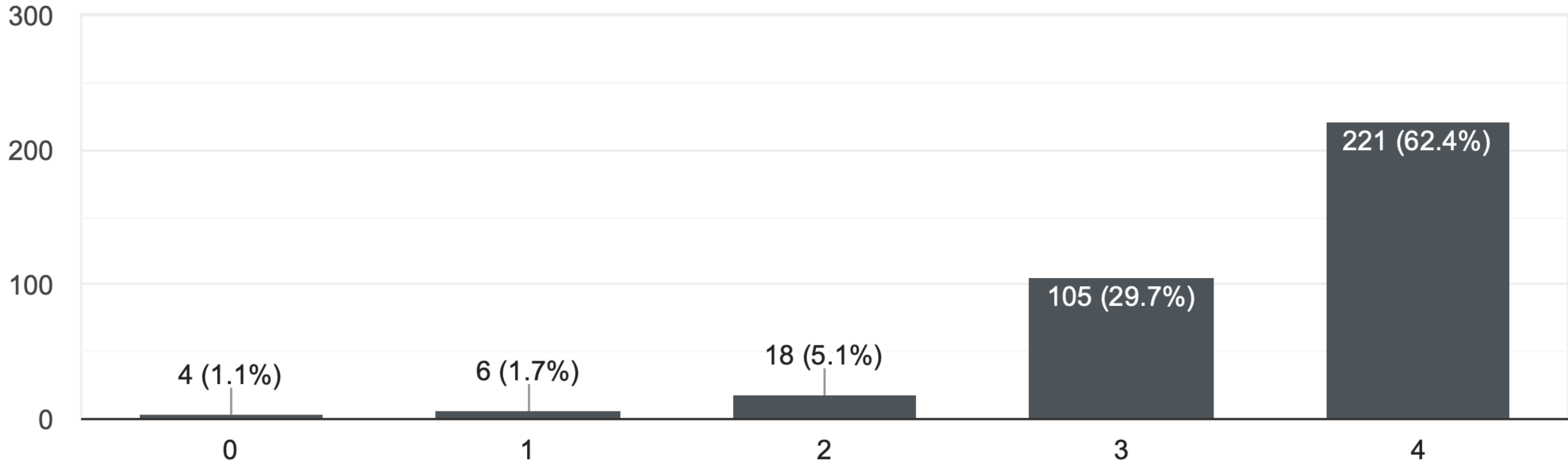

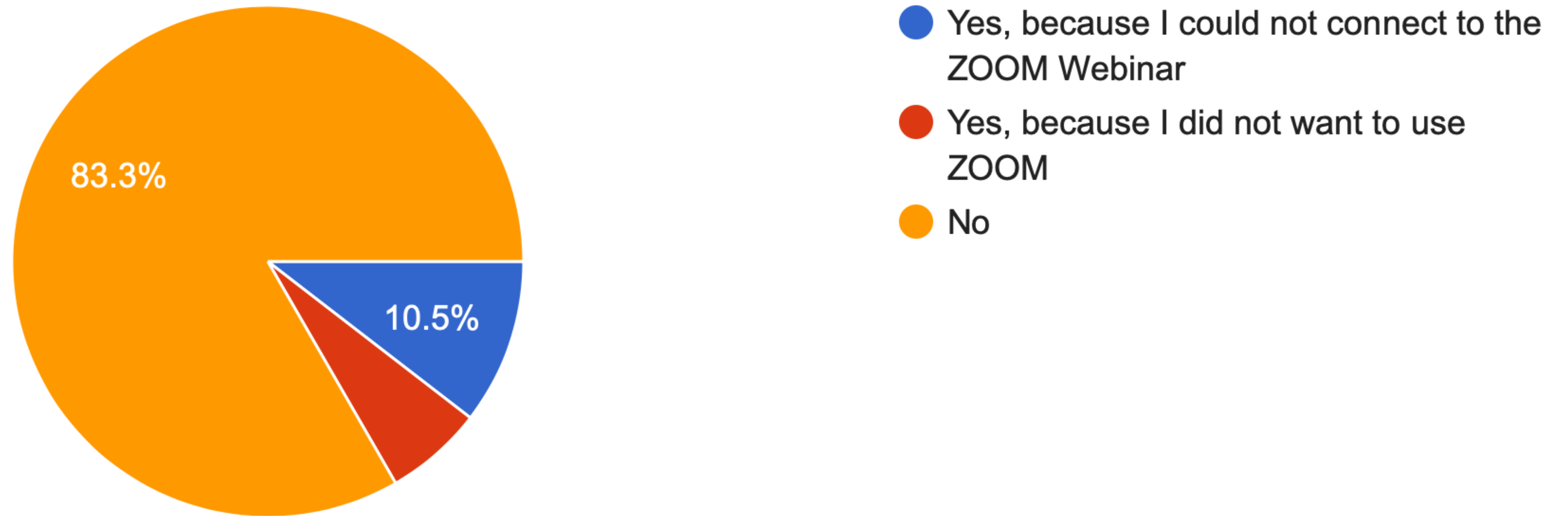
How satisfied are you with choice of ZOOM as the platform for the videoconferencing?

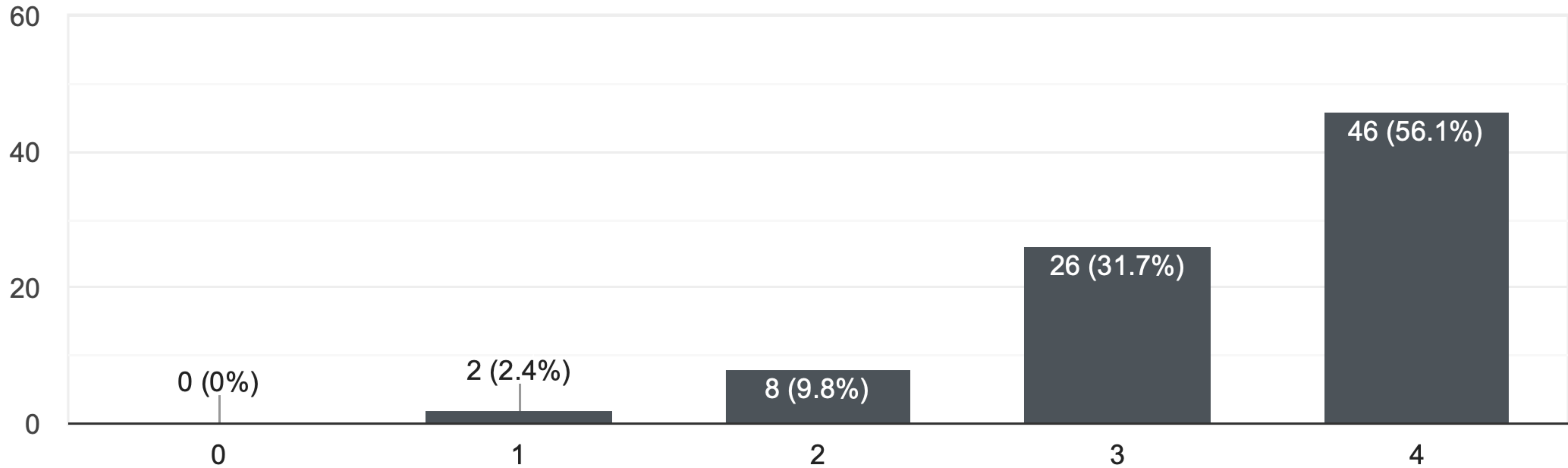

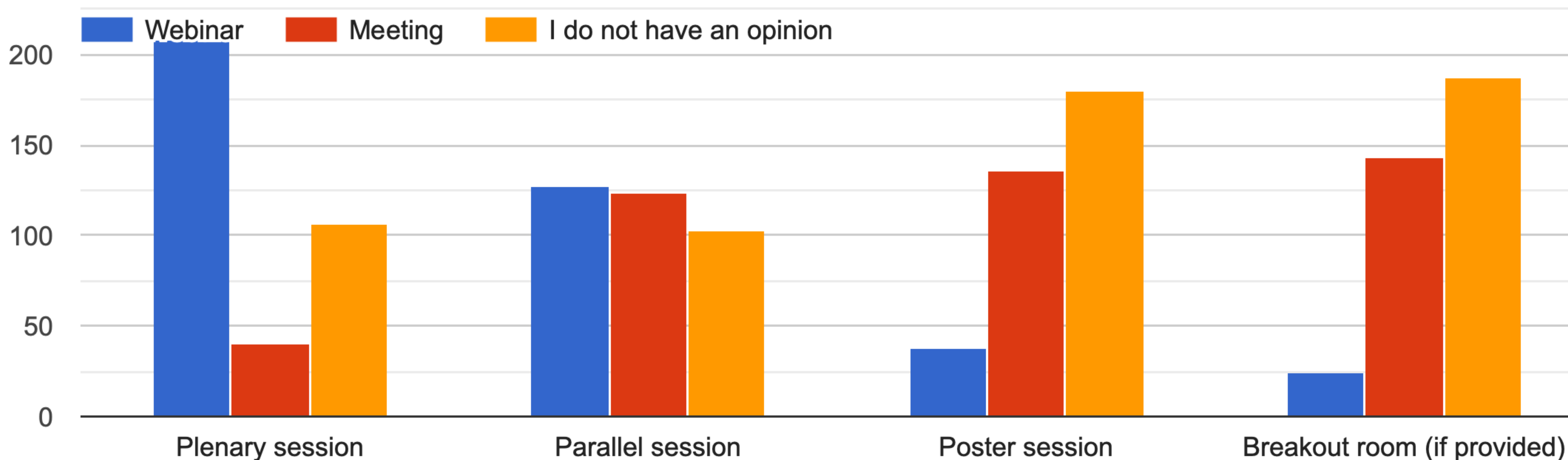


If you followed the plenary sessions on Webcast, how satisfied were you with it? (optional)

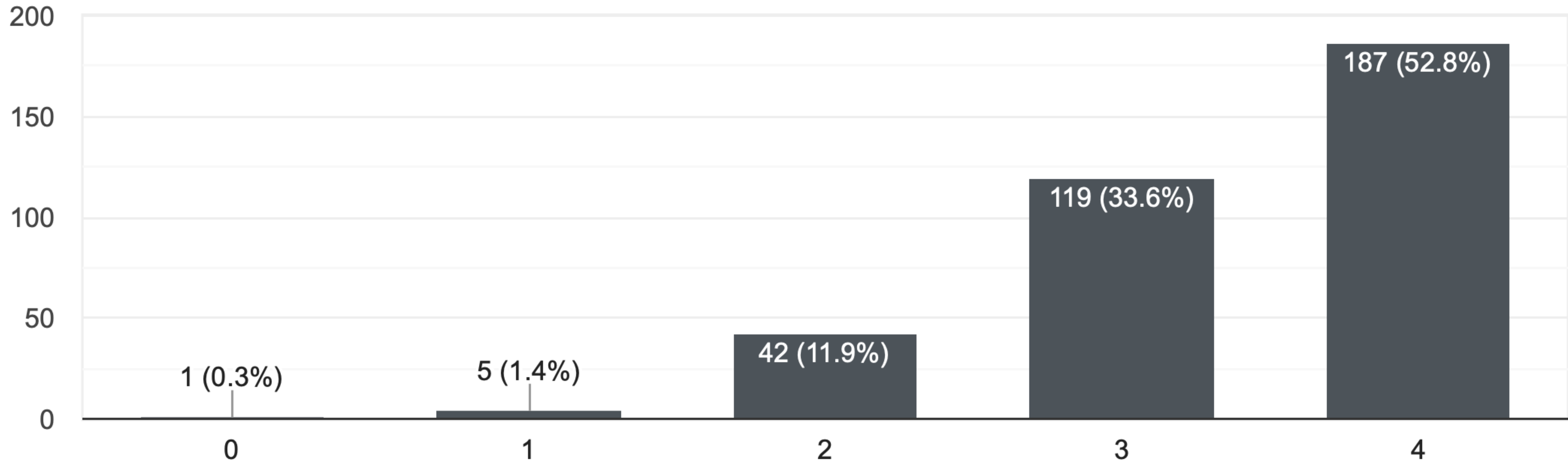

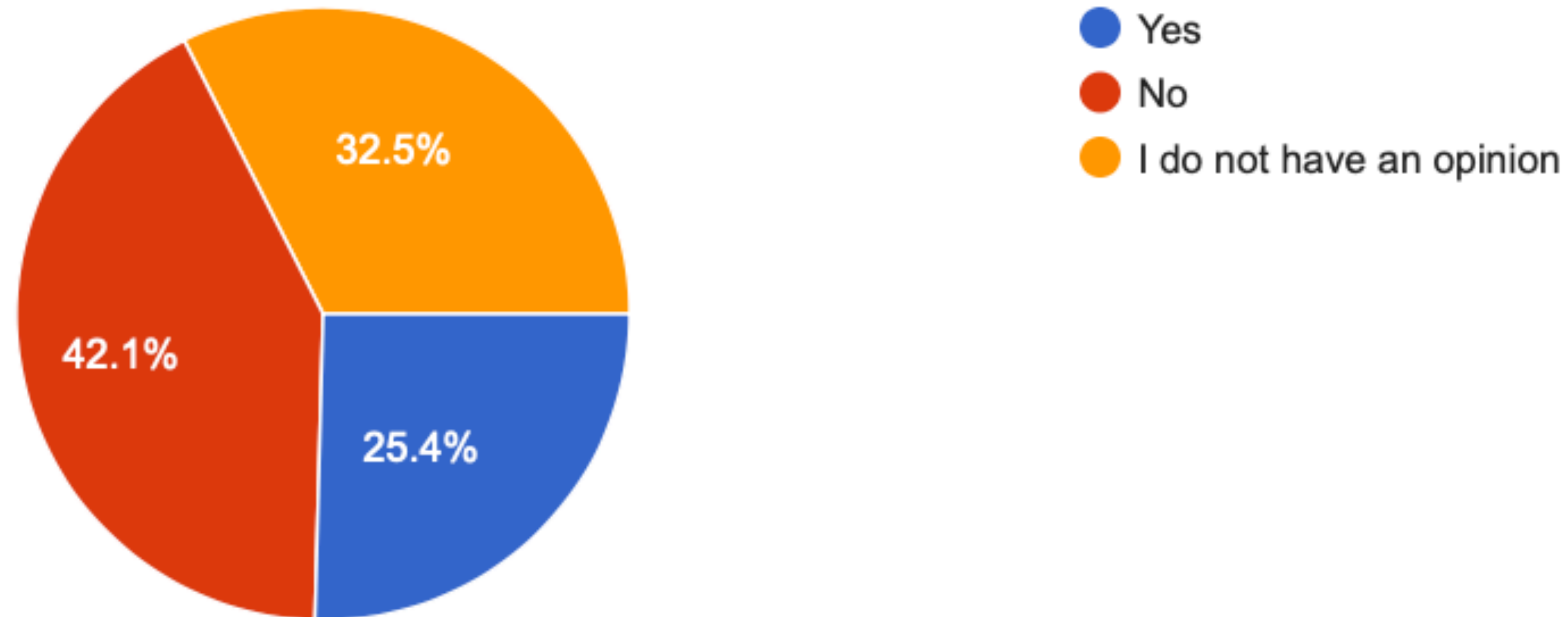
How satisfied were you with the ZOOM raise-hand feature for the question and answer (Q&A) phase?

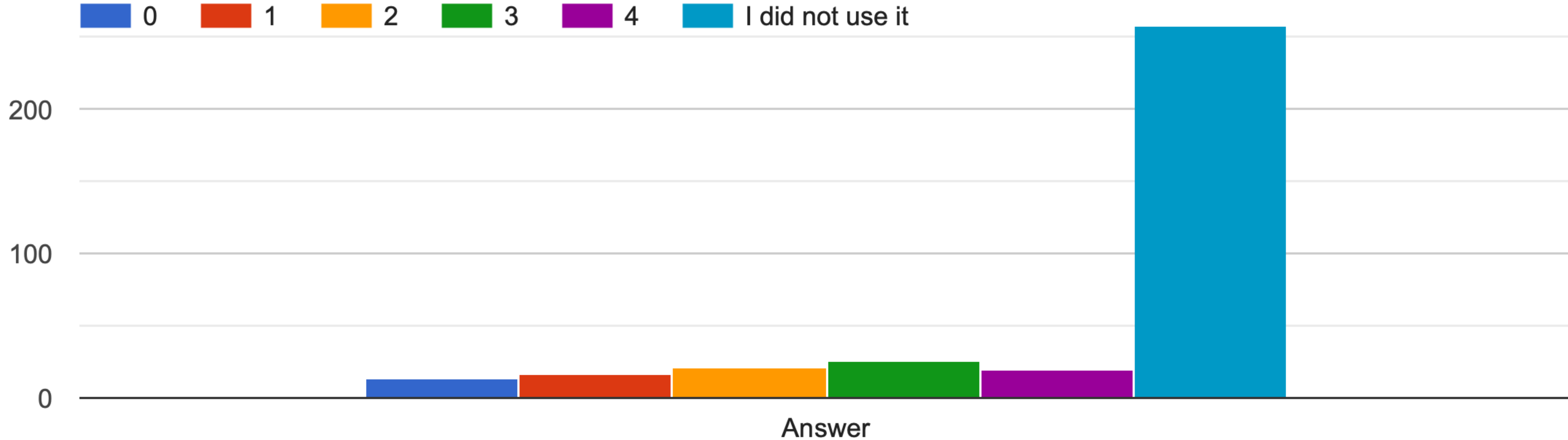

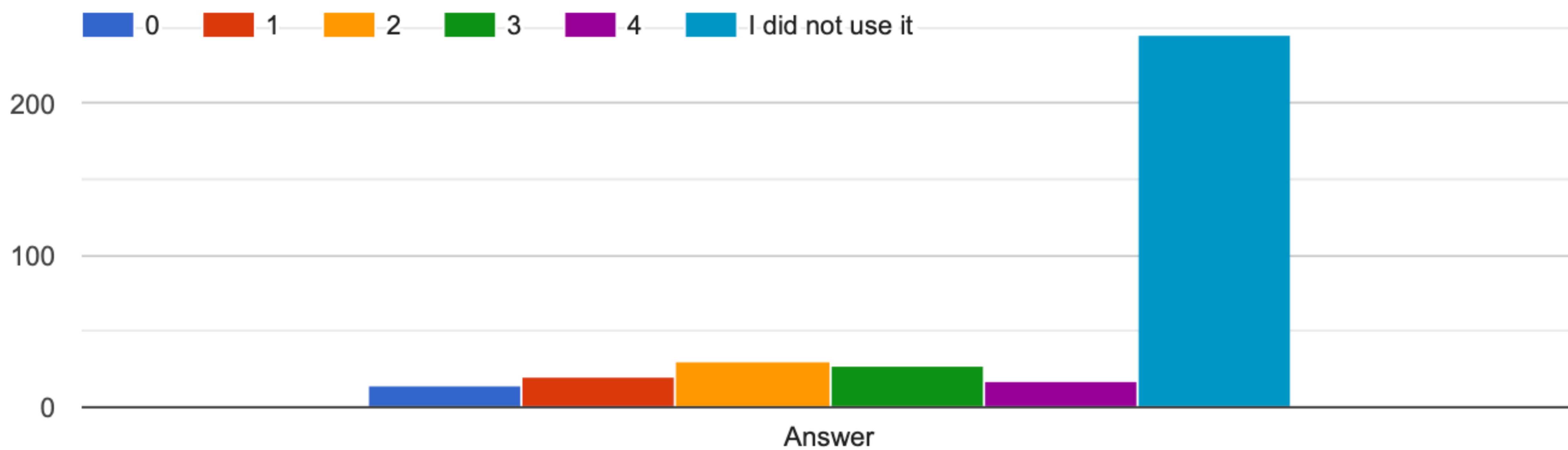

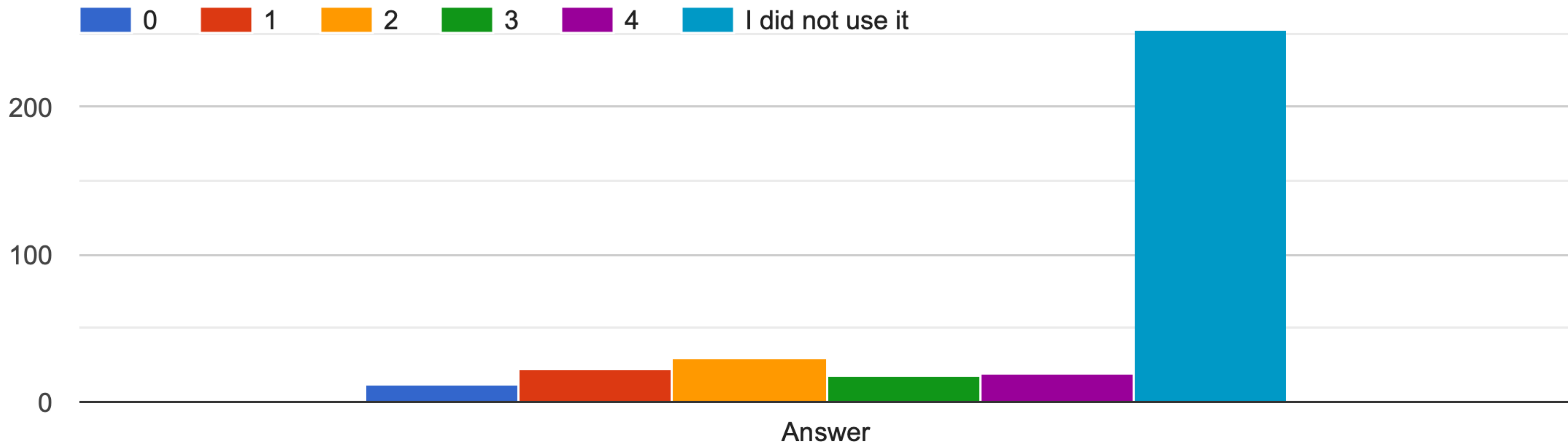

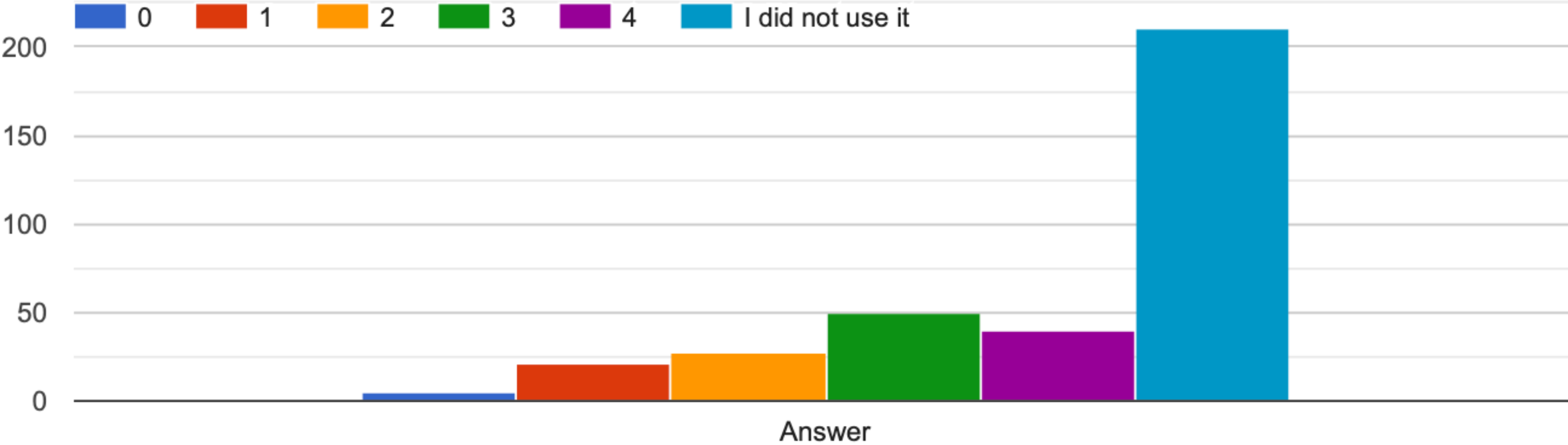

Similarly a dedicated Discord "virtual coffee break" channel was created. How satisfied were you with it? (0=not at all satisfied, 4=completely satisfied)

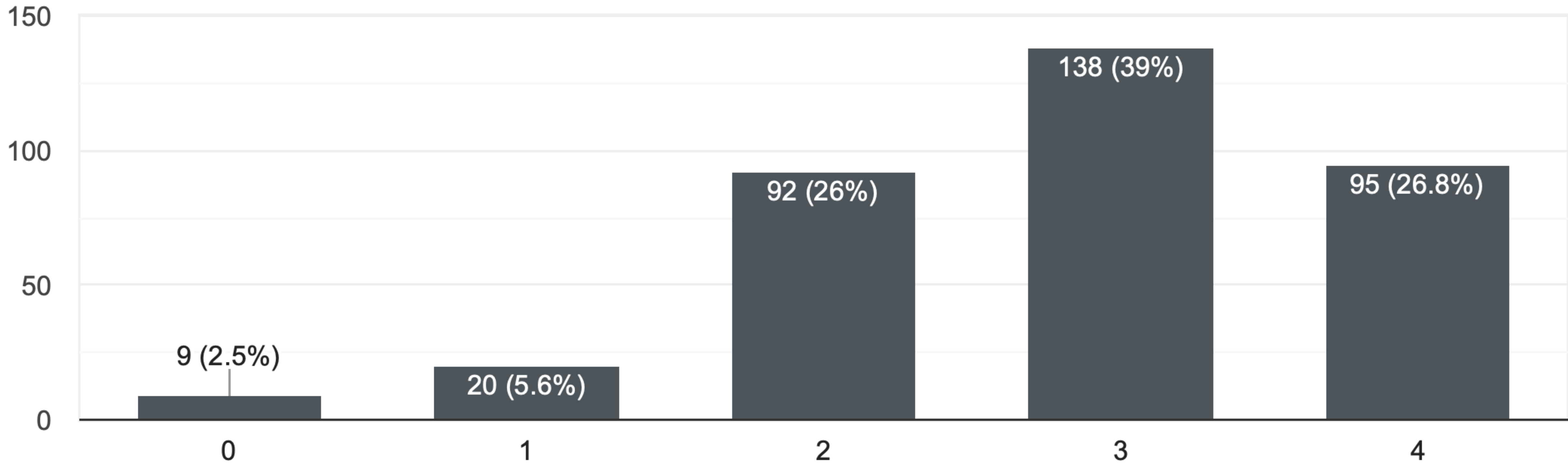

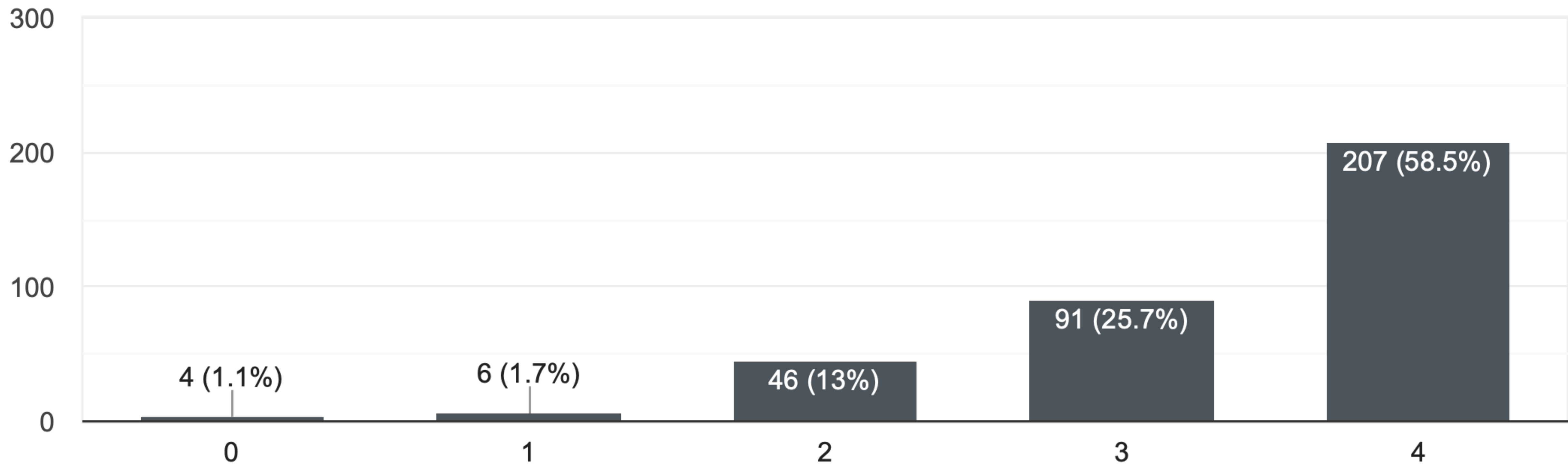
How important to have a "breakout room" where both speaker and participants could discuss after the sessions?

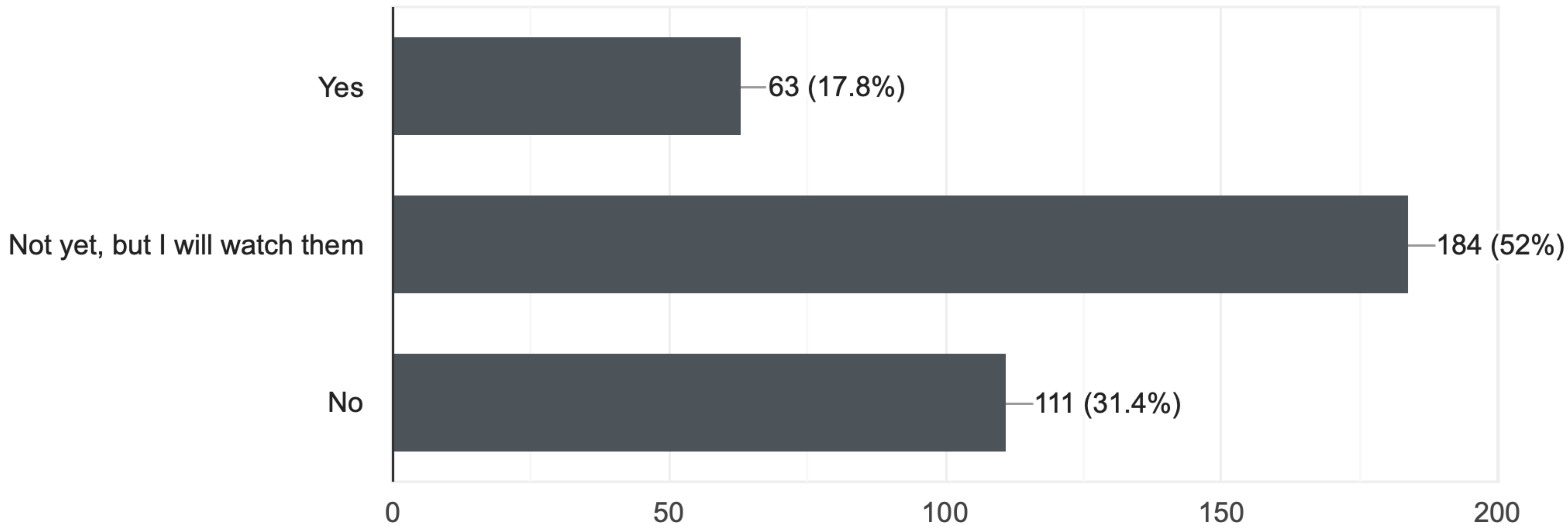
Talks have been recorded and posted on indico agenda. How satisfied were you with this choice?

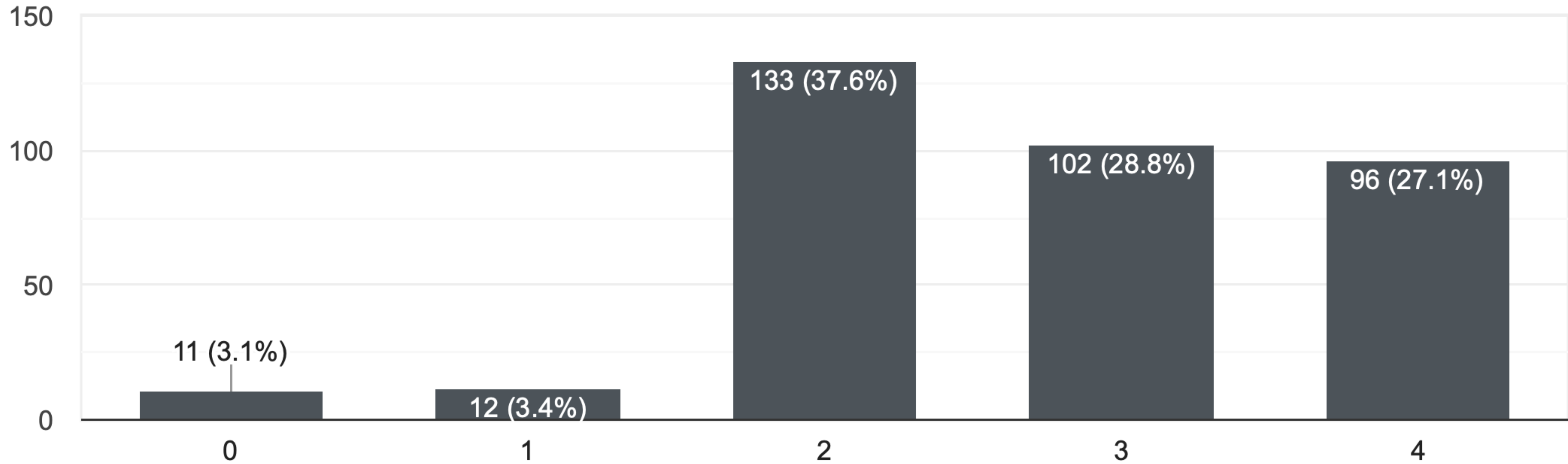
Did you watch the recordings?

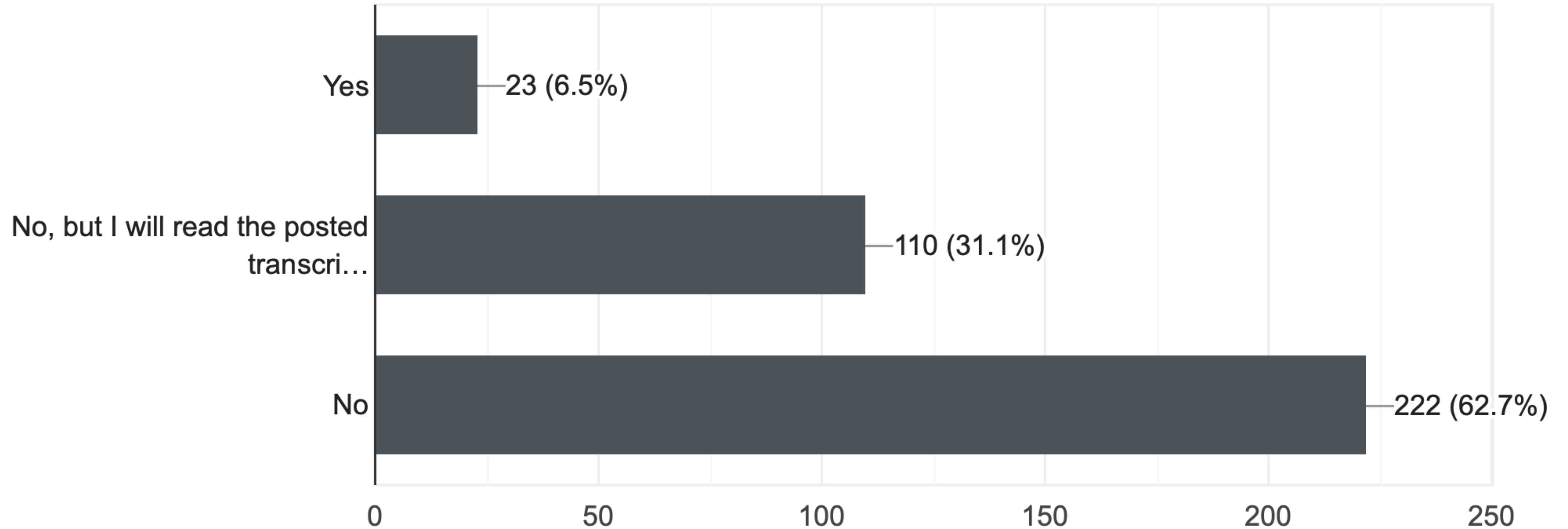
Some talks have been live transcript and transcriptions posted on indico agenda. How satisfied were you with this choice?

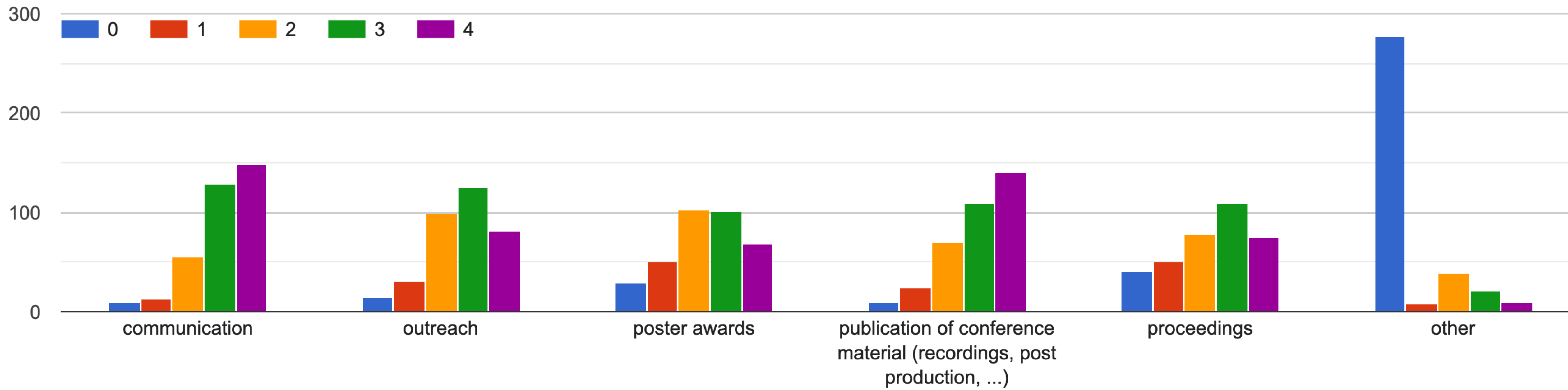


Did you use the live transcriptions?

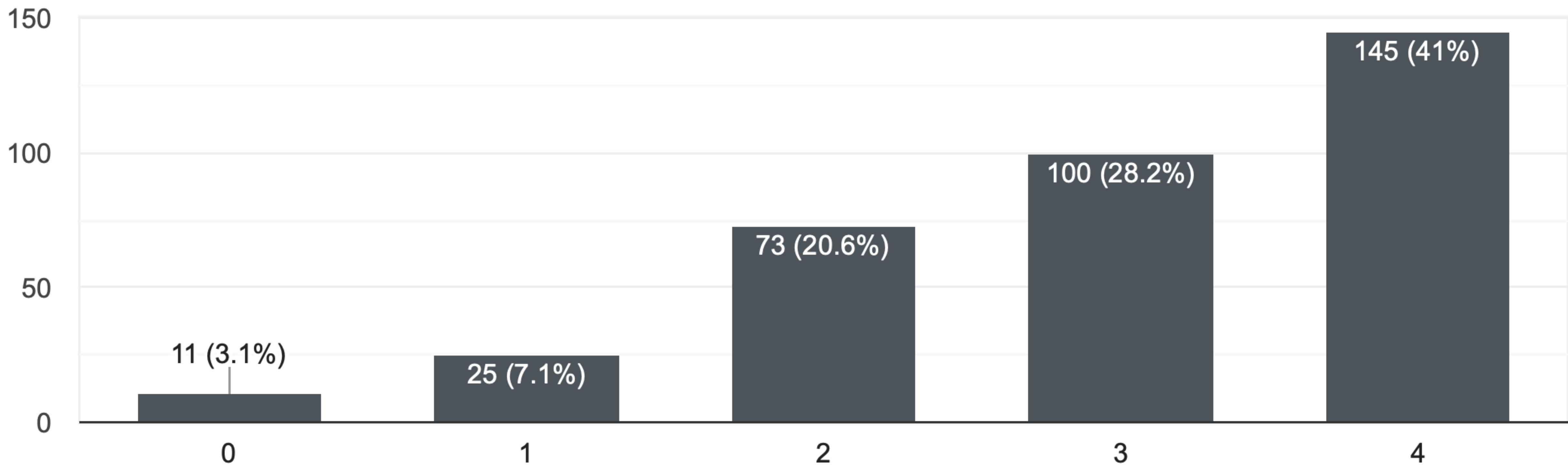


Budget is very severely constrained for an online conference without a fee. How useful do you find the following items (0 = low priority, 4 = high priority):



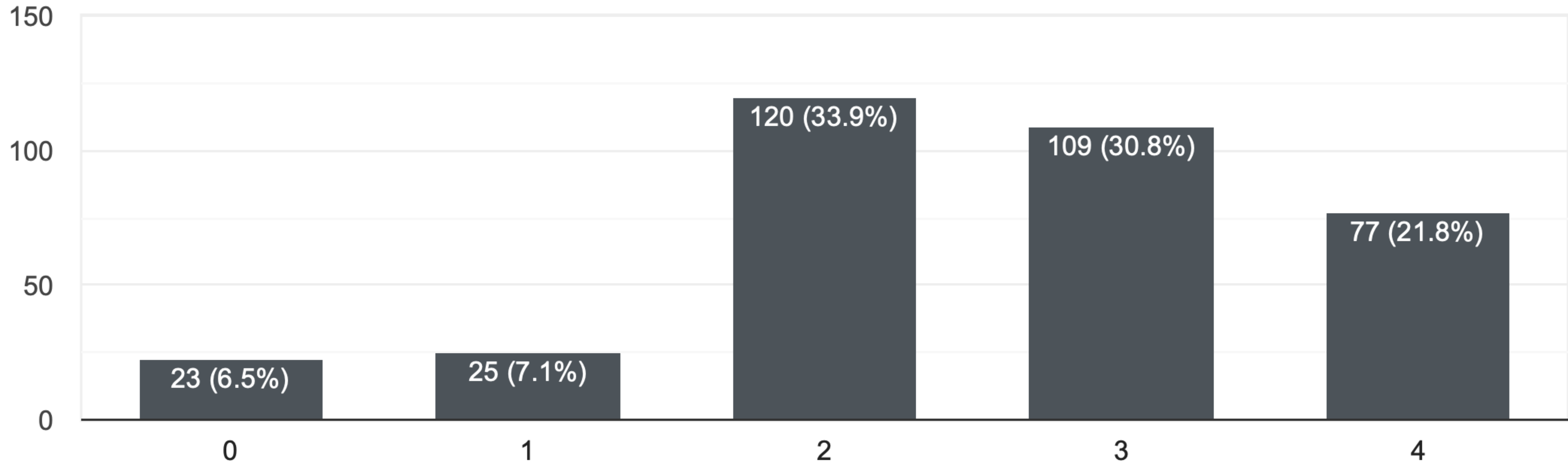
How important is to maintain a "fee free" registration for the online conferences?

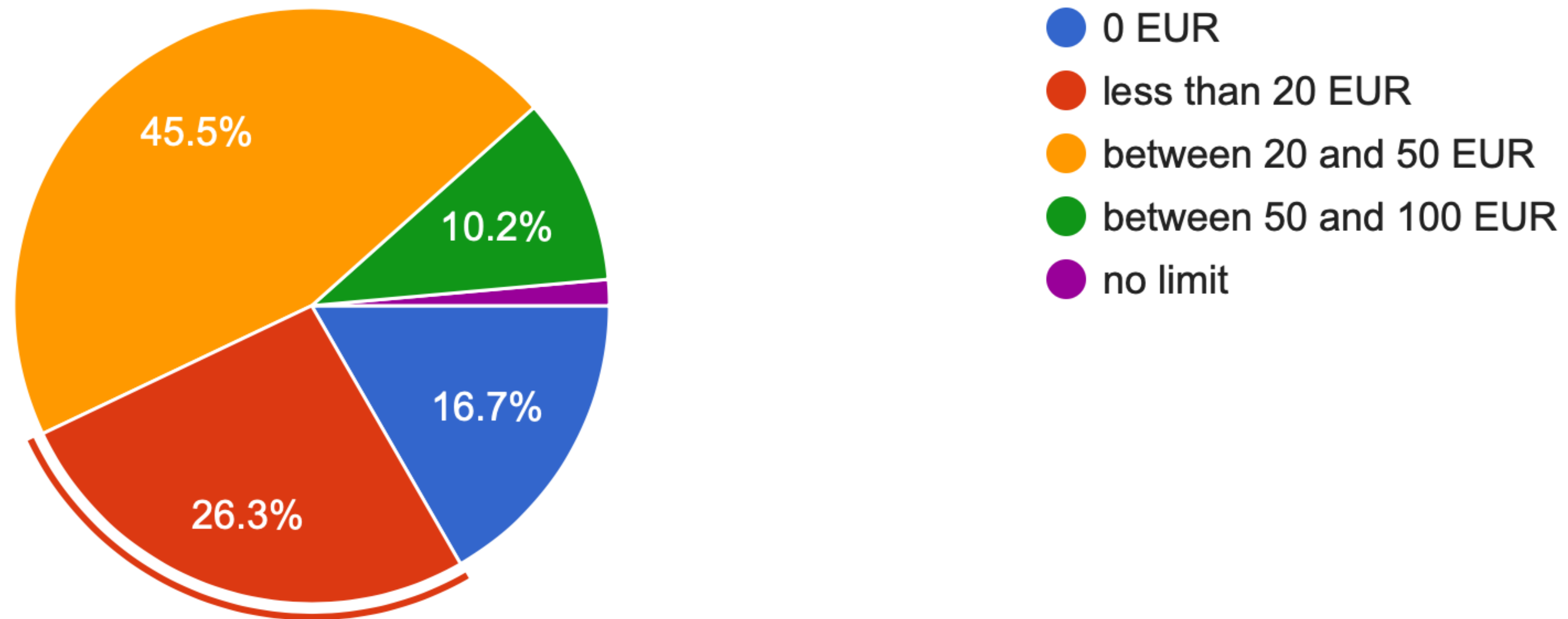
Do you think that your institute/funding agency should contribute financially to support the organisation of a fully online conference?

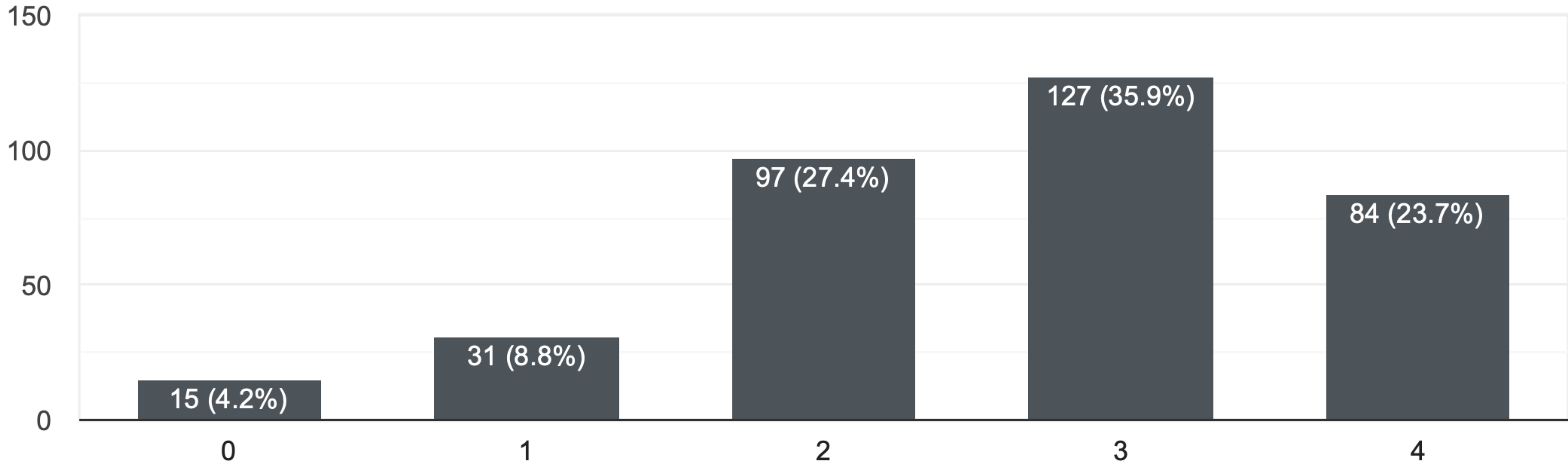
What is in your opinion a reasonable fee for the (major) online conferences?
