


## Distribution of participants & organisers by gender (1)



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


# Geographical distribution of participants

based according on institute declared in Indico registration form




## Timezone distribution of participants








### Which sessions did you attend?






How satisfied are you with having the parallel sessions in the central part of the daily schedule and the plenary sessions at the beginning or at the end of the schedule?







How satisfied are you with choice of ZOOM as the platform for the videoconferencing? 354 responses






If you followed the plenary sessions on Webcast, how satisfied were you with it? (optional) 82 responses






How satisfied were you with the ZOOM raise-hand feature for the question and answer (Q&A) phase?














How important to have a "breakout room" where both speaker and participants could discuss after the sessions?











Budget is very severely constrained for an online conference without a fee. How useful do you find the following items (0 = low priority, 4 = highs priority):




How important is to maintain a "fee free" registration for the online conferences? 354 responses




Do you think that your institute/funding agency should contribute financially to support the organisation of a fully online conference?


What is in your opinion a reasonable fee for the (major) online conferences? 354 responses
