# **1. HOSTEL** Info for participants staying at CERN Hostel The Hotel Reception (Building 39) is open as follows: Mondays to Fridays from 7.30 to 19.30.- Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays from 9.00 to 13.00. Outside these times, room keys can be obtained from the security guard on duty at the entrance to CERN's Meyrin site (Swiss side) - Gate B.

All modifications or cancellations must be made at least 48 hours in advance. ## 2. ARRIVAL PROCEDURES - IMPORTANT!

#### Access card

All persons entering the CERN site must be in possession of a card issued by CERN certifying that they are authorized to do so. Access cards are issued by Reception Registration Service and Access Control Service in Building 55 or Building 33.

 At your arrival at CERN, you should have to collect your access card in building 55 -1<sup>st</sup> floor. The building 55– located near the Entrance B - is open from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. nonstop (open days).
 Please refer to CERN map at the end of document.

Arrival beyond hours mentioned above, you should have to collect a temporary access cards at Entrance B (building 120) close to the guard, awaiting to have a permanent one - to collect in building 55 – 1<sup>st</sup> floor during open hours.

## Taxi: please call: (+ 41.22. 320.22.02).


The meeting point for the taxi can be the reception (building 33) -until 17:30- or near the steps of the travel agency (Main building - 500).






**Bldg 55 Access card services.** 


