  - Analysis of your websites
  - Rank them
  - Plan their migration
  - Move to alternatives

#### What has been done so far

- Moved to static website
  - ~10 websites migrated with our procedure
    - D7 old versions after migration, old event websites, cern.ch/angelsanddemons
  - Some in the pipeline to be done
  - Other migrated to other alternatives, Discourse, MKDocs, Wordpress
    - Entice portal being phased out in favour of Discourse forum
    - phone-migration.web.cern.ch

#### What has been done so far

- Migration from Drupal 7 to Drupal 8
  - 566 official Drupal 7 websites
  - 248 official Drupal 8 websites
  - 372 test Drupal 8 websites
- Difficult to fully track the success rate
  - Archived websites on D7
  - Sites created from scratch
  - Some sites still as test websites on D8 (WIP)
- Around 200 migrations done (including repeating failing sites)
  - Very good and positive user feedback

### What are we still working on

- Providing more alternatives
  - Including a technology decision diagram
- Improving the migration process
- Preparing the last 6 months communication campaign
- Help on the transition period
- Video tutorials, documentation pages for specific use cases
