



- To promote the exchange of information and views among the members of the international scientific community in the general field of Particles and Fields.
- To recommend for Union sponsorship international <u>conferences</u> which qualify for support under Union regulations.
- To promote the free circulation of scientists; to assist conference organizers in ensuring such free circulation and in resolving potential infringements.
- To organize where feasible the <u>award</u> of medals or other testimonials of excellence in its field.





- To publish where feasible newsletters, circulars, occasional books, journals or handbooks in its area.
- To maintain liaison with other <u>IUPAP Commissions</u>, with the Commissions or Committees of other Unions or of the <u>International Council of Scientific Unions</u> (ICSU) or other scientific organizations.
- To make available to each <u>General Assembly</u> of the Union a summary of activities and progress in its field since the previous Assembly.





- Held every 3 years
- Last one was in October of 2017
- The IUPAP Commission chairs also meet in October and once in the spring after the General Assembly

- The 2020 meeting in Beijing was postponed to 2021 due to COVID-19 and travel restrictions.
- As a result, current membership continues for 1 additional year.

New resolutions from the General Assembly

- The 29th General Assembly RESOLVED to encourage IUPAP-sponsored conferences to have a session for all participants on diversity and inclusion in Physics, together with IUPAP values.
- The 29th General Assembly RESOLVED to encourage IUPAP-sponsored conferences to include more female plenary speakers, and asks that the number of male and female plenary and invited speakers at the conference be reported in the conference report to IUPAP.

These are already part of the ICHEP series in Chicago and Seoul





 Council was pleased to endorse the initiative to create a Neutrino Panel as a combined effort under the supervision of the C4, C11 and C12 Commissions together with the WG1, WG9 and WG10 Working Groups. The C11 Commission will take the role as the coordinating Commission of the action. The suggested mission of the Neutrino Panel is:

'to promote international cooperation in the development of an experimental program to study the properties of neutrinos and to promote international collaboration in the development of future neutrino experiments to establish the properties of neutrinos.'

- The 29th General Assembly RESOLVED to establish the Neutrino Panel, composed of nominees of C4, C11, C12, WG1, WG9 and WG10, under the supervision of those Commissions and Working Groups and coordinated by C11
- The 29th General Assembly DELEGATED to the Executive Council the authority to approve the mission of the Neutrino Panel and the membership of the Panel

There are several classifications of IUPAP involvement http://iupap.org/sponsored-conferences/

Sponsorship requires a formal application by June of the preceding year

- Sponsorship at level A 1 per year receives 11500 EUR
- Sponsorship at level B 1-2 /year receives ~5000 EUR
- Sponsorship at level C no funding

Endorsement – can be done at any time, can display the logo.





- A Very large international, 1 per year (ICHEP, Lepton Photon)
- B Substantial international, topical (Neutrino, LHCP, CHEP ...) 1-2/year
- C Smaller, regional or special (Baldin, History of the Neutrino)

Sponsorship and Endorsement help in obtaining funding and visas for participants





- Informal proposal to C11 at these meetings ~4-5 years in advance (recommended)
- Formal bids 3-4 years in advance (see the conference guidelines)
- Decision by C11 on venue 3-4 years ahead
 - Assistance from C11 in organization and timing
- Formal request for sponsorship is due June 1 of the year before the conference
- IUPAP formally approves sponsorship at their October meeting
- C11 involved in formation of IAC
- Conference is held
- Reports are due by June 1 of the following year
