Large Hadron Collider Physics (LHCP) Conference Series

- Successful fusion of two international conference series
 - Physics at Large Hadron Collider
 - Hadron Collider Physics Symposium
- Review of the latest experimental and theoretical results from the LHC physics program
 - Unique international venue for lively scientific discussions focused on LHC physics, detector technology, upgrades, and future physics opportunities
 - Typical attendance: 300 –400, > 25% students
- Emphasis on engaging early career scientists and the public
 - Plenary talks: Young Scientist Forum, Outreach efforts @ LHC
 - Public outreach: each edition features a public event in the local language
 - Strong encouragement for experiments to select a diverse and outstanding set of junior scientists to give talks and present posters



Very challenging task: < 2 months for planning the online conference!


Online LHCP 2020 format




- "No fee" fully online conference

 - Talks scheduled during 12:30-18:30 CEST with two 15' breaks and up to 7 parallel sessions running at the same time


 Zoom-based, webinars for plenaries & parallels, posters with videos and Zoom-rooms, "discord" channels for informal chats/discussion...

Demographics information




Participants (1301 persons)




Demographics information: LHCP committees



Geographical distribution of participants




In addition to your participation, did you have any other role(s) in the conference? 354 responses

Which sessions did you attend? 354 responses




Post-conference survey results: Format (time)

0: not at all satisfied4: completely satisfied



How satisfied are you with having the parallel sessions in the central part of the daily schedule and the plenary sessions at the beginning or at the end of the schedule?



Post-conference survey results: Format





LHCP 2021

- Re-scheduled to be held in Paris: 7 12 June
 - LHCP 2022 to be held in Taipei (Taiwan)
- Preparations for LHCP 2021 are in full swing and build upon the work initially done for hosting LHCP 2020 in Paris
- Funding:
 - We are grateful to IUPAP for providing funds for LHCP2020 and for allowing us to now use them for LHCP 2021 instead
 - As was done previously, IUPAP funding will go primarily to support students and early career scientist to attend and give presentations.
 - Consider also for satisfying accessibility needs?
 - Additional funds obtained from local and regional organizations (IN2P3, P2IO + P2I), organizing labs (LLR/LNPHE/IJCLab/IRFU); funds pledged (FRIF, La Diagonale) for outreach activities
 - Support expected from CERN; additional sources being explored
