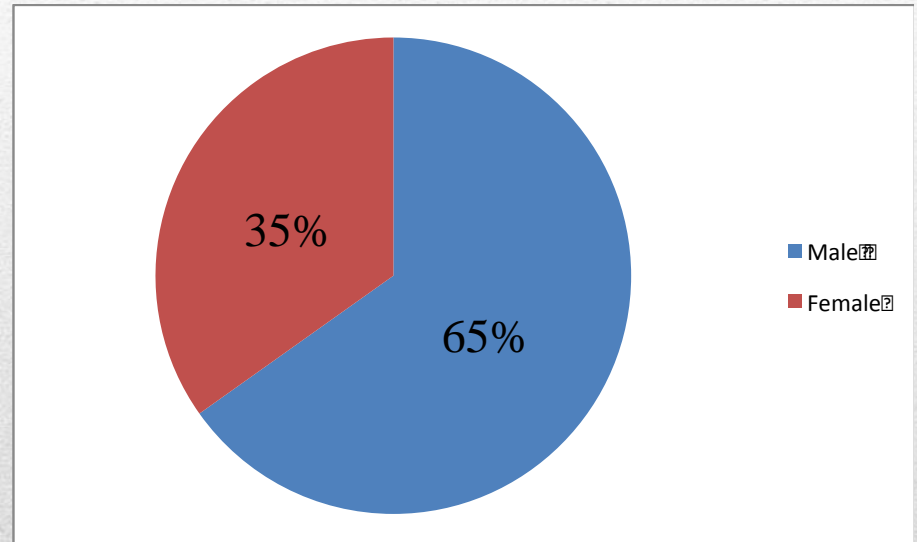

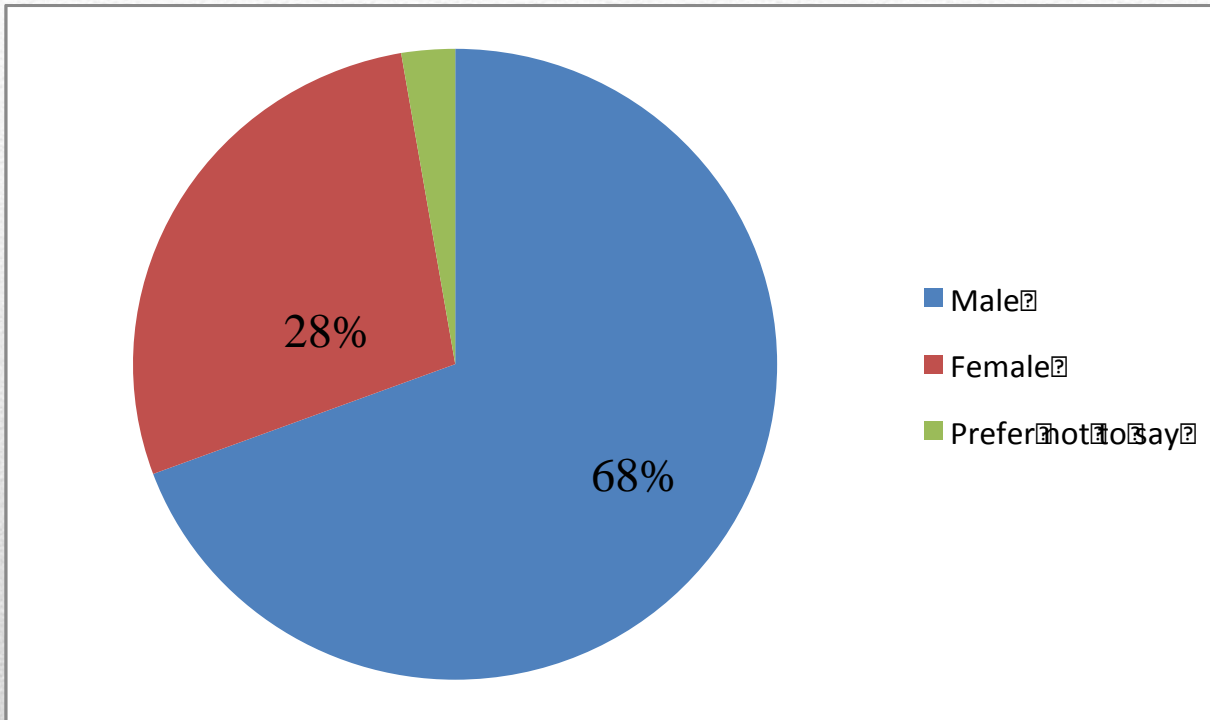

## Plenaries/Parallels/Posters





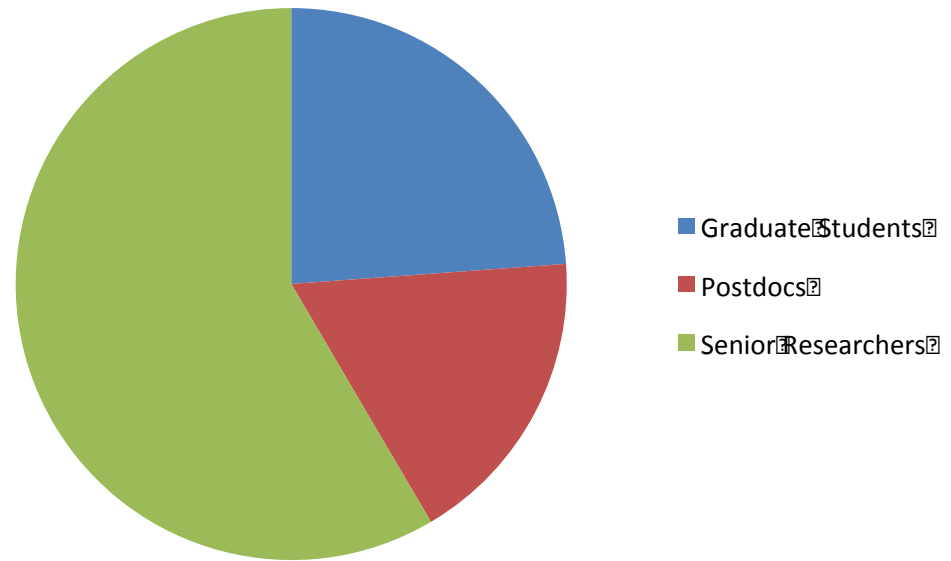
## Delegate gender

\$700CAD for full delegates

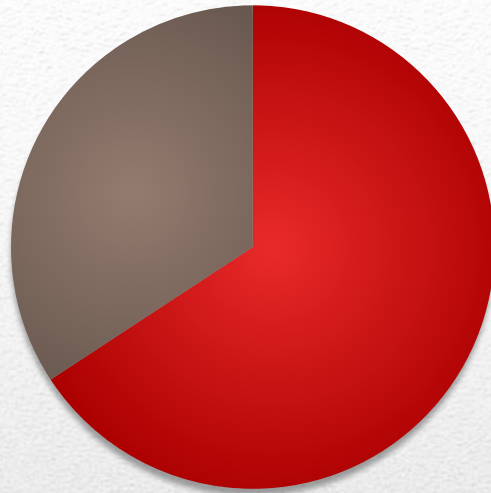

---





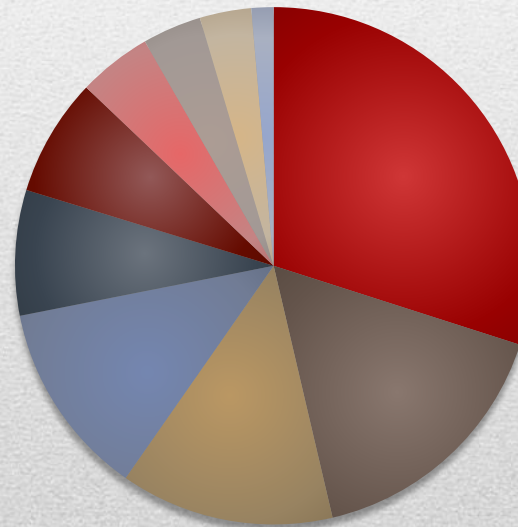

- Worked hard to have a diverse set of plenary speakers
  - Not quite gender parity (plenary speaker 35% women)
  - Asian contingent low (20% of delegates/plenary speakers)
  - Parallel session + posters were not worse than plenary

- Professional conference organizer (@\$100/delegate) dealt with hotel, caterers and registrations – worth every penny
