ERC National Contact Points (NCPs)

- Raise awareness, inform and advise on ERC funding opportunities at national level (do not represent the ERC)
- Are located in the organisations of different nature (ministries, academies of science, research agencies, etc.) that act as information providers to ERC applicants in their native language
- Are based in all EU countries and Associated States, as well as in some non-European countries

Additional Opportunities: Visiting Research Fellowships

- Placements available via national or regional funding agencies
- Funding covers all costs of the research visit including salary, travel and reasonable subsistence costs
- Fellow must apply for an ERC grant after the visit within a time specified in the funding agreement
- Currently in place:

ERC CZ

- National funding scheme (1,109 mld CZK ~ 44,4 mil EUR for 2012-2026)
- Programme is aimed at ERC applicants who obtained A or B in step 2 of the ERC Starting, Consolidator or Advanced grant evaluation but were not funded under that call due to budgetary constraints (the results of the evaluation within the ERC are taken into account)
- The researcher of any nationality can choose any host institution in the Czech Republic
- The proposal with the evaluation A is entitled to receive a 5-year grant, the proposal with the evaluation B will be funded for 2 years
- ERC CZ holders are obliged to submit again an ERC proposal within 2 years after starting their ERC CZ project
