# CREAM Migration TF update (1/2)

- CREAM support stops at the end of this year
  - Sites need to move to alternative ways to make their computing resources available to WLCG and others
- Today, some 90 sites have at least 1 CREAM CE that supports at least 1 LHC experiment
  - It does not mean they are all used by the experiments
- On March 4, GGUS tickets were opened for those sites
  - Listing possible alternatives: ARC, HTCondor, no-CE (e.g. Vac)
  - Pointing to the SIMPLE Grid Framework as a possible means for easy deployment of HTCondor CE + batch
  - Asking site admins to let us know about their plans and timelines for phasing out their CREAM CE instances

# CREAM Migration TF update (2/2)

- We will track the tickets
  - Ensure they get acknowledged as a start
- Assist sites with resolving technical issues encountered when trying out a given alternative technology
  - That may typically imply involving the relevant product team
- Update the TF docs with known issues, recipes, ...
- What shall we do with tickets for sites that have clear plans and timelines for later this year?
  - Keep the tickets on hold? Open fresh tickets at some point?
