

Minutes CERN-Lithuania meeting on 11.1.19

The Lithuanian delegation requested to have 4 official representatives in the committee. This was agreed on, but only for the first 2 years. After that, the number of official representatives should go down to three, as it is for all other CERN external liaison committees.

Juras has stressed the importance of the chair of particle physics at Vilnius University as national coordinator and not only university wide.

Saule: organising the teacher program is a challenge in LT. The participation of LT artist in the ARTS at CERN program should be improved as well as the participation of the LT industry.

Anders: Happy to go to LT to visit companies. On the 12.3.19 there is the ILO forum, where LT should participate.

Saule: Career fairs are in Vilnius and Kaunas, where CERN could participate. The BIC is an agreement on the national level. Coordinator is the Minister of Economy via the Lithuanian Innovation Center. There should be a common selection committee. Support is 40k Euro/company paid by EU structural funds. The agreement should be ready in about 2 weeks time.

Giovanni: KT forum, one seat is for LT

Sarah: no LT representative in teacher forum so far.
