 - IPAC'10 Kyoto, Japan
 - IPAC'11 San Sebastian, 5-9 September
 - IPAC'12 New Orleans
- The former PAC will continue on a two-year as a National NA PAC, in odd years
- All are fully JACoW SPMS Compatible
