Post Workshop

Keep momentum going after the event itself!

Maintain gentle pressure on authors yet to submit; emphasize importance of their contribution, especially if invited, and appeal to their sense of obligation!

Final checking of papers a hard task as editors become oblivious to their own mistakes
- fresh face is best!

Numerous papers with missing footnotes:
e.g. "*" after title pointing to nothing
