What's Considered

New Bug Reports @ Github

- Github offers "Issues" for bug reports; data is exportable
- New bug reports would have to be entered there
 - Jira closed for bug submission, only handling of existing bugs
- Will not migrate existing bugs from Jira into Github
 - No need (assumption: Jira will be kept)
 - Saves lots of extra effort

ROOT@Jira

Projects @ sft.its.cern.ch

- ROOT #1 with >10k issues
 - Out of 24k total on that Jira instance
- LHCb Deployment: 4k
- CORAL / COOL: 3k
- All others < 3k

Why to Stay With Jira


- Binding ourselves even more to commercial platform that we don't control
- Not sure to which extent github can replace project management (e.g. bug report plots) - see this meeting
- We cannot customize the Github interface
- We would have to live with two systems (JIRA and Github issues) for quite some time (forever?)
- Would need to combine issue stats from Jira (old issues) and Github (new)

Why to move

- Philippe cannot edit Jira tickets in his Firefox; works for Github
- Lower barrier to entry for physicists to report ROOT bugs
 - No need for CERN account
 - Report templates, see e.g. https://github.com/numba/numba/issues/new/choose
- Project management features of GitHub Issues such as milestones, checklists, progress bars - see this meeting

Why to move

- Publicly visible, tighter integration between bug reports, PRs and code: cross-references, issues auto-closed by PRs, branch-dependent URLs
- Better notification emails: targeted; relevant info
- Markup language consistent with "the rest of the world": github PR reviews (obviously), Jekyll, codimd
- More streamlined interface



Create a report to help us improve Numba. If this doesn't look right, choose a different type.






Issue Labels

 numba/numba/labels




Issue Assignment

Advanced Filter

- Simple search box
- Advanced search features
 - Spans virtually all fields: milestone, assigned, author, created date, updated date, closed date...
 - Lots of logical connections: "links" (or doesn't); no assignee or label etc

Search only issues or pull requests

Search by the title, body, or comments

Search within a user's or organization's repositories

Search by open or closed state

Search by public or private repository

Search by author

Search by assignee

Search by mention

Search by team mention

Search by commenter

Search by a user that's involved in an issue or pull request

Search for linked issues and pull requests

Search by label

Search by milestone

Search by project board

Search by commit status

Search by commit SHA

Search by branch name

Search by language

Search by number of comments

Search by number of interactions

Search by number of reactions

Search for draft pull requests


Search by pull request review status and reviewer






Milestones, Again








App Candidates

 - Roadmaps, agile epic + story + sprint + milestone, reporting
- Auto labeling (based on ML): <u>Issue-Label Bot</u>
- Notification management: Octobox

Experiments

ALICE

- Jira
 - Used both Jira and Github but duplication was problematic
- Strong resistance to move away from Jira for "political" reasons
 - "private" bugs etc

LHCb

- Uses both Jira and Gitlab Issues, IIUC:
 - Jira: project management
 - Gitlab Issues: code bugs; e.g. Gaudi @ Gitlab
- Concerned by transition: redirecting new bugs; follow-up on old ones

ATLAS

- Uses Jira
- Never considered moving away from it
- Sees no problems with ROOT moving to Jira
- Requests meaningful message on the then legacy Jira site, if we move
